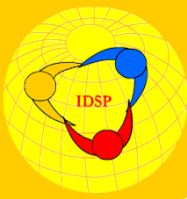

40th Week Map

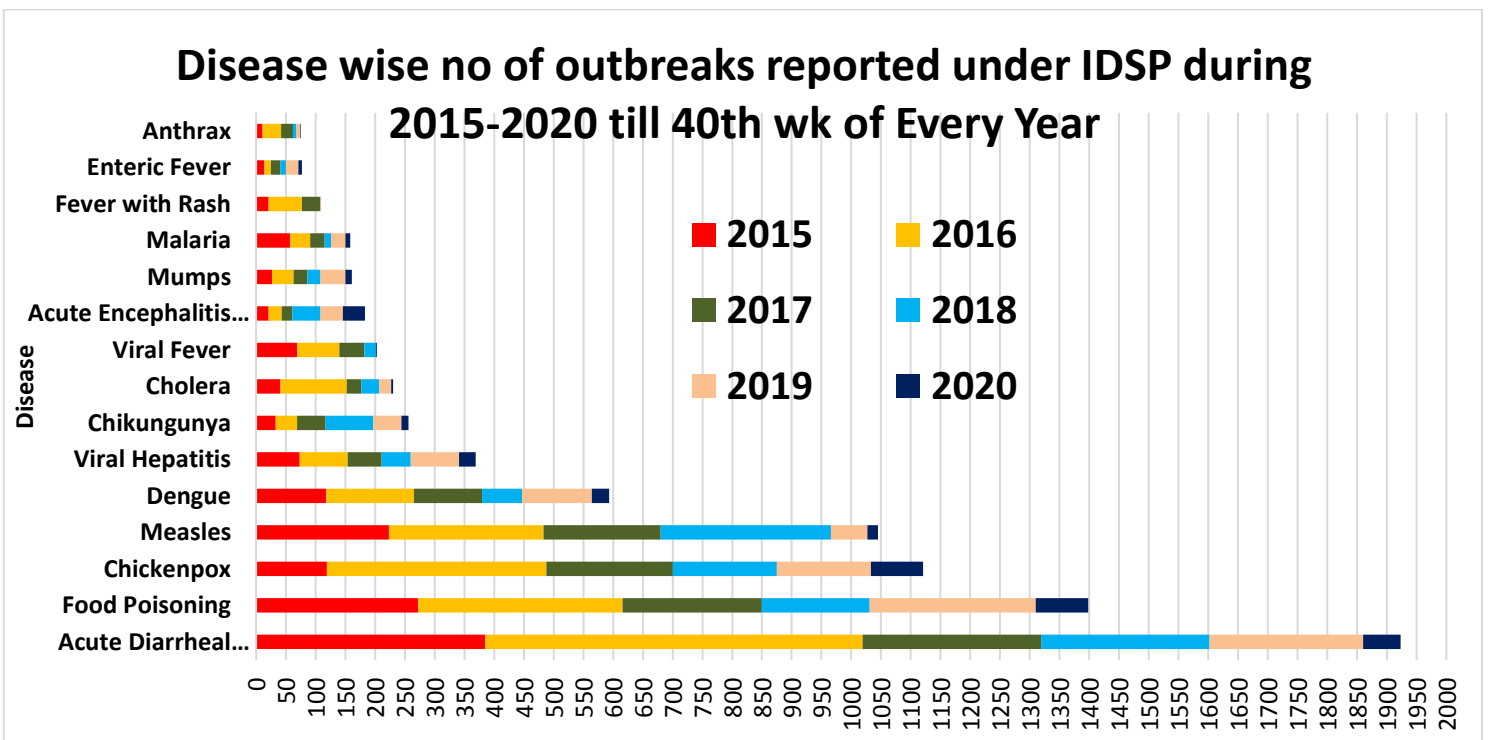
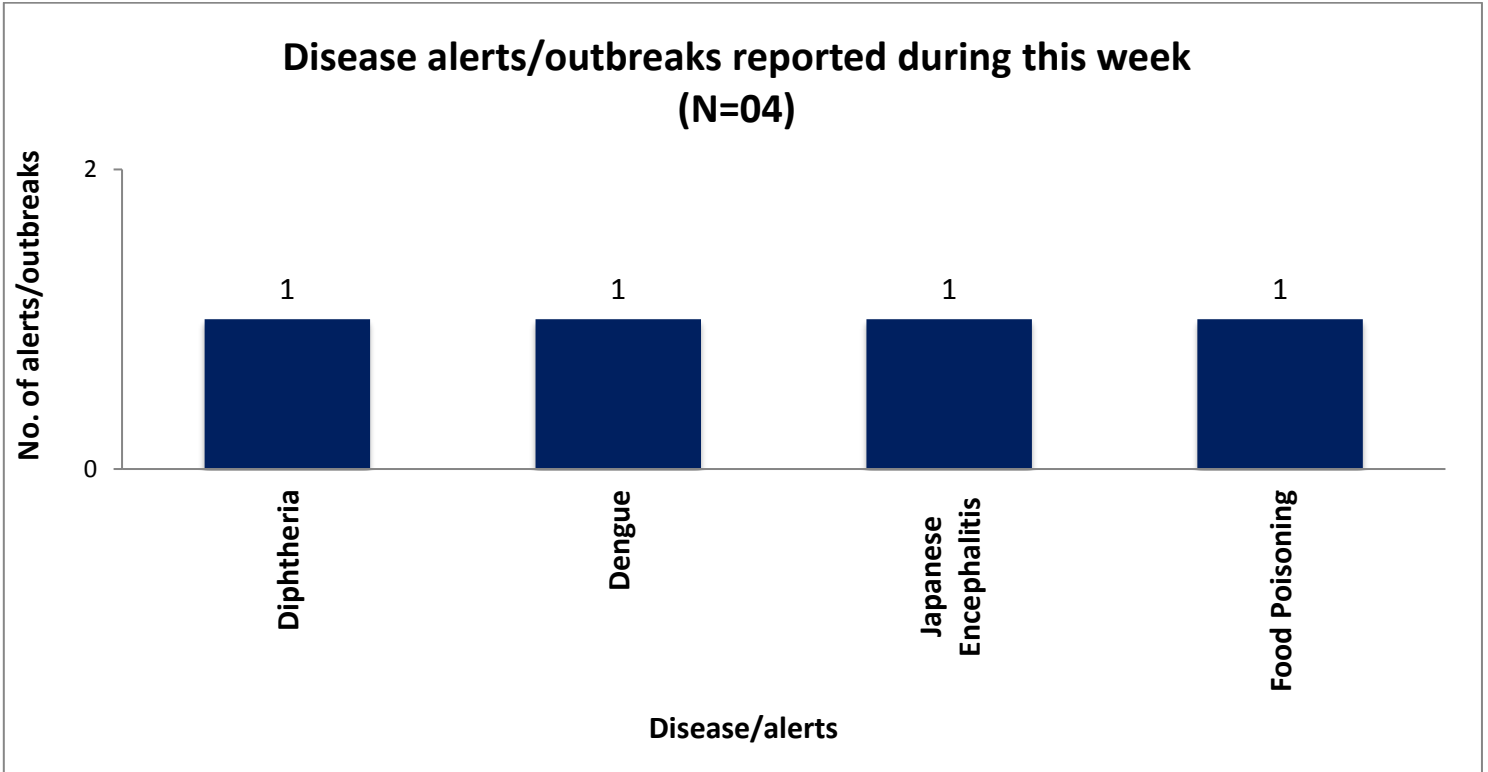
