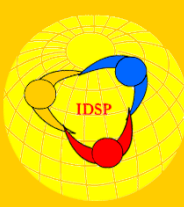

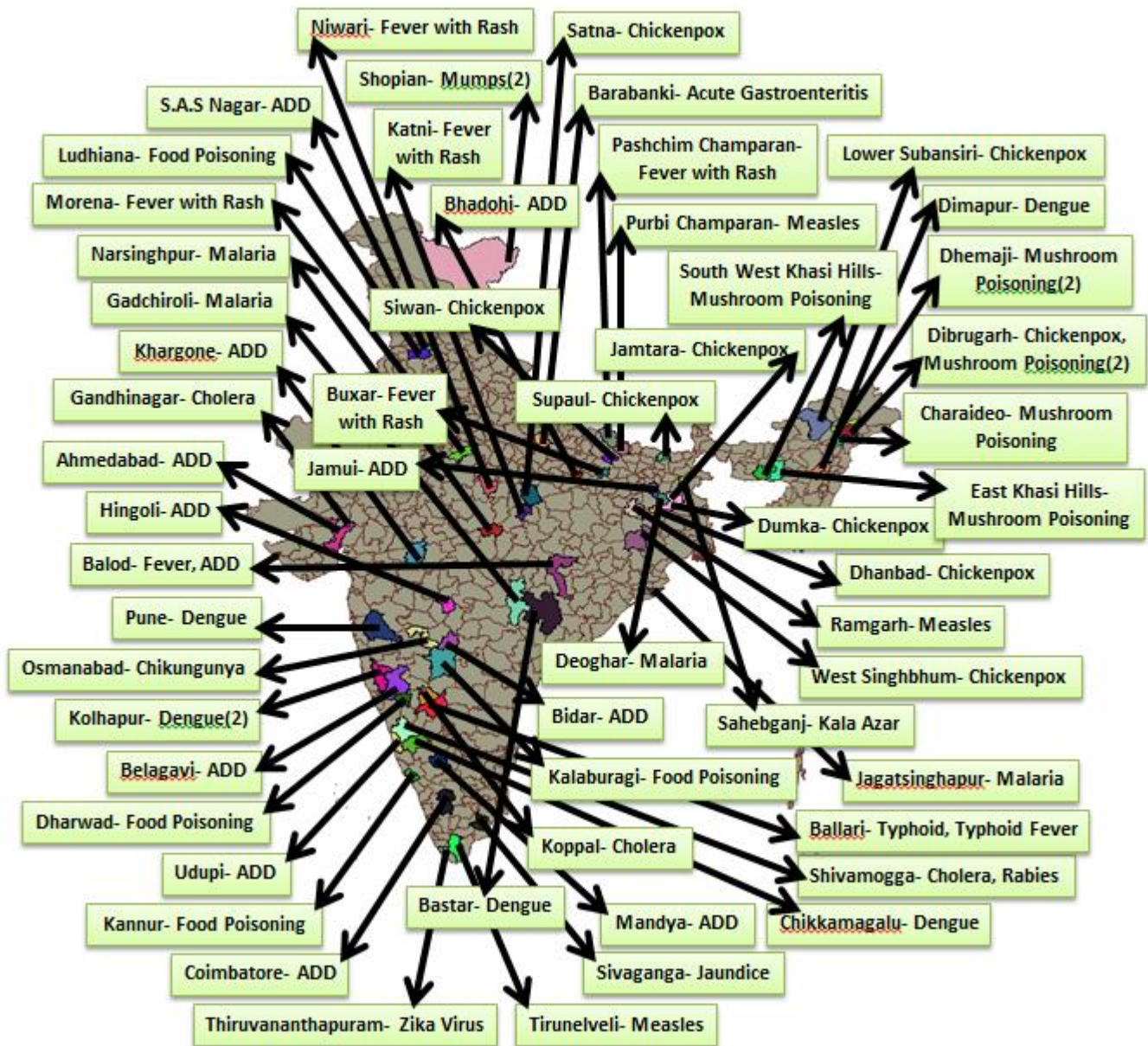

25th Week Map

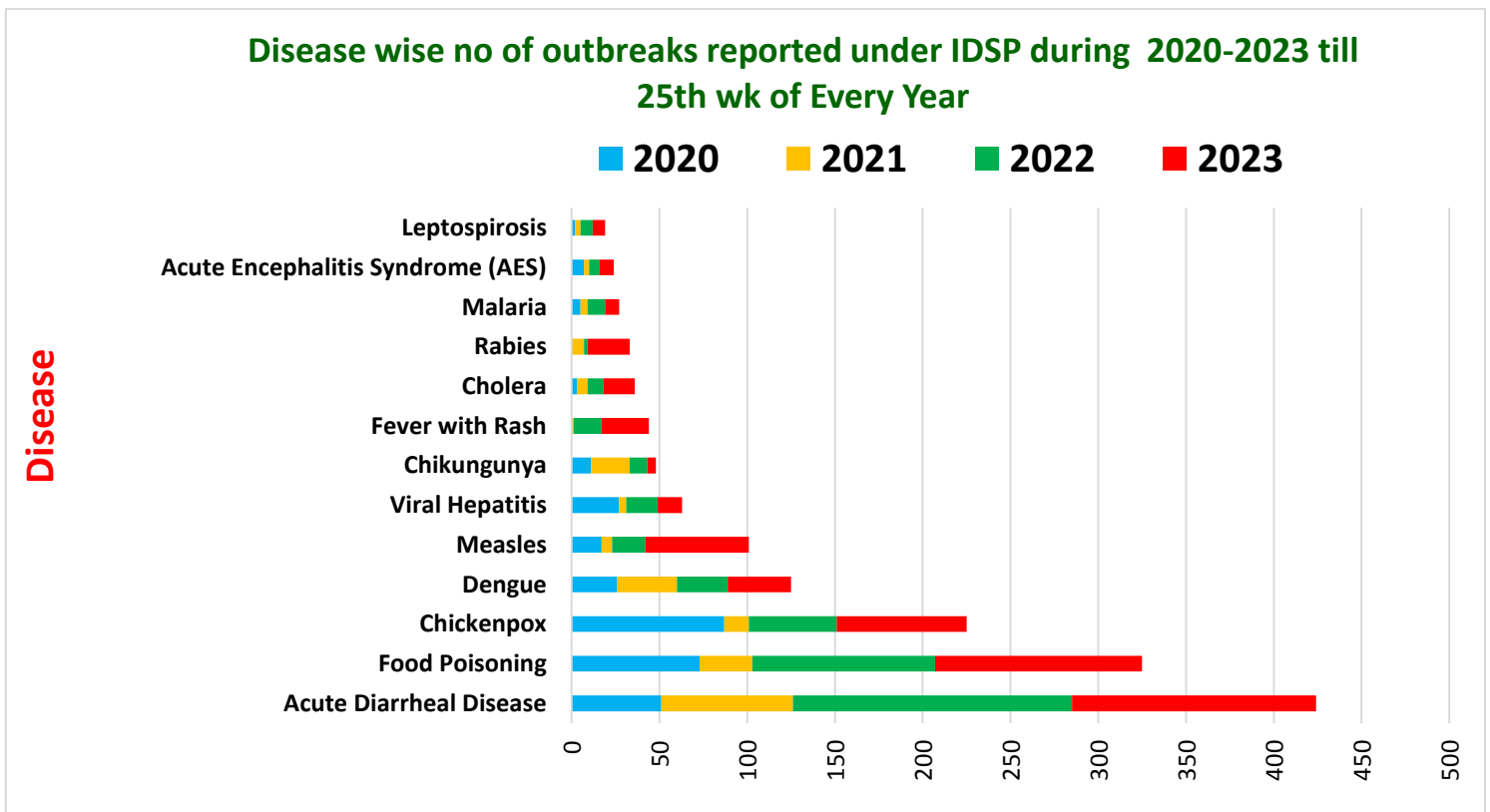
