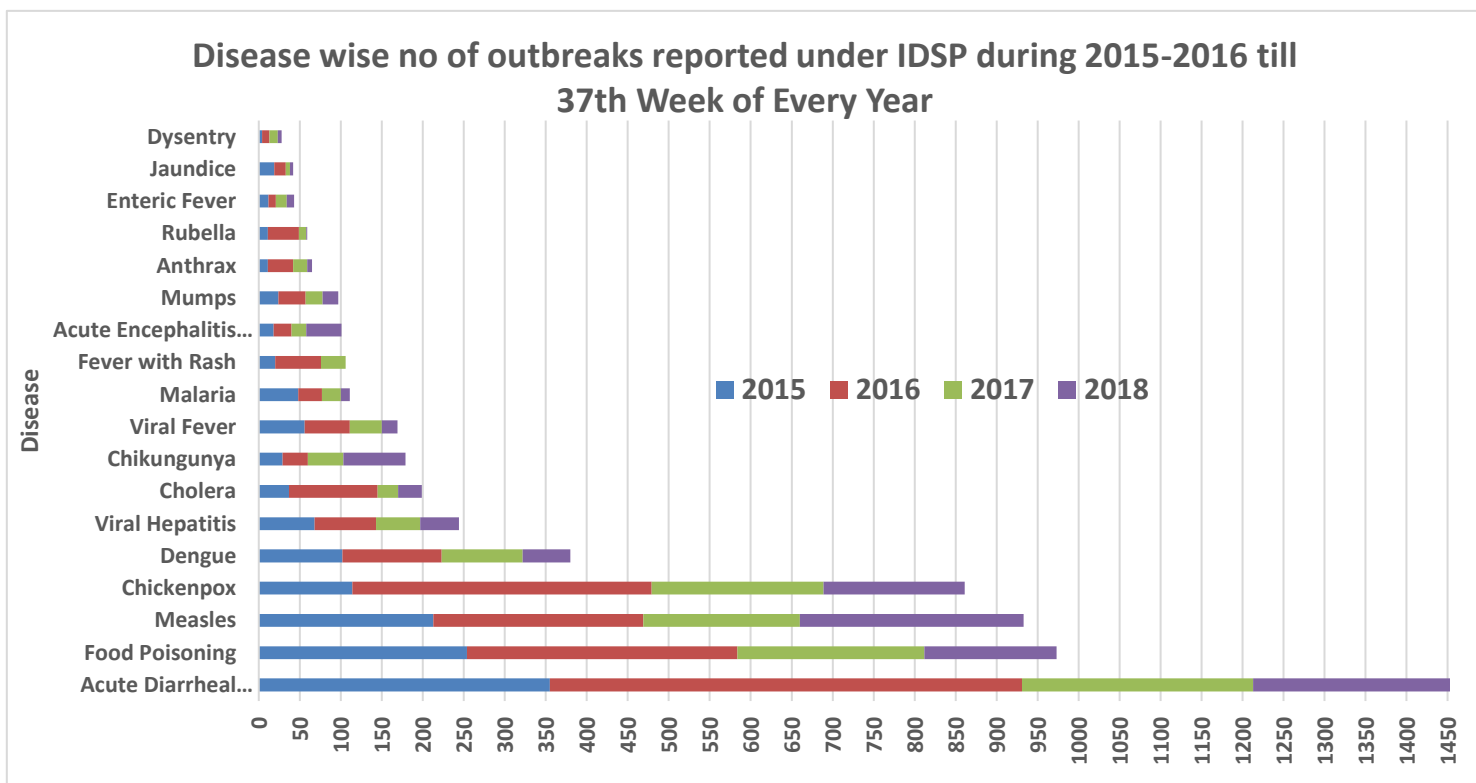
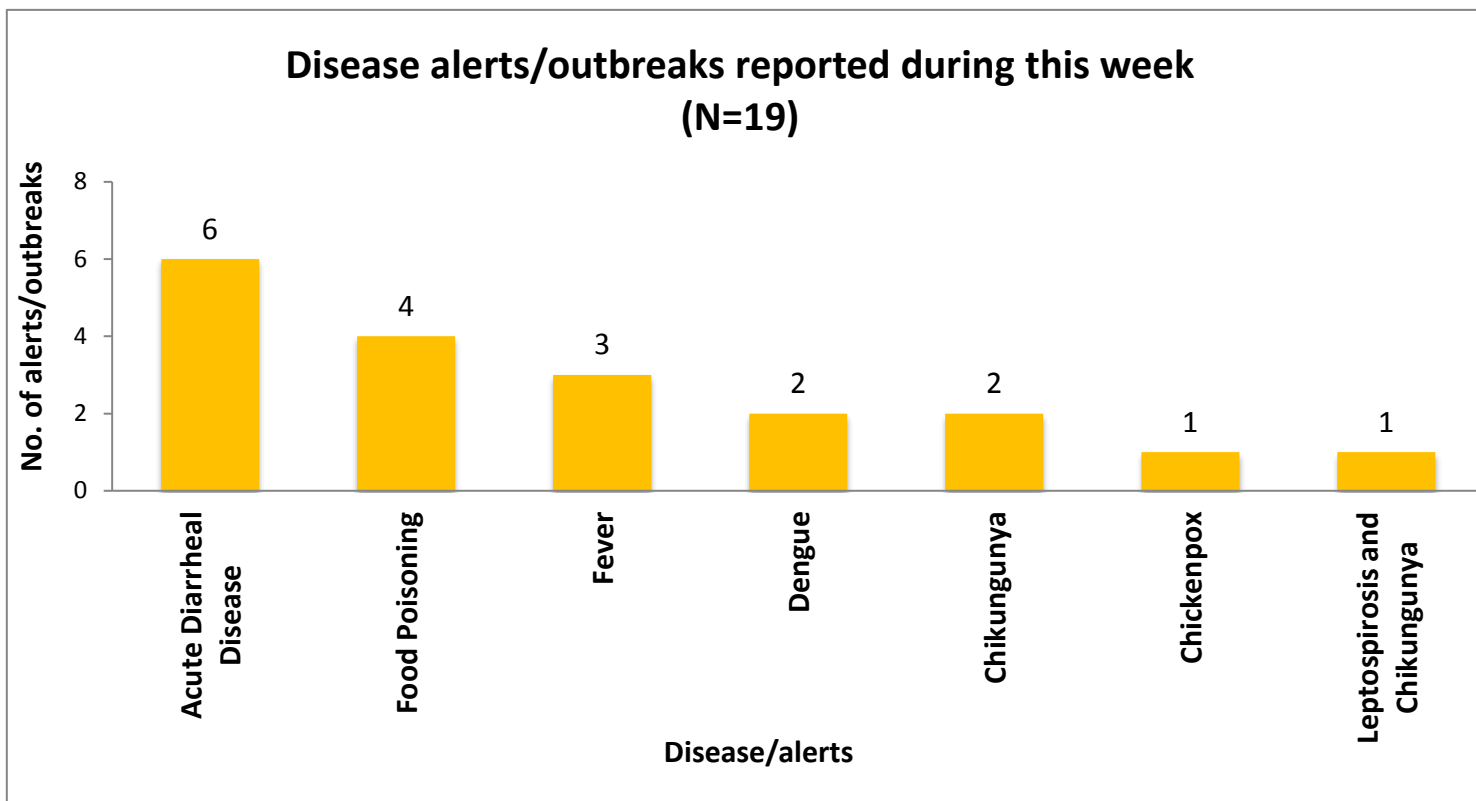

IEC activities regarding Dengue prevention measures are being carried out in the form of Mega phone announcements, Hand bill distribution etc. All cases treated symptomatically. Source reduction activities undertaken. Health education given.

All cases had history of consumption of wild mushroom after which symptoms of vomiting and diarrhea developed. Six patients are admitted in sub Divisional Hospital, CKP for treatment. RRT & Block team visited the affected area. All cases treated with anti-diarrheal drugs and ORS. Health education given.
