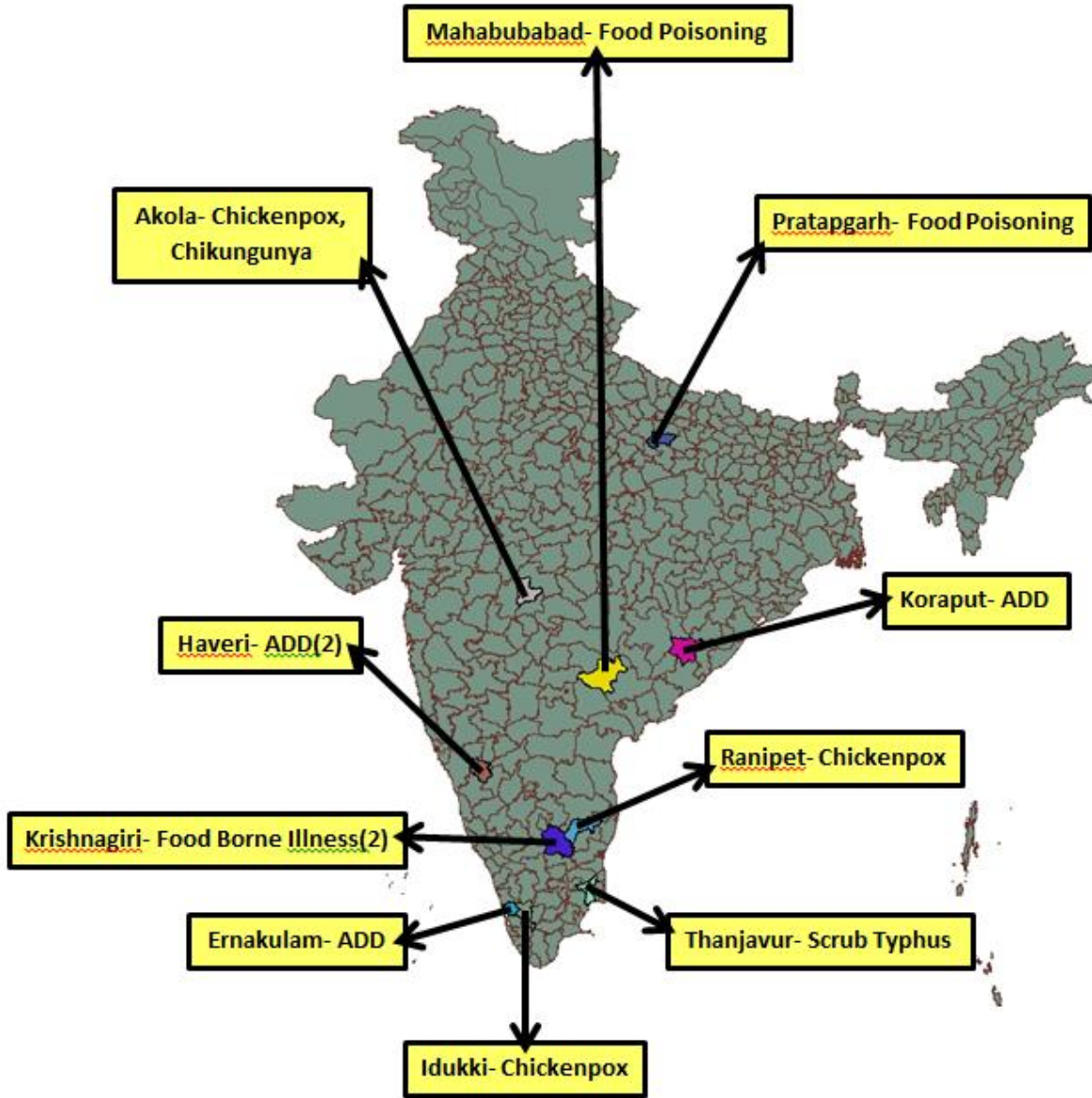

