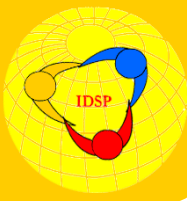

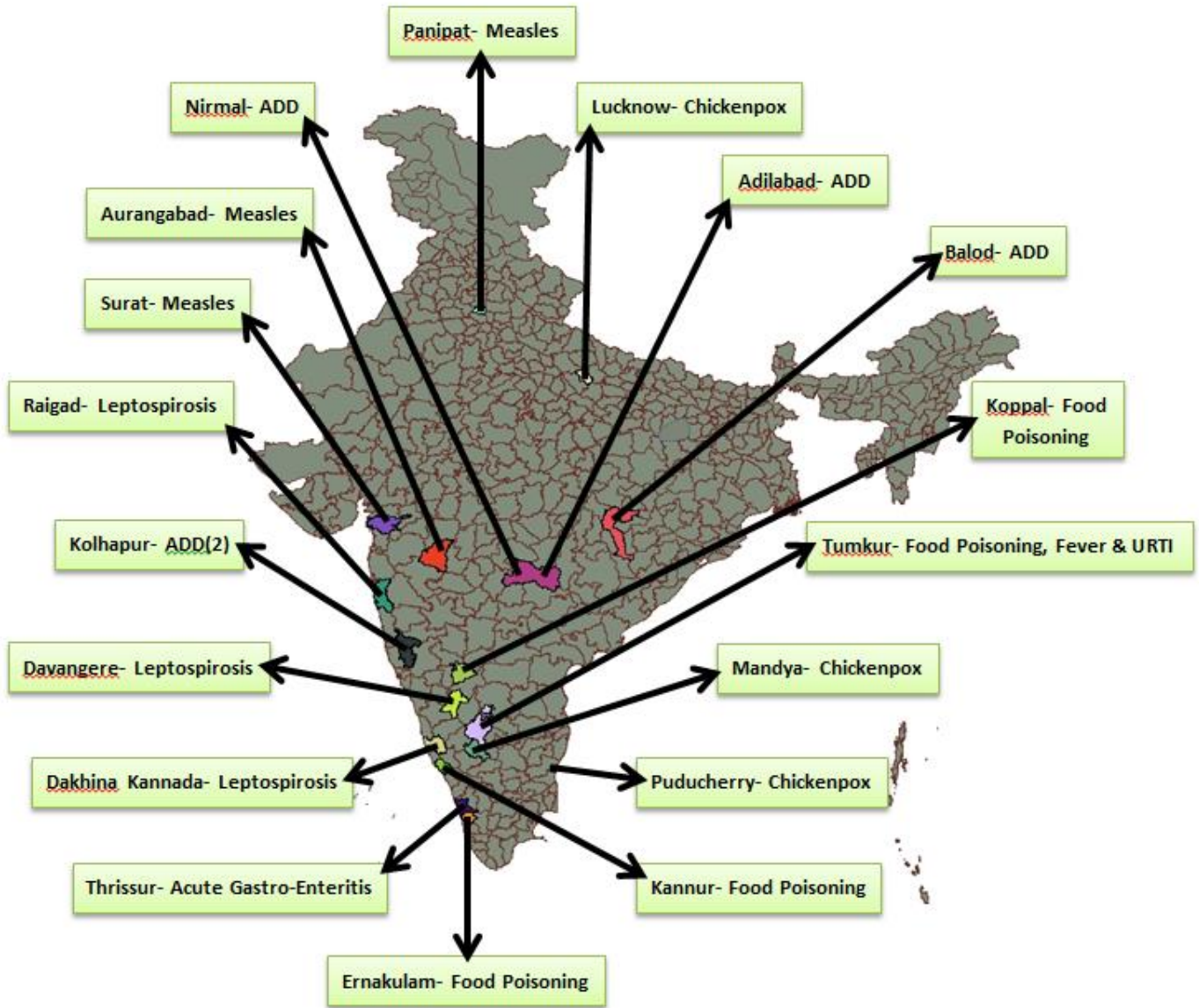

51st Week Map

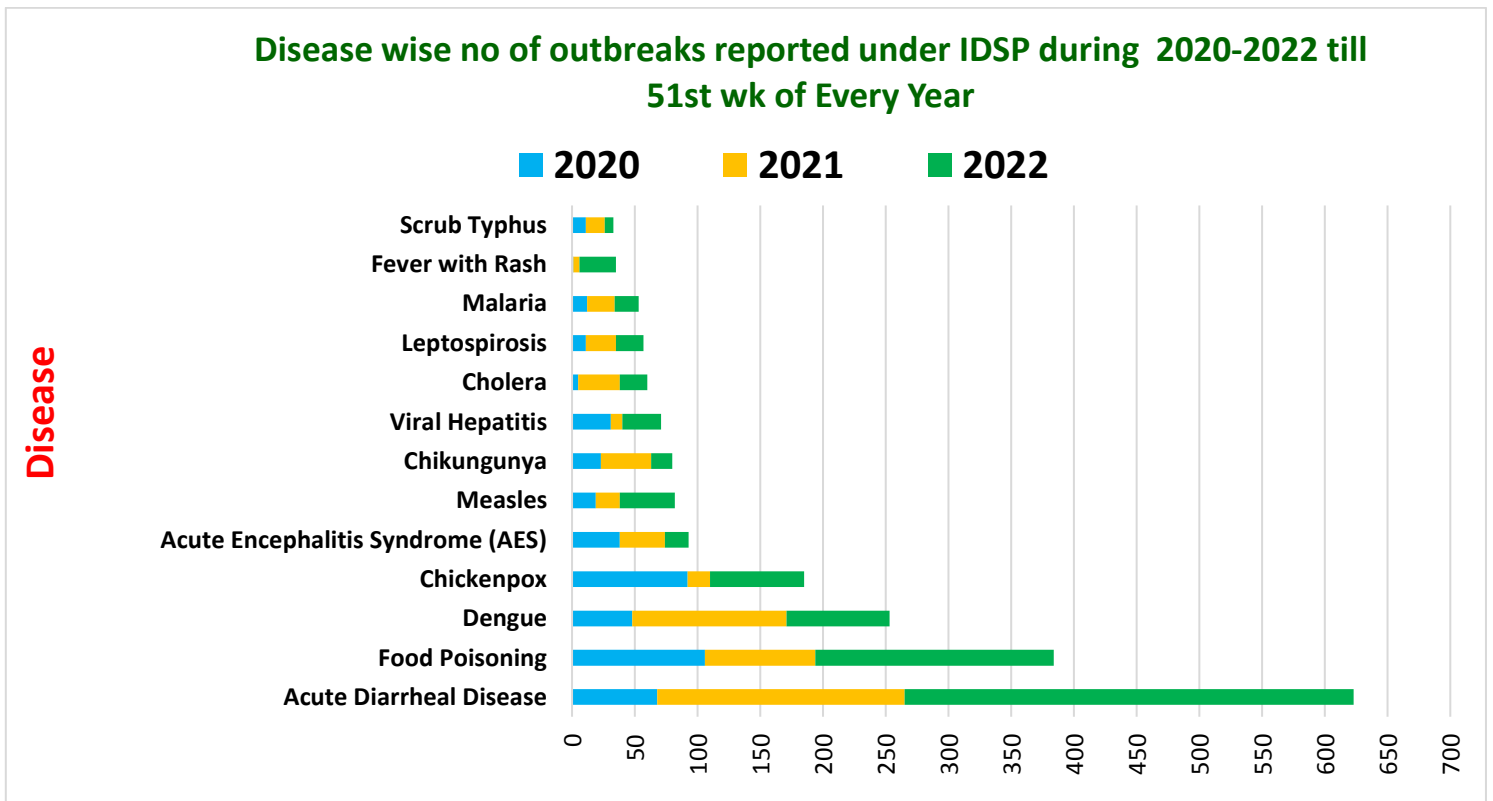
