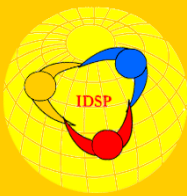

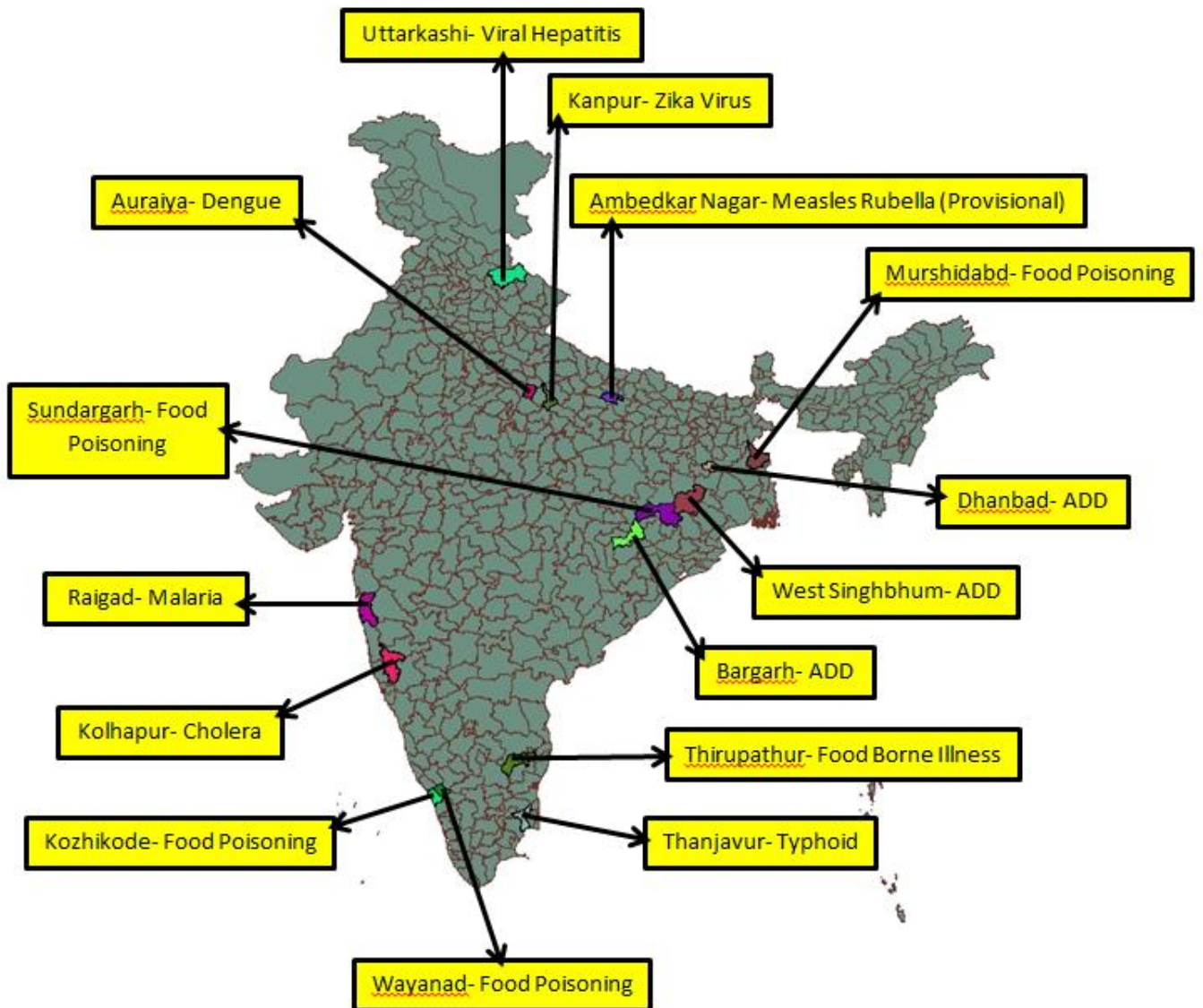

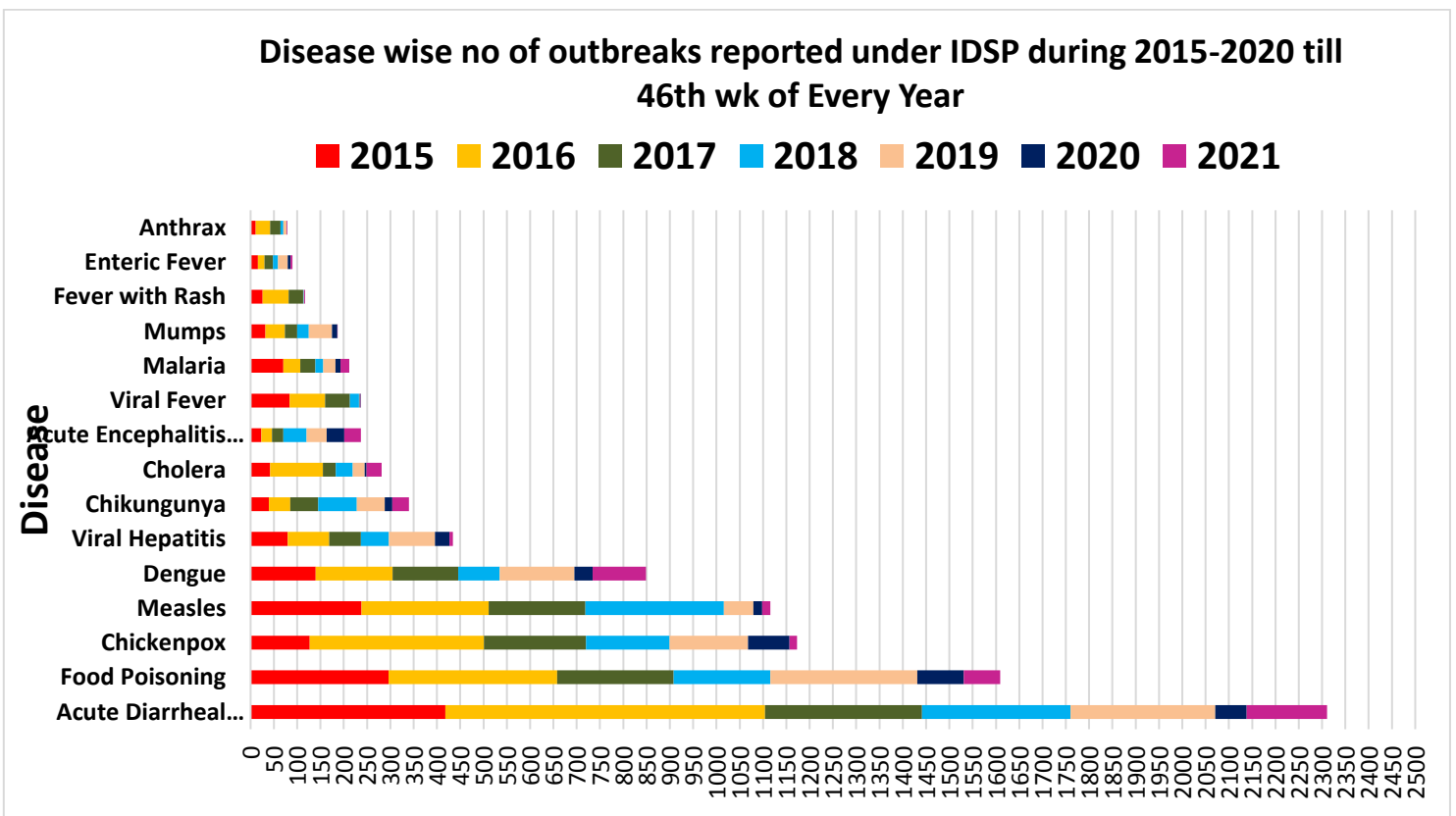

Water analysis showed presence of E coli and coliform count exceeded the limit. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Symptomatic treatment was given to all the cases. Chlorine tablets were distributed. Health education was given regarding importance of safe drinking water.

Symptomatic treatment was given to all the cases. Chlorine tablets were distributed. Health education was given regarding importance of safe drinking water and properly cooked food.

Symptomatic treatment was given to all the cases. Chlorine tablets were distributed. Health education was given regarding importance of safe drinking water

Cases presented with fever and joint pain. 49 blood samples were collected and sent to PHC Lohop Laboratory. Of these, 19 samples were found positive for Malaria by blood smear examination. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Anti-larval spray was used and fogging done. Health education was given regarding importance of vector control measures.

Cases presented with fever and loose stools. 15 blood and five water samples were collected and sent to DPHL Kumbakonam. Of these, nine were found positive for Typhoid by Widal. Three samples were found non – potable for drinking. District RRT investigated the case. Symptomatic treatment was given to all the cases. Chlorine tablets were distributed. Health education was given regarding importance of safe drinking water.

District RRT investigated the outbreak. Anti-larval spray was used and fogging done. Health education was given regarding importance of vector control measures.

Cases presented with fever, abdominal pain, and vomiting. A total of 21 blood samples were collected, six samples were sent to DH Uttarkashi and 15 samples were sent to DPHL Srinagar, Pauri. Of these, six were found positive for Hepatitis A. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.
