





Larval surveys and source reduction activities done in the area. 21 blood smears tested for Malaria found negative. 20 serum samples sent to GMC Aurangabad for Dengue and chikungunya examination; result awaited. All cases treated symptomatically. Fogging done in the affected area. Dry day observed once a week in area.
