

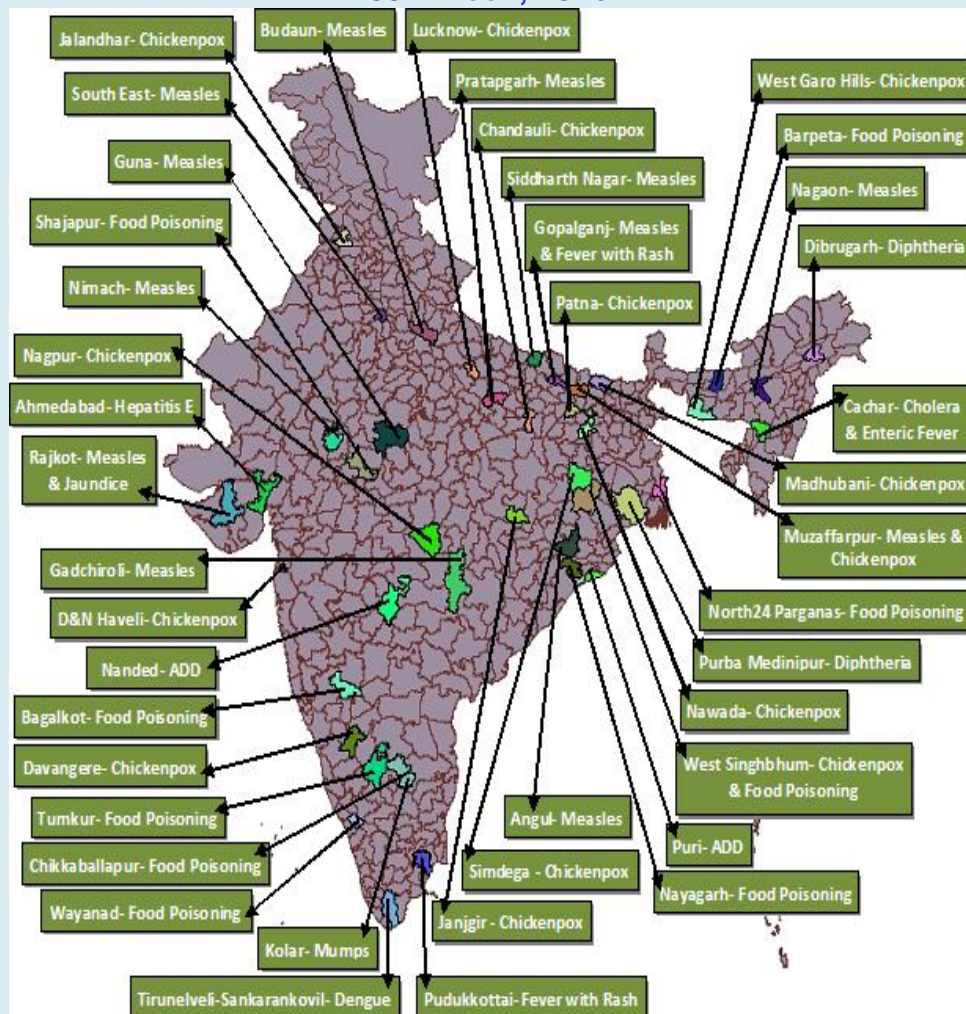

District wise disease alerts/outbreaks reported in the 03rd Week, 2016

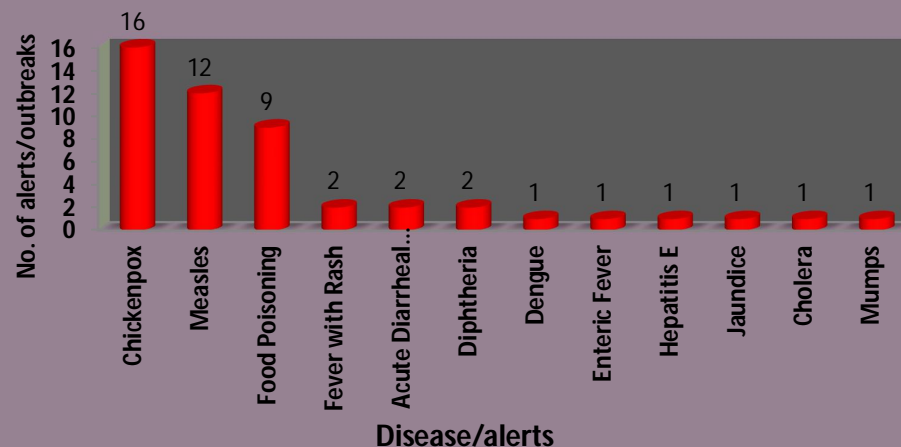

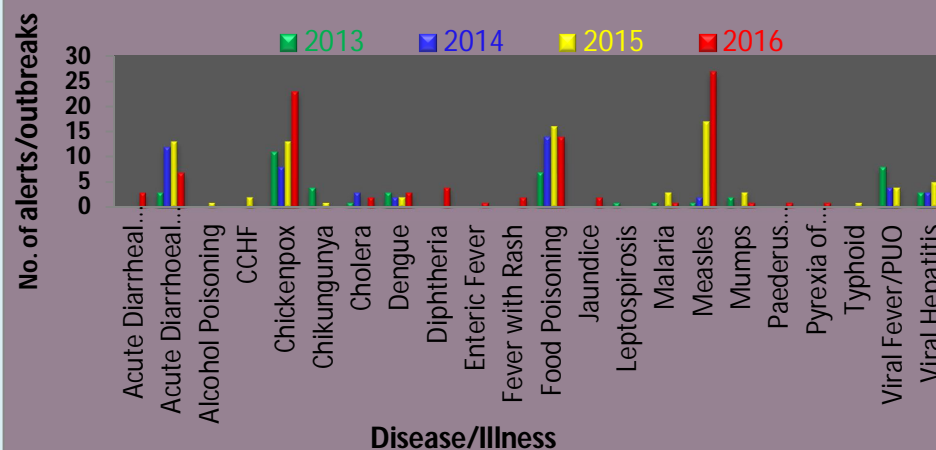
