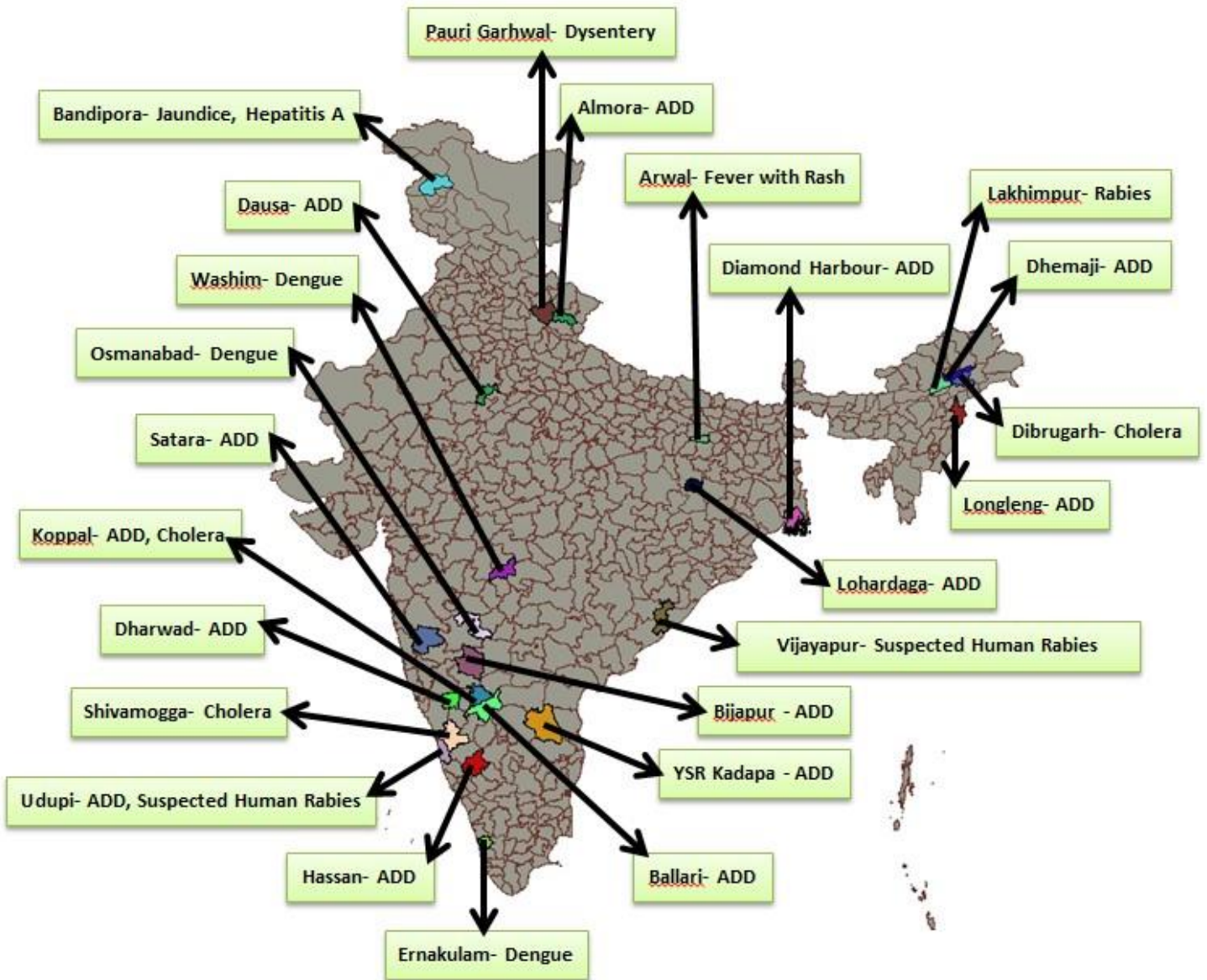

