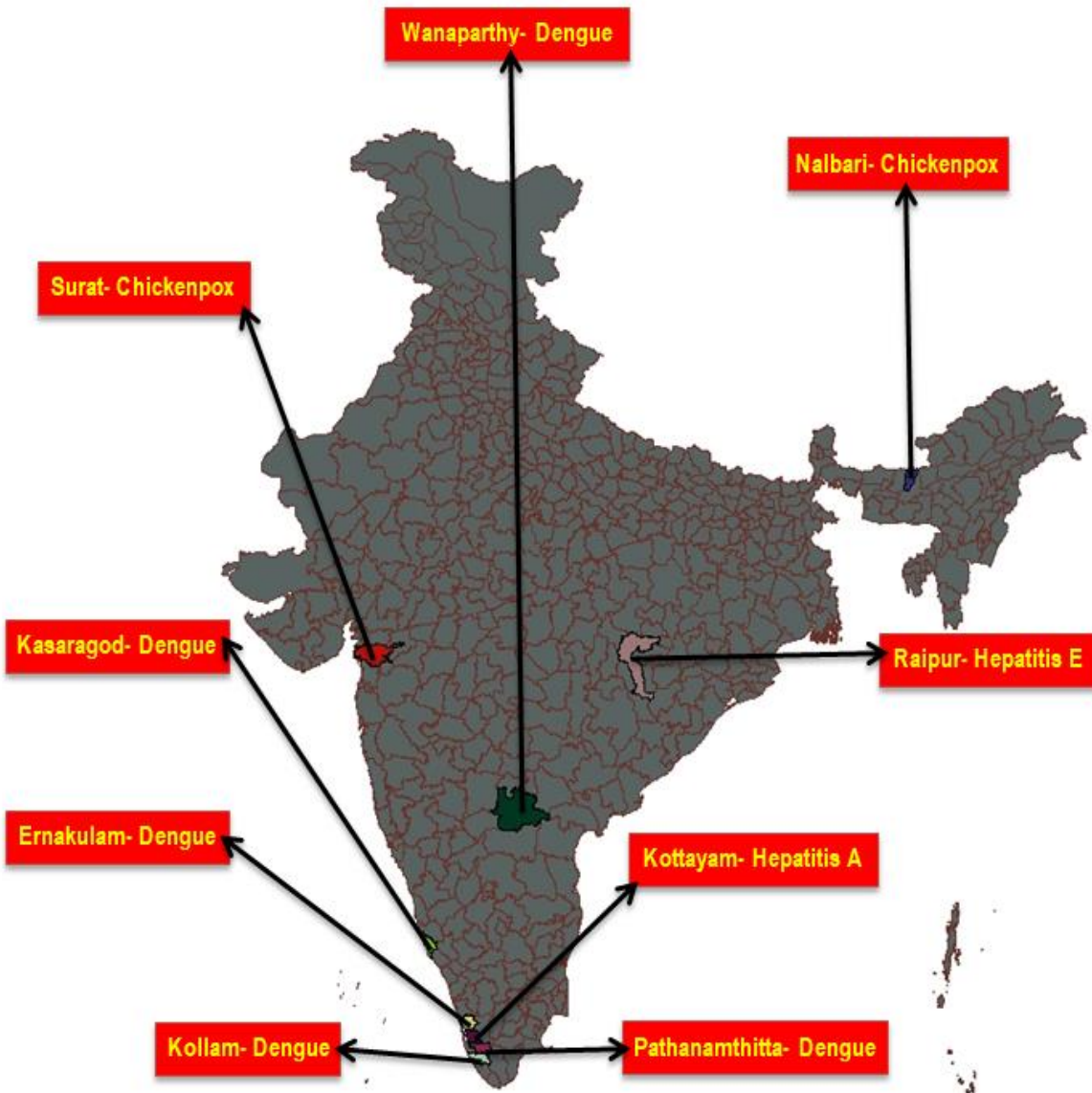

19th Week Map

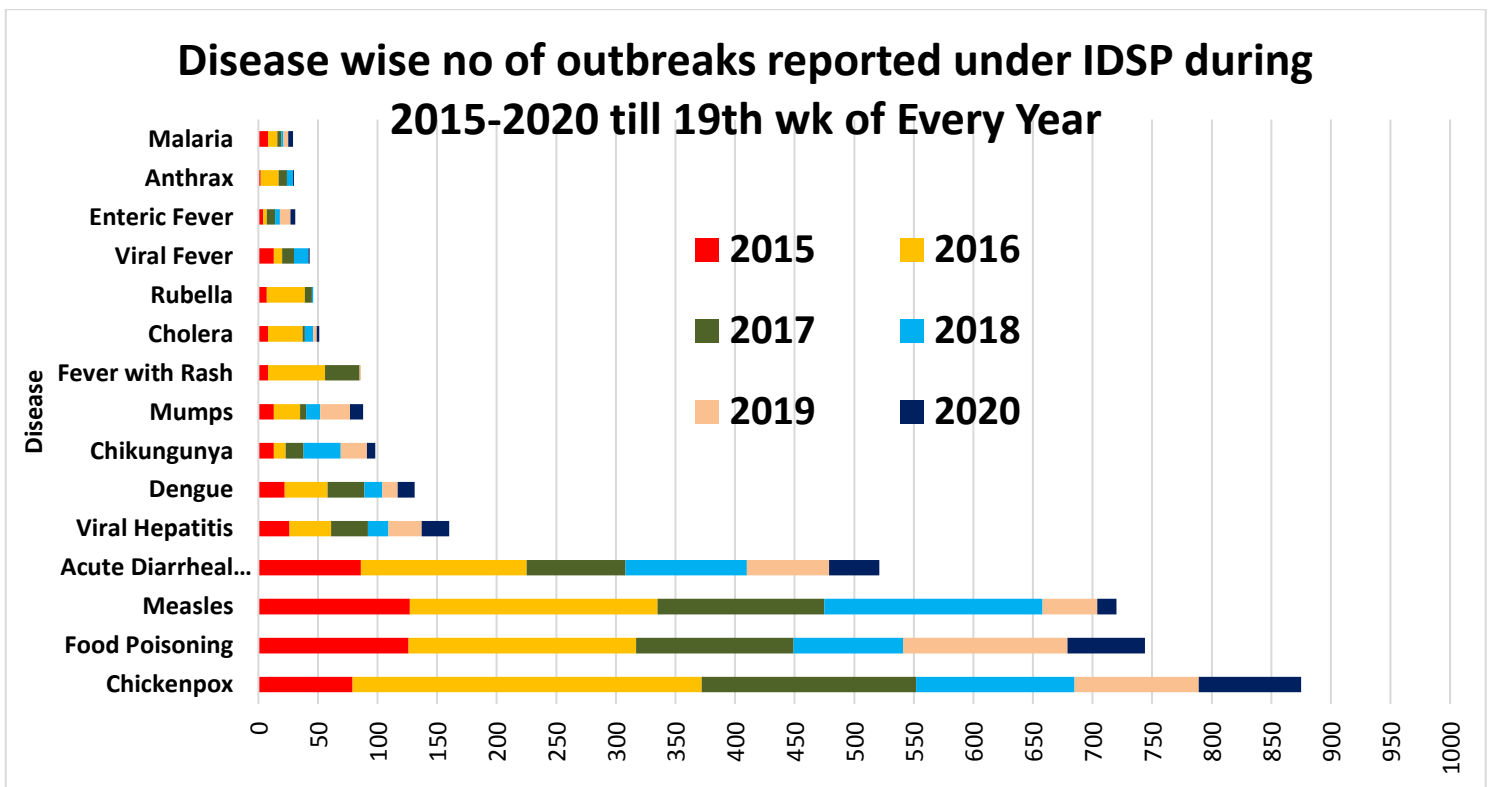
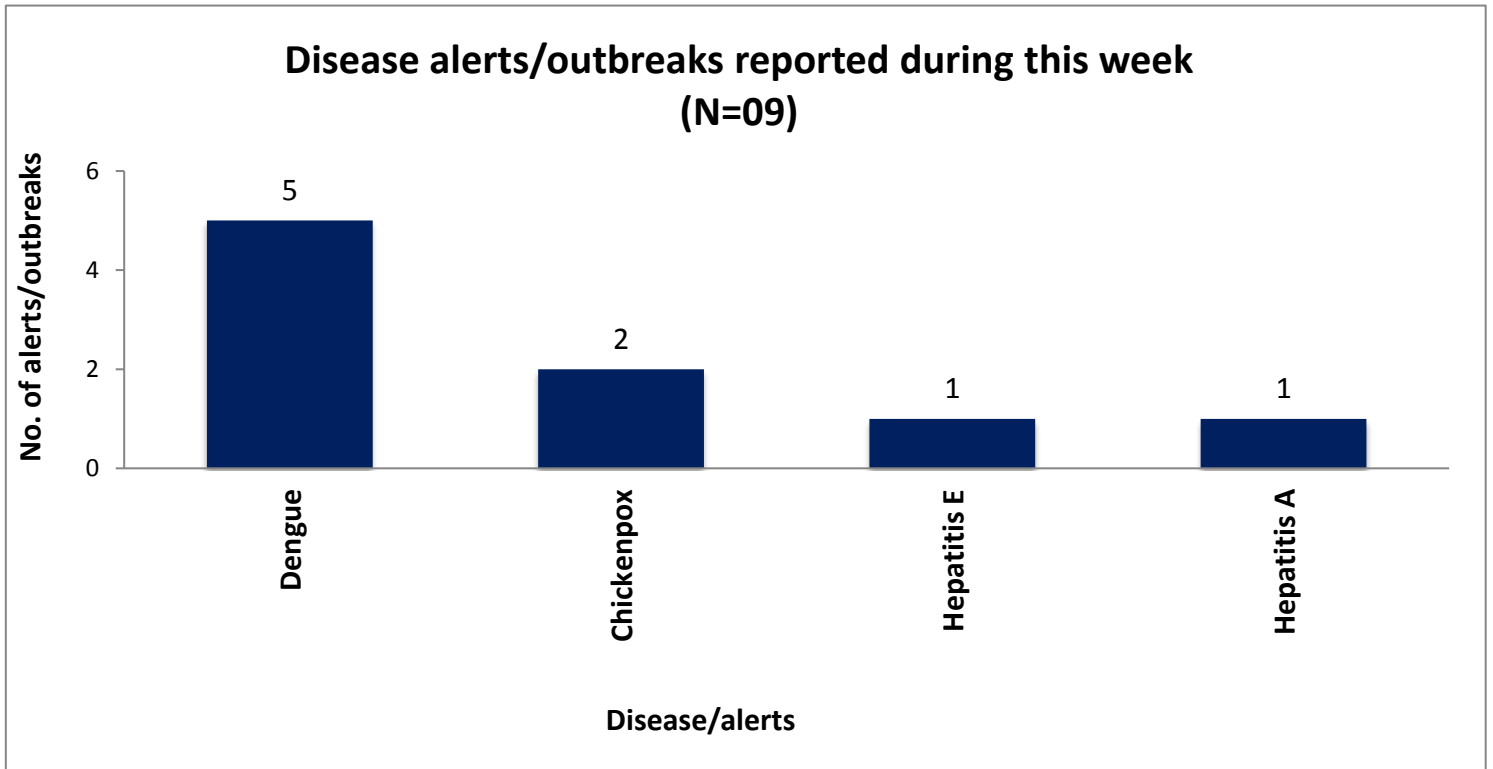

Health education given.

The deceased was a 50y/F presented with fever, cough and headache later she developed haemorrhagic manifestations. A total of 13 blood samples collected and sent to PH Lab Kollam, 07 were found to be positive for Dengue by Igm ELISA. Source reduction activities undertaken. All cases treated. Source reduction activities undertaken. Fogging done. Health education given.

Superchlorination of water done. Chlorine tablets distributed in the affected area. All cases treated. Health education given

State and District NVBDCP officials were informed. House to house survey conducted. A total of 168 sources were found positive for Aedes breeding. Cases presented with fever, body ache, headache and chills. Cases were among daily wage labors and migrant workers. A total of 73 blood smears were found to be negative for Malarial parasite. A total of 52 samples were collected and of these 37 were found positive for Dengue by IgM ELISA. All cases treated. Source reduction activities undertaken. Health education given
