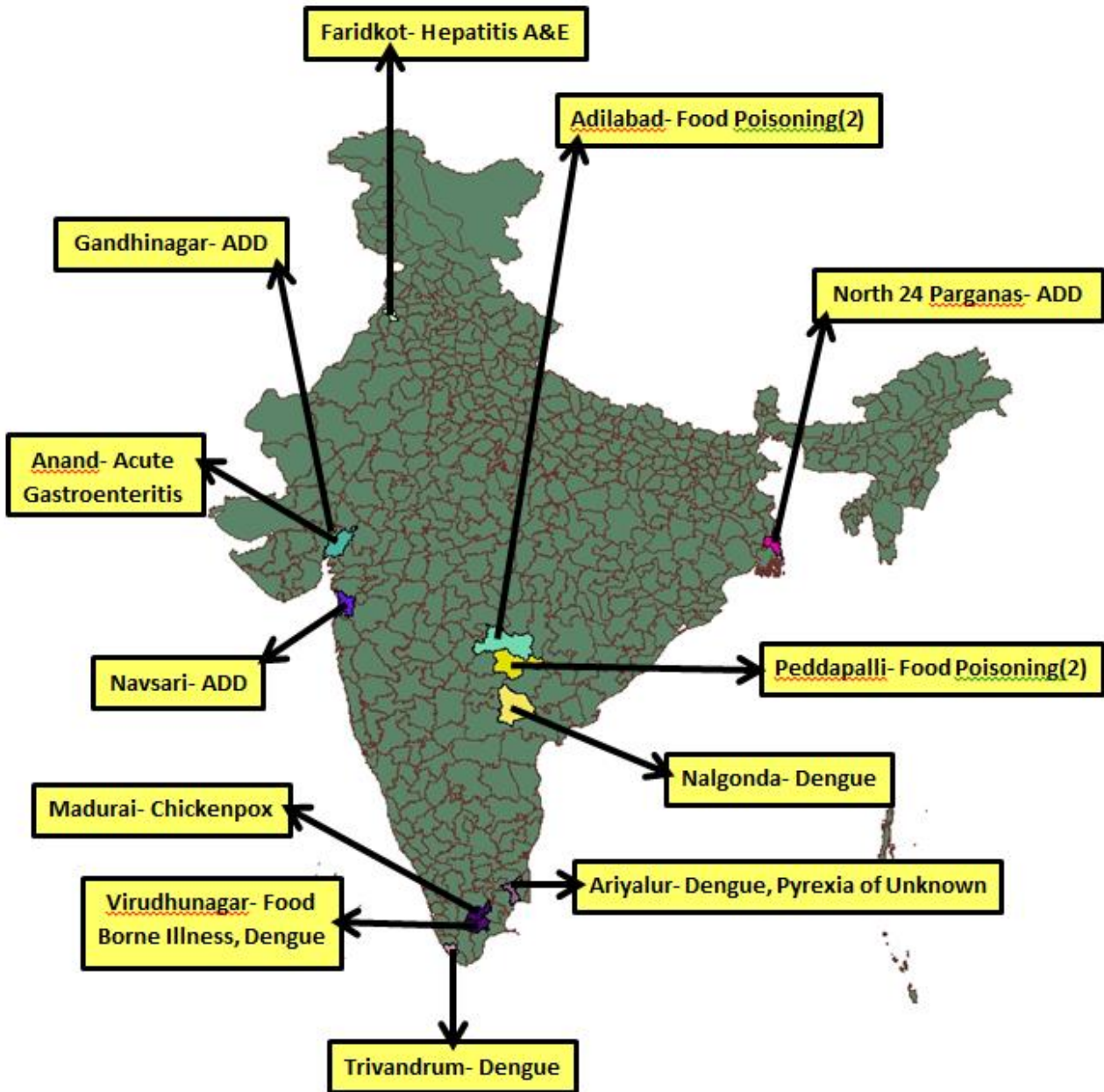

10th Week Map

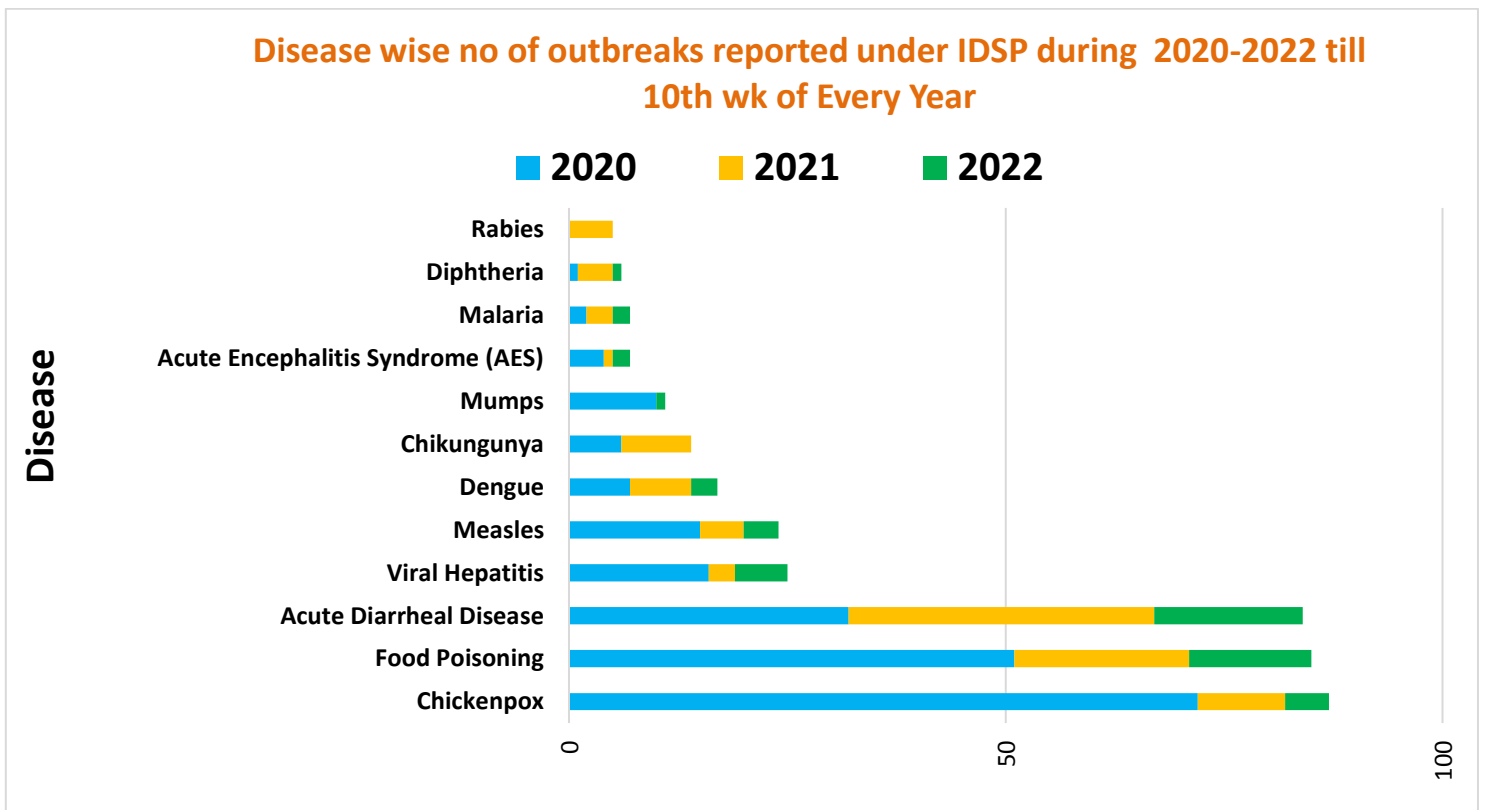
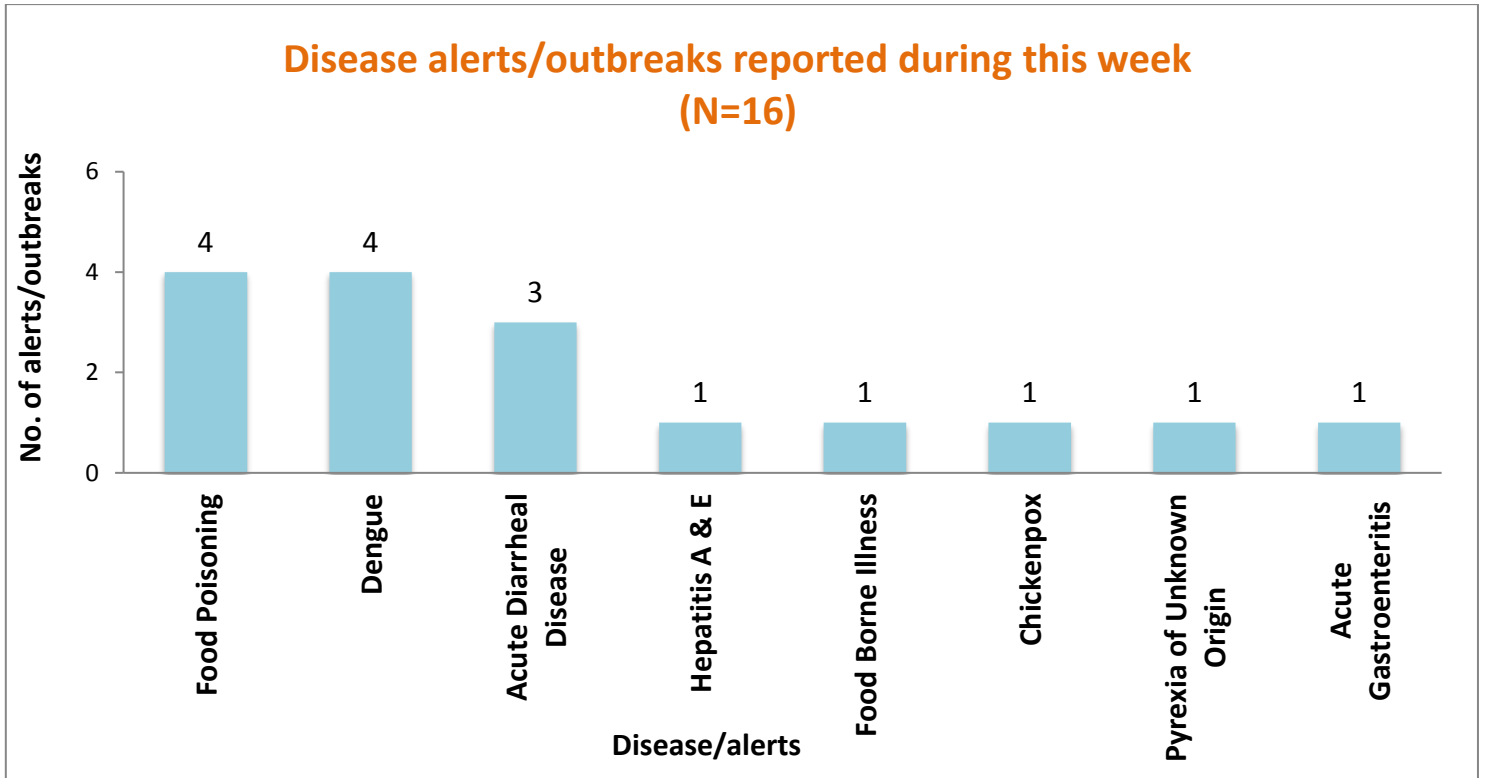

Chlorine tablets and ORS sachets were distributed. Health education was given regarding importance of safe drinking water and sanitation practices.

Chlorine tablets and ORS sachets were distributed. Health education was given regarding importance of safe drinking water and sanitation practices.

Cases presented with loose stools, abdominal pain and vomiting. Nine stool samples and four water samples were sent to DPHL Petlad, Anand. Stool samples showed no organism and water samples were found unfit for drinking. The deceased case was a 6 year old female. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Symptomatic treatment was given to all the cases. Chlorine tablets and ORS sachets were distributed. Health education was given regarding importance of safe drinking water and sanitation practices.

Chlorine tablets and ORS sachets were distributed. Health education was given regarding importance of safe drinking water and sanitation practices.