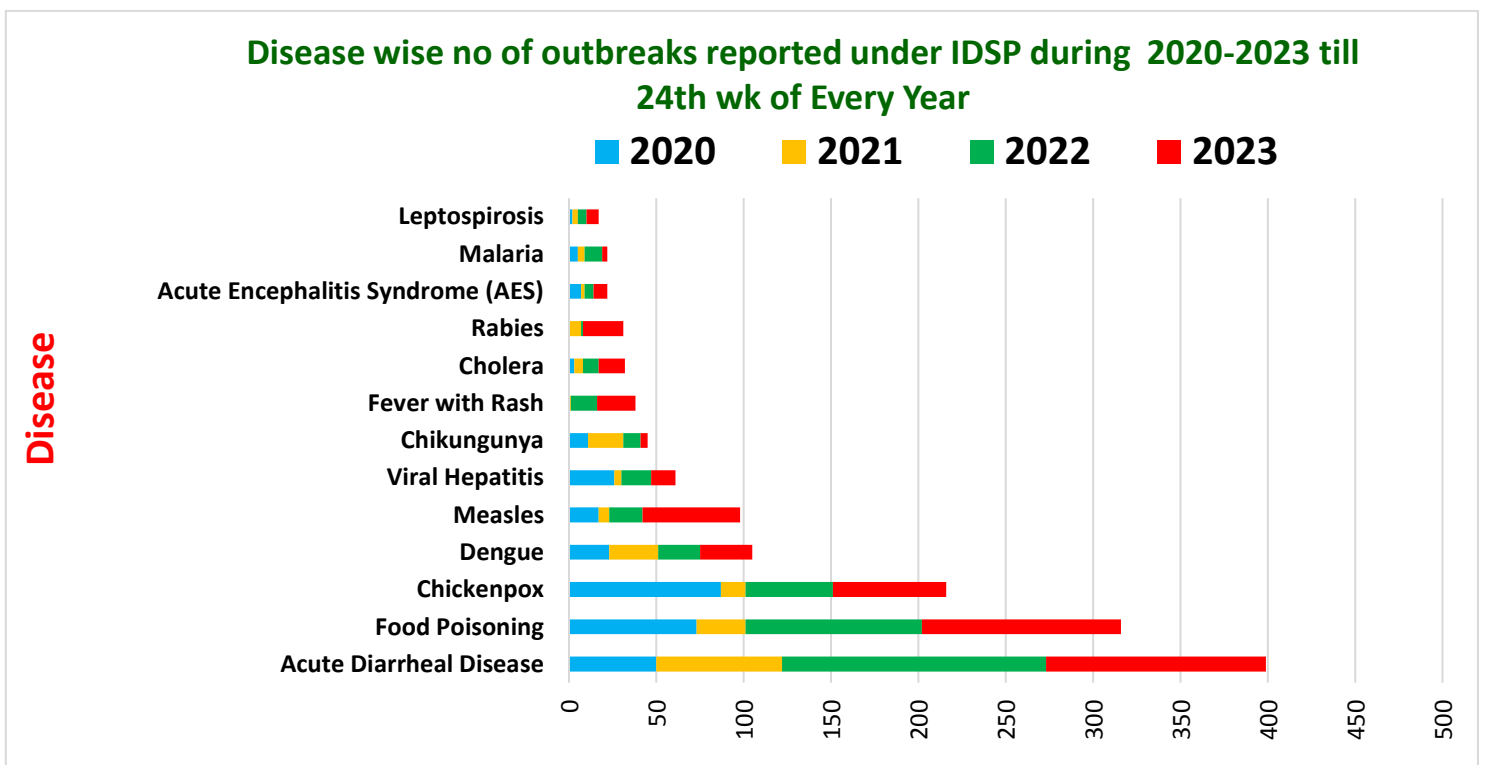
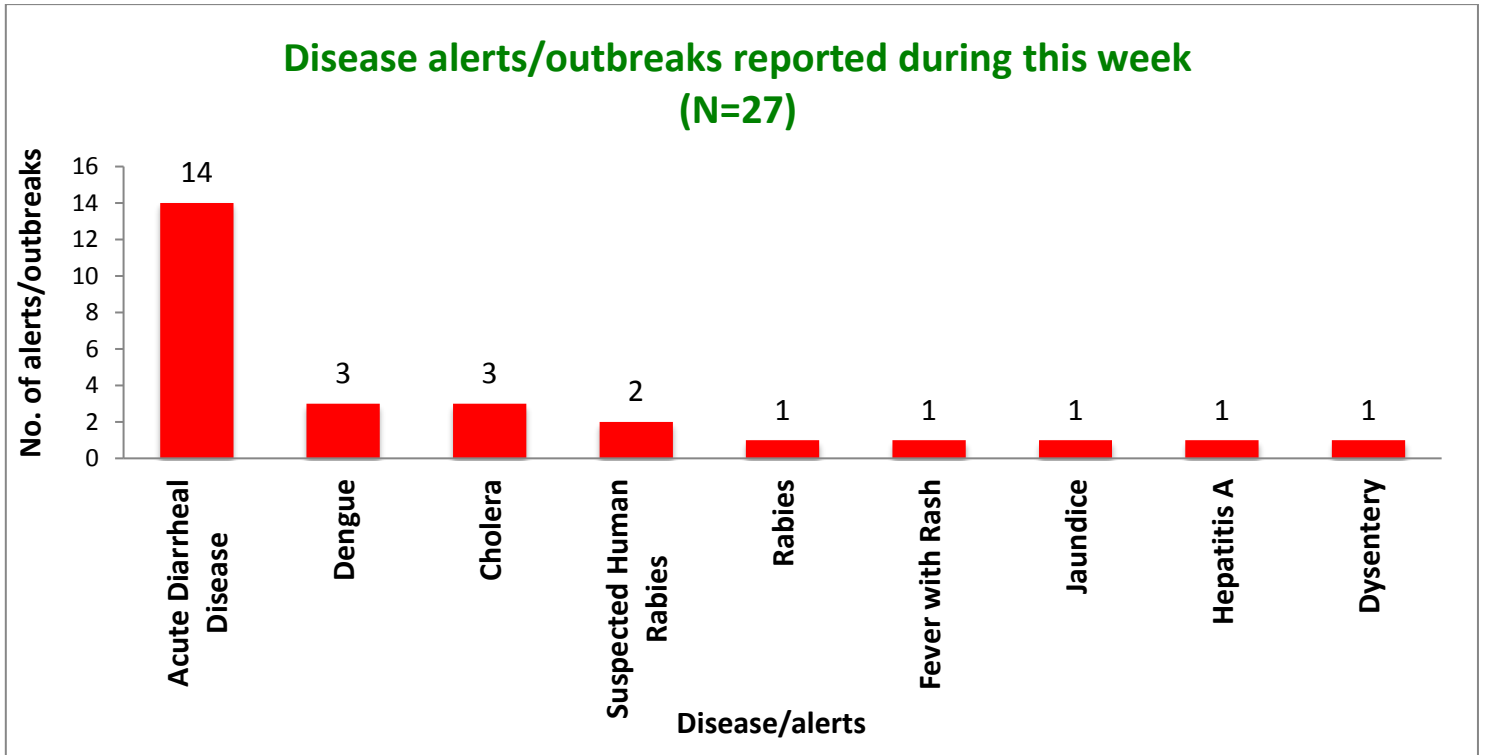