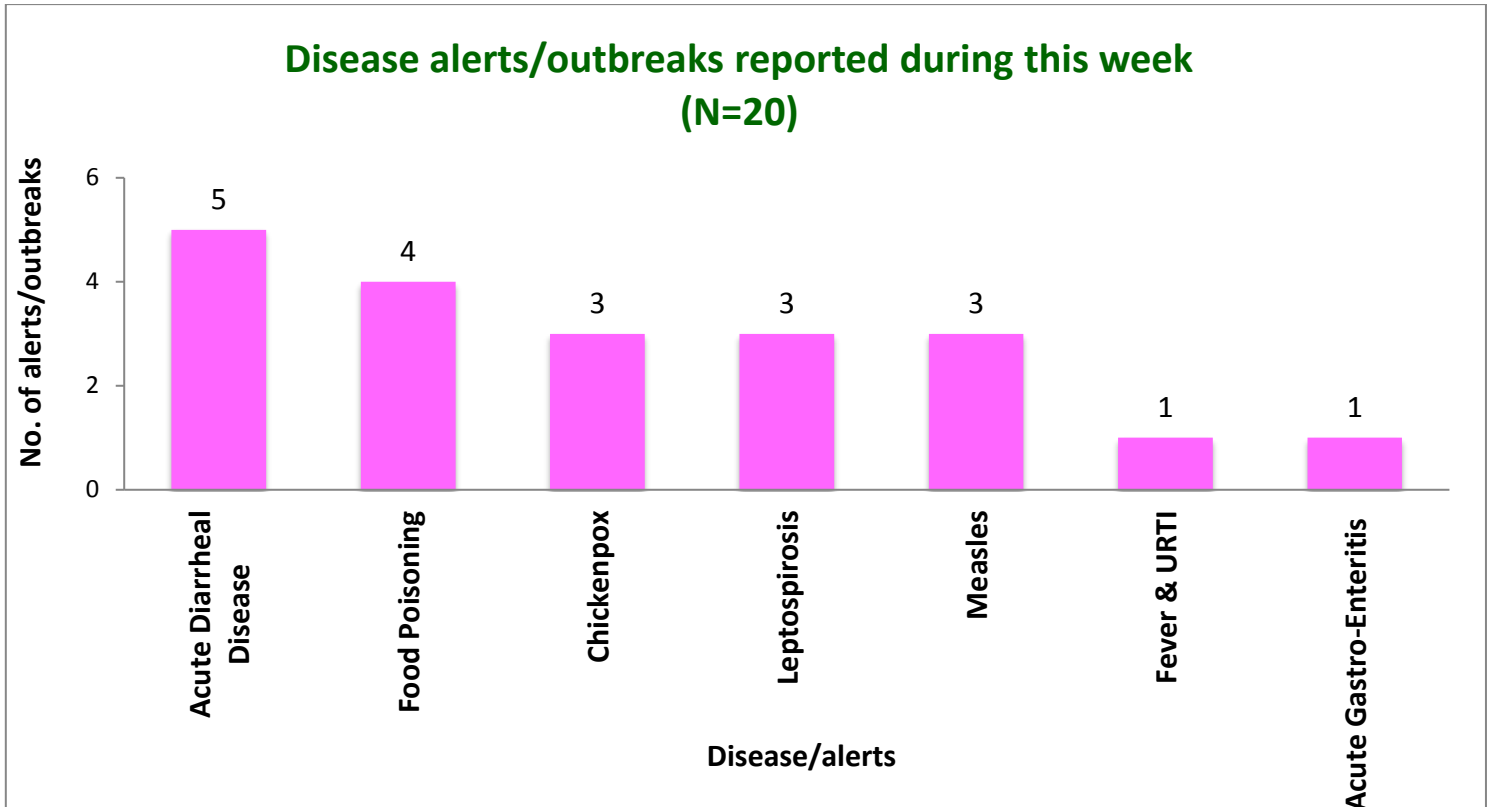

Patient suffered from nausea, breathlessness and tachycardia. One sample collected and sent to Yenapoya Medical College Hospital, tested positive for leptospirosis. The deceased was a 28 years old female. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.

