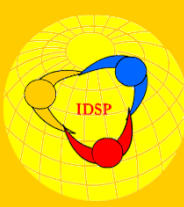

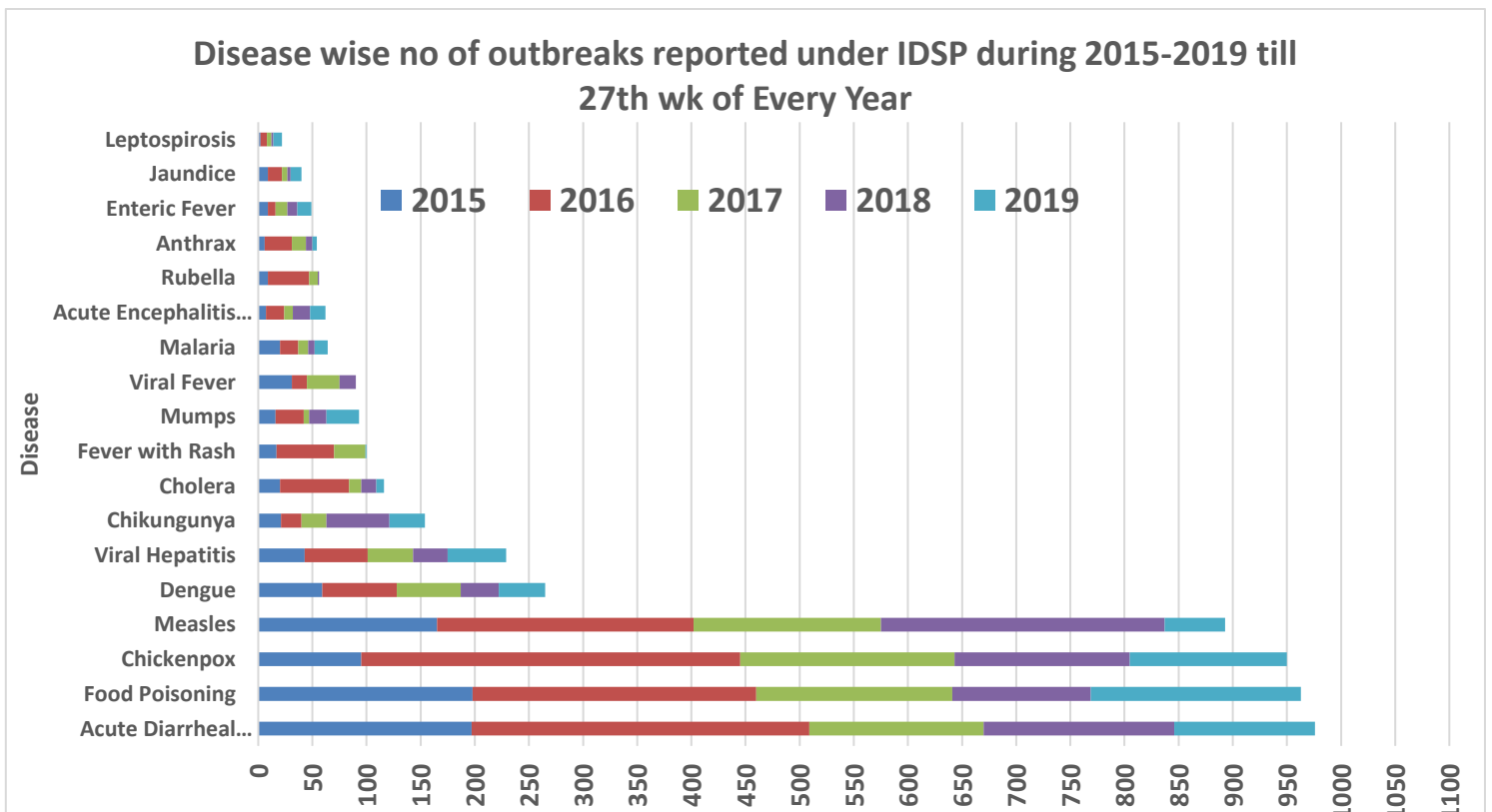
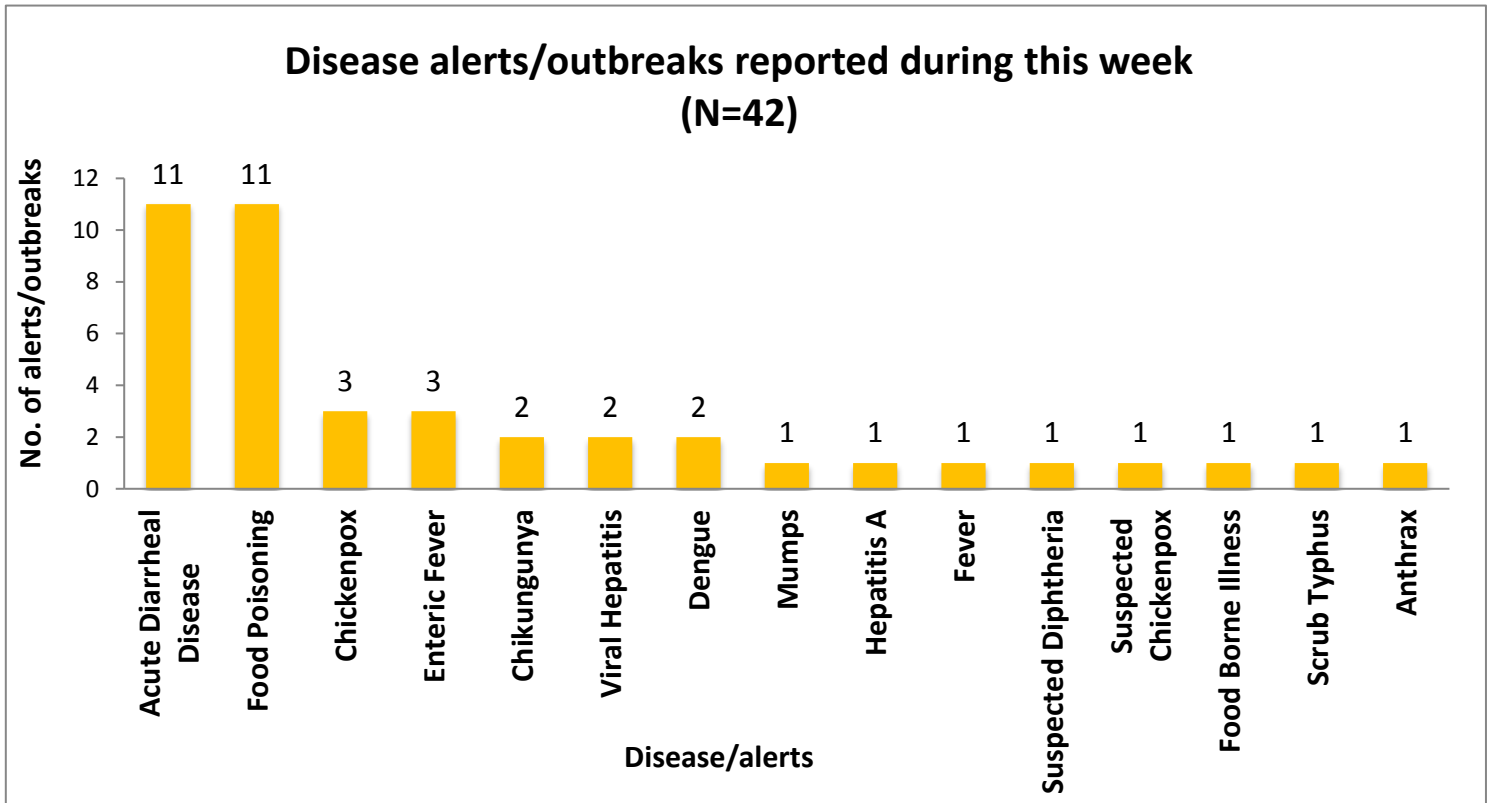

Extensive vector control measures were taken. Fogging done. Various RRTs constituted. Insecticide treated bed nets distributed.