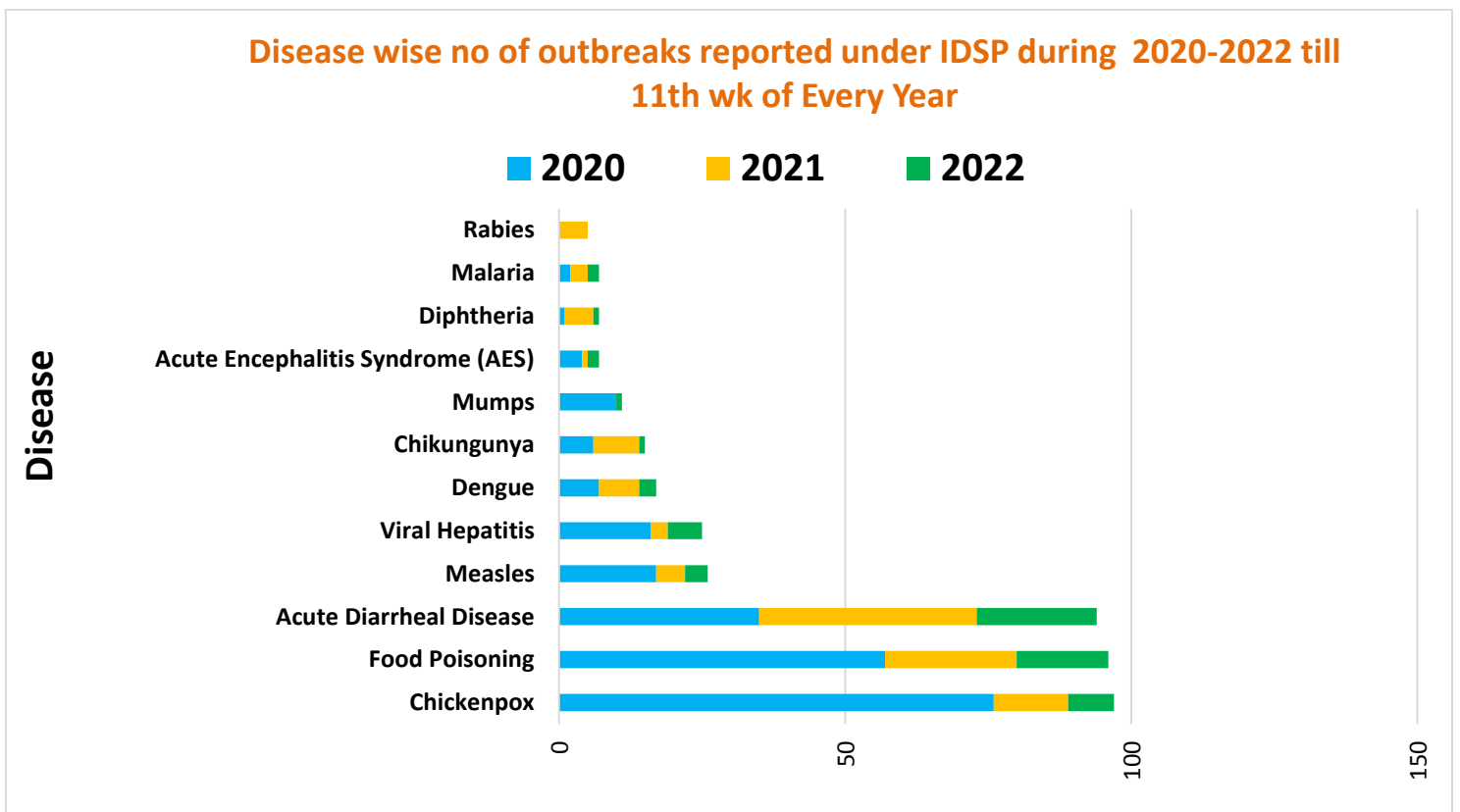
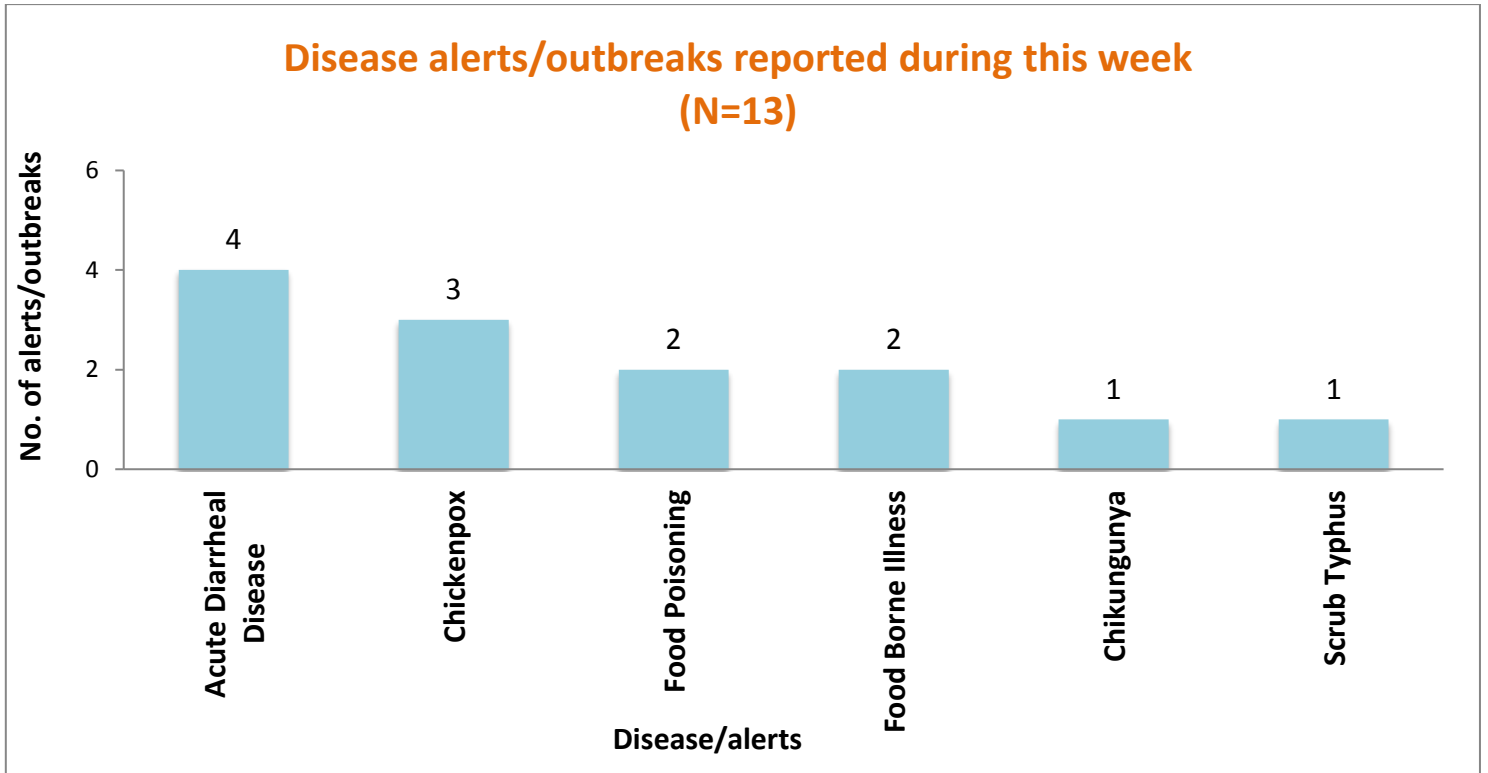