Patient reported with symptoms of fever, cough, pain in the abdomen. One blood sample collected and sent to DPHL Dakshin Kannada, tested positive for leptospirosis. The deceased was a 57years old male. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.

Two water samples collected and sent to DPHL Kolar and found SPP with H2S method. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given and instruction to warden regarding supply of chlorinated & filtered water, maintenance of hygiene while preparing food. proper storage of food grains in the hostel

One Vomitus, Thirteen water and Two stool samples collected, where one vomitus sample showed no growth after 48 hours of incubation, out of 13 water samples, six samples found to be non-potable by MPN Test and no enteric bacterial pathogens isolated in stool samples. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.

District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given. Chlorination of water supplies was carried out.

District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given. Surveillance for more cases & Immunization Session was conducted. Mobilization by Local leaders during RI Sessions. IEC done by involvement of local leaders, Maulana of Masjids & Private practioners, miking done by Maulana at Masjid during Namaz, message was shared in Gujarati and Hindi Language.

Seven blood samples have been sent to NIV, Mumbai unit for examination where four samples were found measles positive. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given. Rapid Fever Survey was conducted. Special Isolation Ward has been set up for the treatment of the measles patients, special vaccination drive conducted in the affected areas.

District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given. Valve leakages were repaired, House to house survey and chlorination of water samples carried out. Rapid & Daily Surveillance carried out from the onset of cases, Interruption of transmission by preventing the disease through Personal Protection, Health campaign through Davandi and Health Education, Symptomatic & prophylaxis Treatment of cases done, IEC activities strengthened.
MH/KOP/2022/51/1015	Maharashtra	Kolhapur	Acute Diarrheal Disease	50	00	05-12-2022	Under Control	Cases reported from PO- Blewadi masa/Allabad, SC: Blewadi masa, PHC: Senpati Kapashi, Tal: Kagal, Dist: Kolhapur with symptoms of loose motion, abdominal pains, weakness etc. Eight water samples and four stool samples were collected and sent to DPHL where all eight water samples were found to be contaminated but no organisms were grown in stool culture. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given. Active identification & controlling source of infection. Valve leakages were repaired, House to house survey and chlorination of water samples carried out Rapid & Daily Surveillance carried out from the onset of cases, Interruption of transmission by preventing the disease through Personal Protection, Health campaign through Davandi and Health Education, Symptomatic & prophylaxis Treatment of cases done, IEC activities strengthened.

The deceased was Mr. Shankar Posu Patil, 90 year old male. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given. Rapid Fever Survey was conducted. IEC about not going to the field barefoot provided.

The index case 6 yr old male child, student of GPS Vadamangalam, traced to Murungan koil street on 22nd Nov 2022. His mother suffered from Herpes Zoster for one week. Out of the 15 affected 3 children belonged to neighbouring Tamilnadu area and after line listing cross notified. The school children were screened for signs and symptoms of the chicken pox on 30th Nov 2022. Directorate of Education informed of the incidence and School closed for a week and disinfected. Active case search maintained for a period of 28 days. All cases isolated and managed symptomatically. All the school children of GPS Vadmangalam immunized for age. Relevant IEC/BCC activities carried out.
UP/LKW/2022/51/1018	Uttar Pradesh	Lucknow	Chickenpox	05	00	09-12-2022	Under Control	Cases reported from village- Kesari Kheda, Kudha, Mohanlalganj with fever and rash. 4 Samples out of total five were found positive for Varicella Zoster Virus. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given. A medical team under Dr Ashok Kumar, with LT & BHW was constituted and visited the affected area. Essential medicines have been distributed in the village. House to house surveillance has been done.
