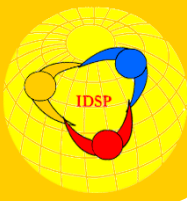

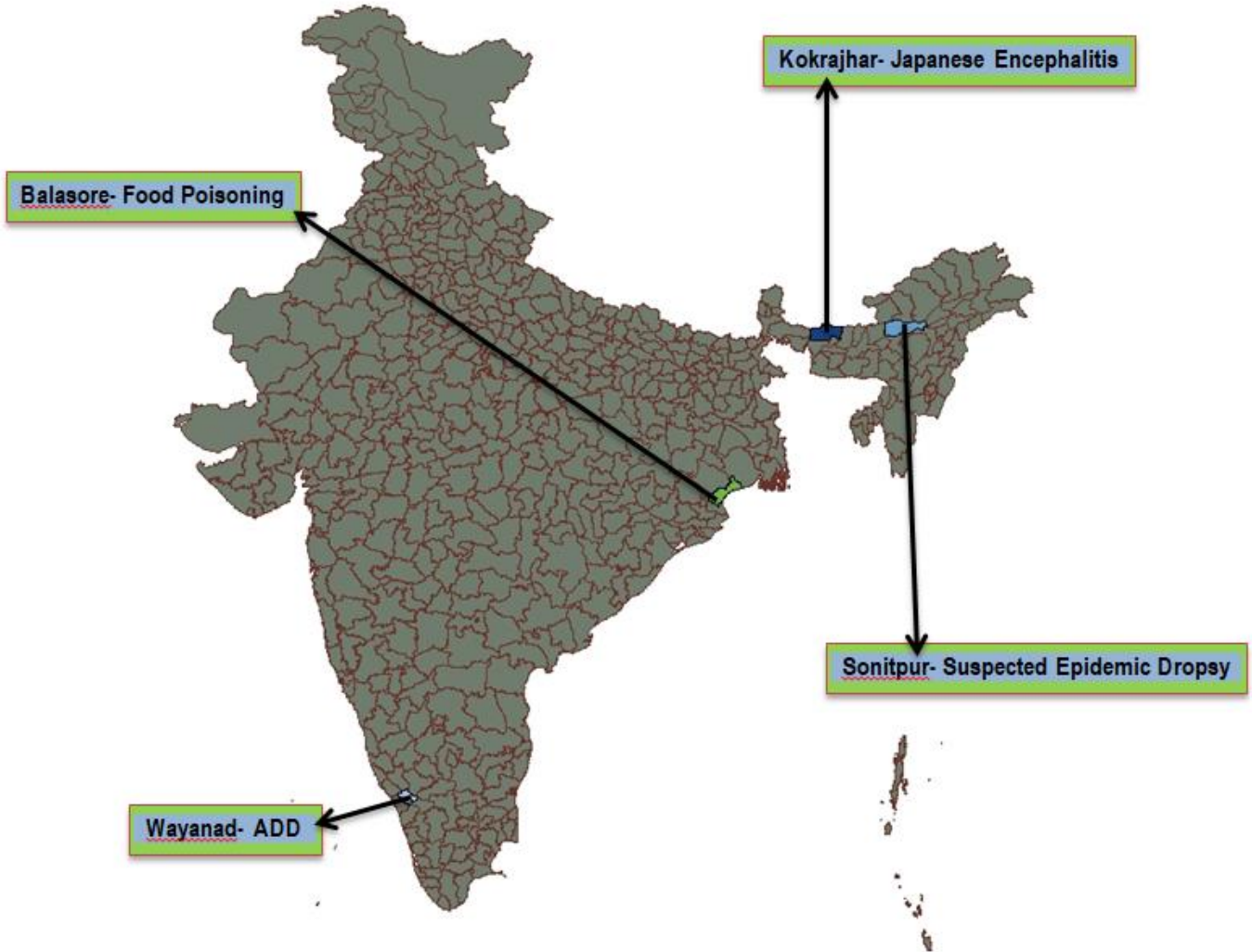

33rd Week Map

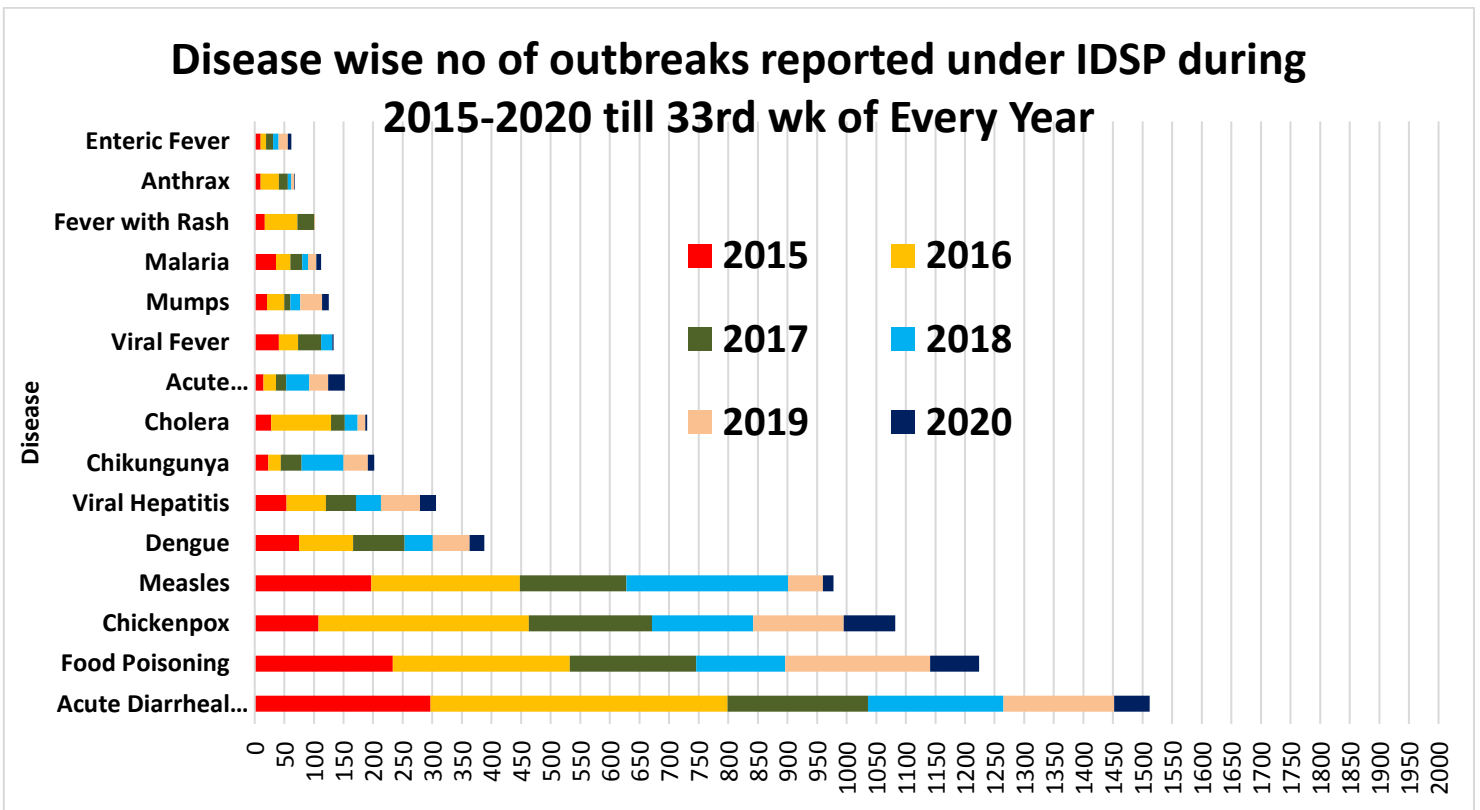
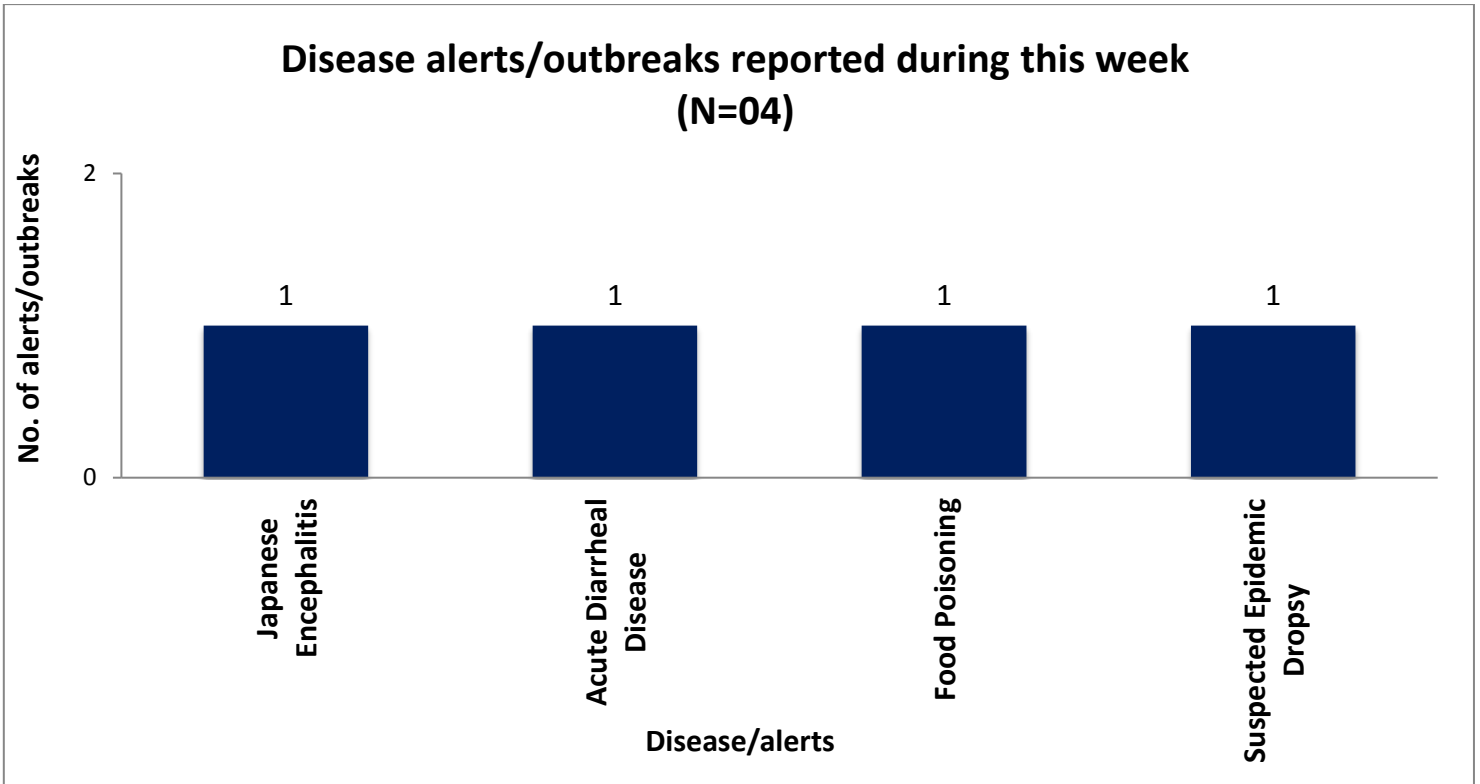

All cases treated. Health education given on food adulteration.
KL/WYN/2020/33/406	Kerala	Wayanad	Acute Diarrheal Disease	31	00	10-08-20	13-08-20	Under Control	Cases reported from Ukkalikalaval colony HSC/PHC Appad, CHC/Block Meenagady. District RRT investigated the outbreak. House to house survey conducted. Cases presented with fever, loose stools and vomiting. It was observed that people were practicing open defecation and not following hand hygiene. All cases treated. Medical camp organized in the affected area. Health education given.
OR/BSR/2020/33/407	Odisha	Balasore	Food Poisoning	24	00	15-08-20	16-08-20	Under Control	Cases reported from Village Laikhyanapur and Totapada, SC Dumagandira, GP Begunia, CHC Berhampur, Block Nilgiri. District RRT investigated the outbreak. House to house survey conducted. Cases presented with pain abdomen, loose stools, vomiting and fever after consuming food in a social gathering. All cases were treated. Halogen tablets and ORS packets were distributed in the affected area. Health education given on water hygiene and hand hygiene.

Case treated. Fogging done in the affected area. Health education given