Six water samples were collected from the water sources and sent to District Water Treatment Laboratory and three stool samples were sent to RPH Lab Ernakulam. None of the samples showed presence of any organism. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Symptomatic treatment was given to all the cases. Chlorine tablets were distributed. Health education was given regarding importance of safe drinking water.

All of them were negative for Measles. District RRT investigated the outbreak. House to house mass surveillance was done. Anti-larval activities were carried out. done. Daily fever surveillance was done. Health education was given.

Cases presented with fever and rashes over trunk, back, extremities and face. Five blood samples were sent for lab investigations to GMC Akola. All of them were negative for Measles and Rubella. One sample tested positive for Chikungunya by IgM ELISA. District RRT investigated the outbreak. House to house mass surveillance was done. Anti-larval activities were carried out. done. Daily fever surveillance was done. Health education was given.

Of the total rectal swab samples, four showed presence of E.coli and eight showed presence of Enterobacter species. Out of the total water samples sent, three showed presence of E.coli. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Symptomatic treatment was given to all the cases. Chlorine tablets were distributed. Health education was given regarding importance of safe drinking water.

Cases presented with vomiting, stomach ache, headache, nausea and abdominal pain. One water sample and one stool sample was sent to DPHL Krishnagiri. Water sample was found to be fit for drinking. Stool water showed no growth of any organism. Proper hygiene awareness imparted. District RRT investigated the case. Symptomatic treatment was given to all the cases. Chlorine tablets were distributed. Health education was given regarding importance of safe drinking water and properly cooked food. People were encouraged to use proper toilets.

It was found that the water sample was not fit for drinking. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Symptomatic treatment was given to all the cases. Chlorine tablets were distributed. Health education was given regarding importance of safe drinking water and properly cooked food.

Out of seven blood samples, four were found positive for Scrub typhus by IgM ELISA and one sample was found positive for Dengue by IgM ELISA. Water sample was found to be non-potable. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Door to door surveillance was done, disinfection activities were carried out. Health education was given regarding importance of vector control measures.

District RRT investigated the outbreak. Pest control measures like spraying was done. sanitation with sodium hypochlorite was done in surroundings and school & college. Symptomatic treatment was given to all the cases. Health education was given regarding importance of safe drinking water and properly cooked food.