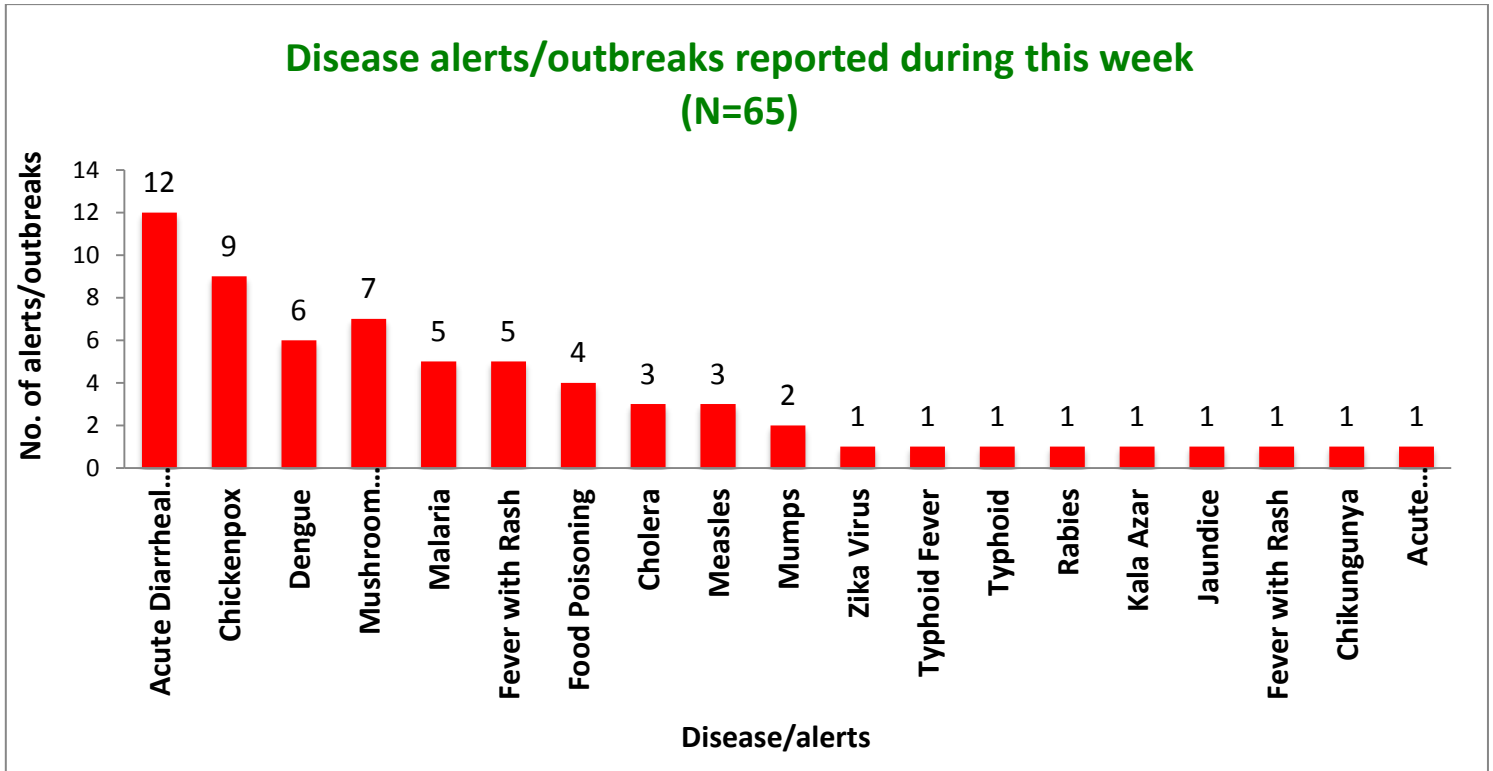