Community awareness and health education given by peripheral team on food hygiene, safe drinking water and sanitation.

Report showed growth of Vibrio Cholera on culture. Affected case was 5-month-old baby. House-to-house survey was conducted along with the distribution of ORS packets. No new cases were detected. Community awareness and health education given by peripheral team on food hygiene, safe drinking water and sanitation.

Case presented with the history of dog bite, excess salivation and difficulty in swallowing. District RRT investigated the outbreak. The case a 59-year-old male who succumbed to death on 13-06-2023. Patient family members and other relatives have taken ARV at LMCH who were in close contact with the patient. Community awareness and health education given by peripheral team on vaccination.

Community awareness and health education given by peripheral health team on hygiene, sanitation and importance of vaccination.

A total of 06 blood samples were collected for Hepatitis A and E serology and 03 water samples also collected for coliform testing and sent to DPHL Baramulla. All 06 blood samples found negative for Hepatitis A and E by IgM ELISA. The water samples found unsatisfactory for potable purpose. Community awareness and health education given by peripheral health team on hygiene and importance of immunization.

One blood sample found positive for Hepatitis A anti IgM antibody by ELISA, while water samples were found satisfactory. Age group of the affected cases is 01-25 years. Community awareness and health education given by peripheral health team on hygiene and importance of immunization.

Community awareness and health education given by peripheral team on food hygiene, safe drinking water and sanitation.

Continuous survey was conducted along with the distribution of ORS packets. Community awareness and health education given by peripheral team on food hygiene, safe drinking water and sanitation.

Stool and blood sample came negative for any pathogens. Food samples were also negative for any bacteria. Continuous hostel survey was conducted along with the distribution of ORS packets. All 5 stool samples showed E. coli isolate on culture, and all 3 water samples found to be not suitable for potable purpose. Continuous house to house survey was conducted. Community awareness and health education given by peripheral team on food hygiene, safe drinking water and sanitation.

Cases presented with loose stools and vomiting. 58 stool and 108 water samples collected and sent to SIMS, Shimogga. District RRT investigated the outbreak. 13 Stool samples out of 58 showed growth of Vibrio Cholrae on culture. A total of 80 water samples found to be not suitable for potable purpose. Continuous house to house survey was conducted. Community awareness and health education given by peripheral team on food hygiene, safe drinking water and sanitation.

Community awareness and health education given by peripheral team on food hygiene, safe drinking water and sanitation.

The case has not taken any vaccination or treatment after the dog bite. After onset of symptoms she was first taken to the hospital on 12-06-2023. Complete prophylactic vaccination given to the one close contact. The case 43-year-old female succumbed to death on 13-06-2023. Community awareness and health education given by peripheral team on vaccination.

One blood sample out of five came positive for Dengue by IgM ELISA. Health education was given on the vector control measures.

Cause of outbreak might be the food served on a religious occasion. House to House survey was done. Saliva tested negative for rabies viral RNA by real time PCR. The case 33-year-old female succumbed to death on 06-06-2023, within 2 days of onset of illness. Seven house members and 25 members in neighborhood were given the prophylactic ARV. Community awareness and health education given by peripheral team on vaccination.

Nine out of 14 water sample found to be not suitable for potable purpose. Continuous survey was conducted along with the distribution of ORS packets. Community awareness and health education given by peripheral team on food hygiene, safe drinking water and sanitation.

Vector indices and mosquito breeding found to be high in affected wards. Community awareness and health education given by peripheral health team on sanitation and vector control measures.
