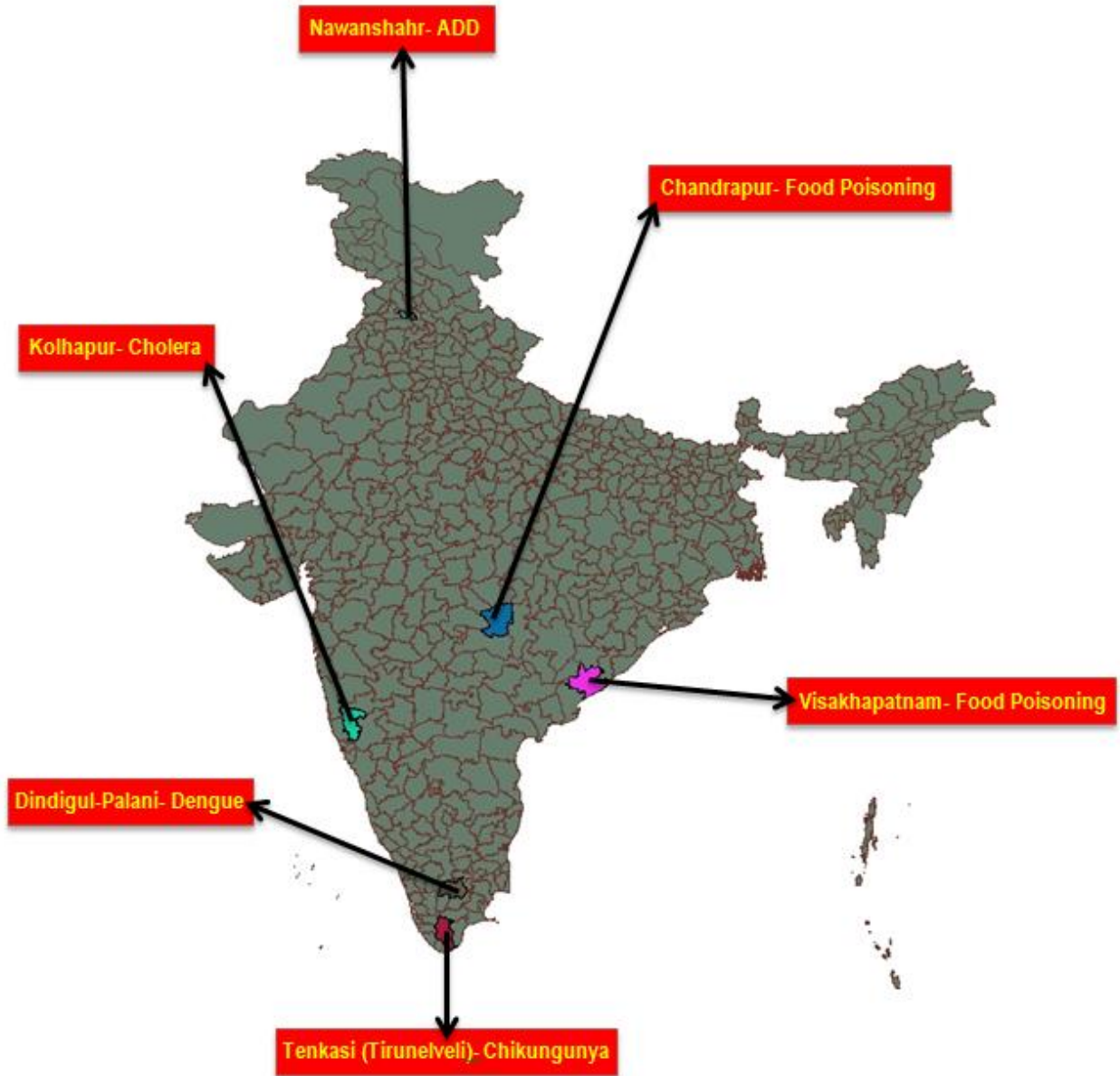

23<sup>rd</sup> Week Map

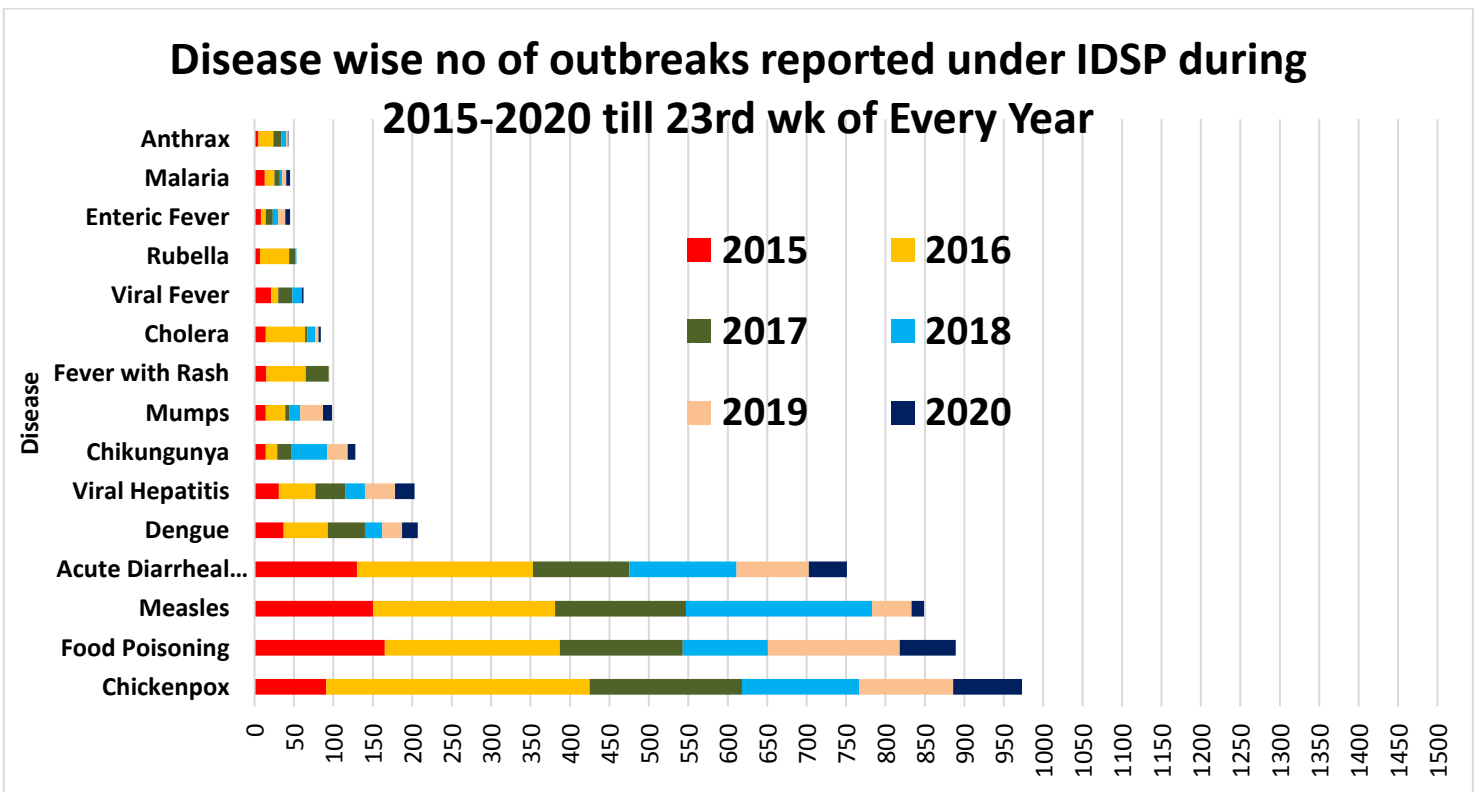
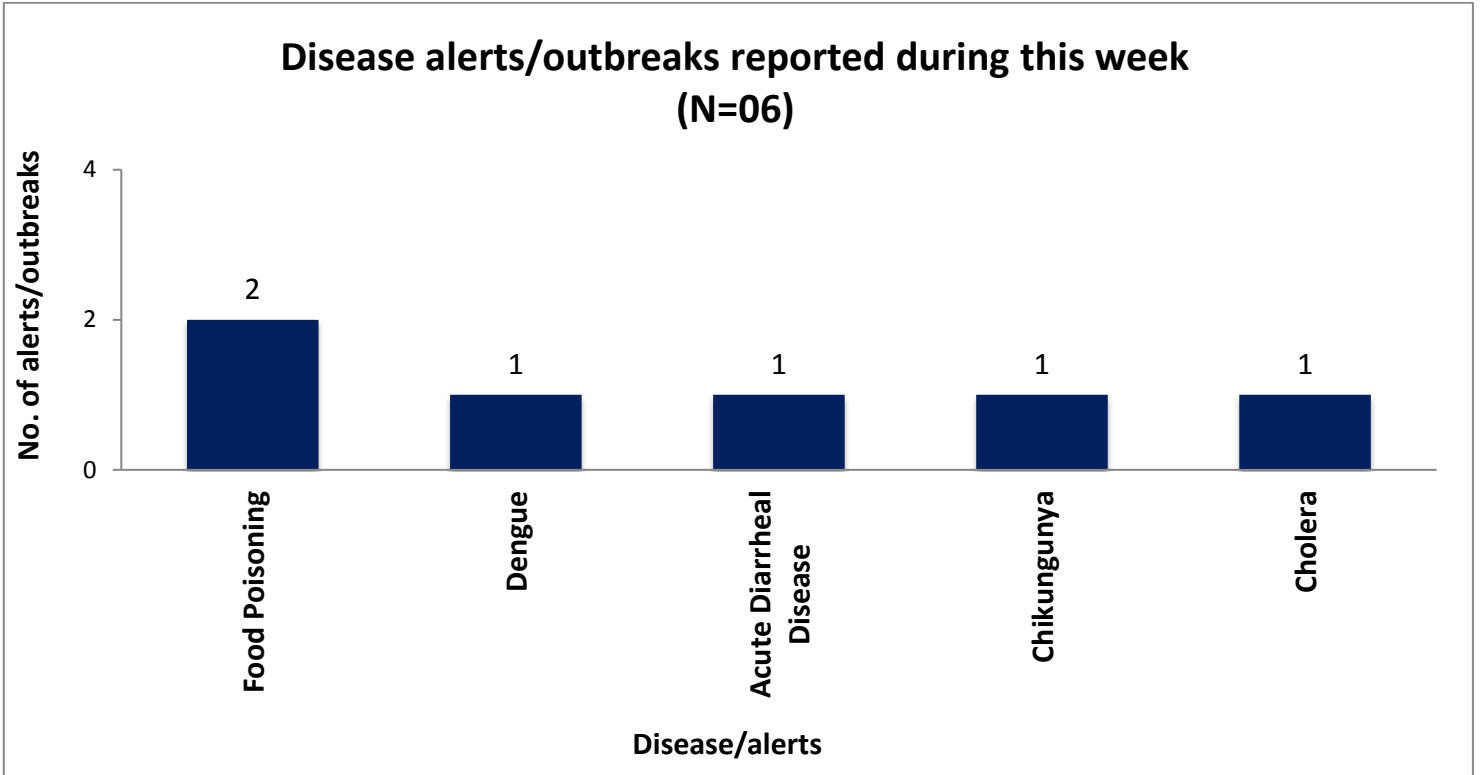

Cases presented after consuming dead goat meat. A total of 02 water samples collected and sent to Regional Public Health Laboratory and were reported negative on bacteriological analysis. All cases treated. Water sources disinfected. Chlorine tablets distributed. Medical camps conducted in the affected area. Health education given.

All cases treated. Fever camps conducted in the affected area. Fogging done in the affected area. Health education given
