



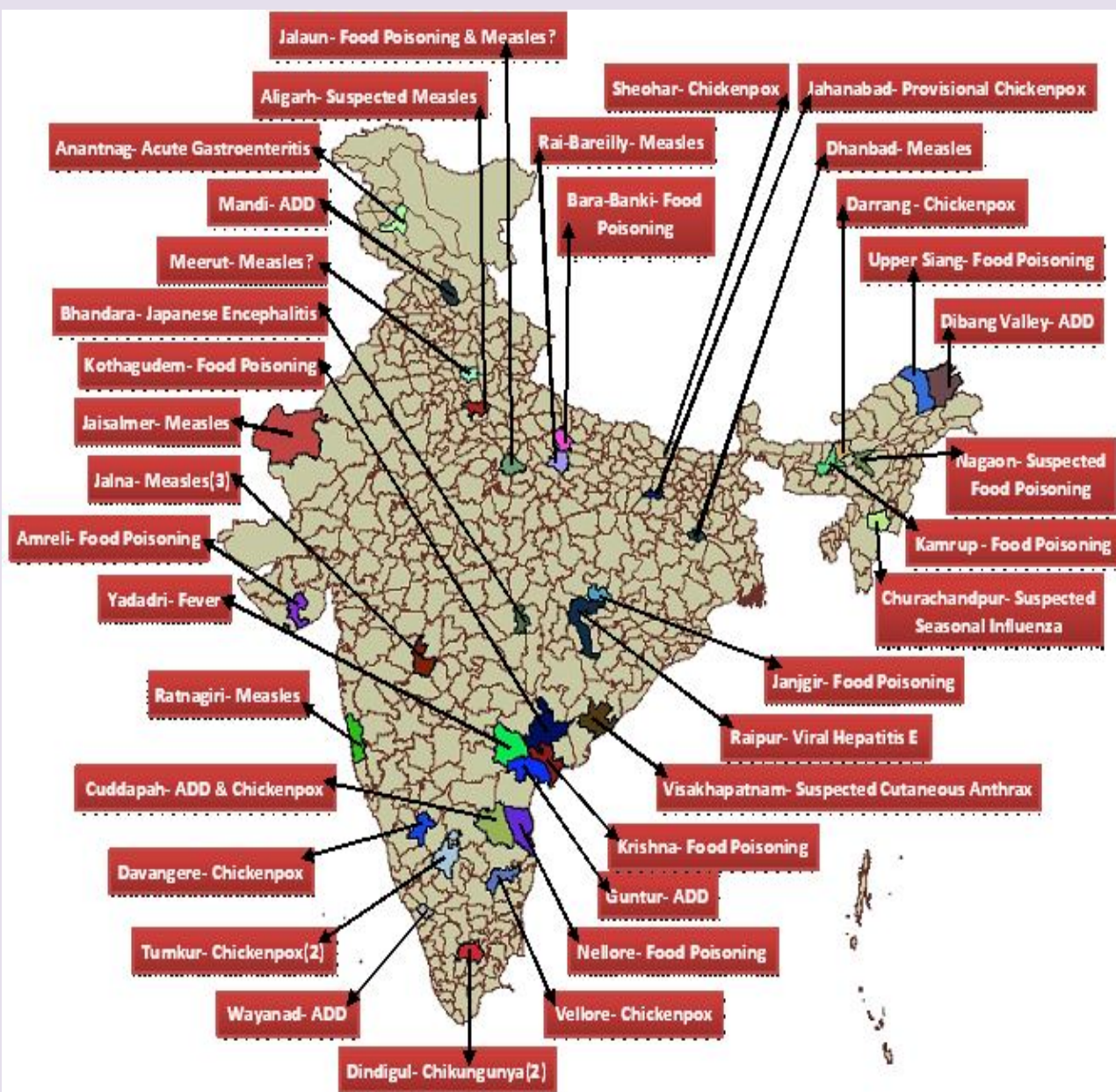

District RRT investigated the outbreak. House to house survey done. 04 Blood samples sent to SGPGI Lucknow; result awaited. Vit A distributed among the cases. All cases treated symptomatically. Health education given.
