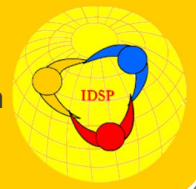

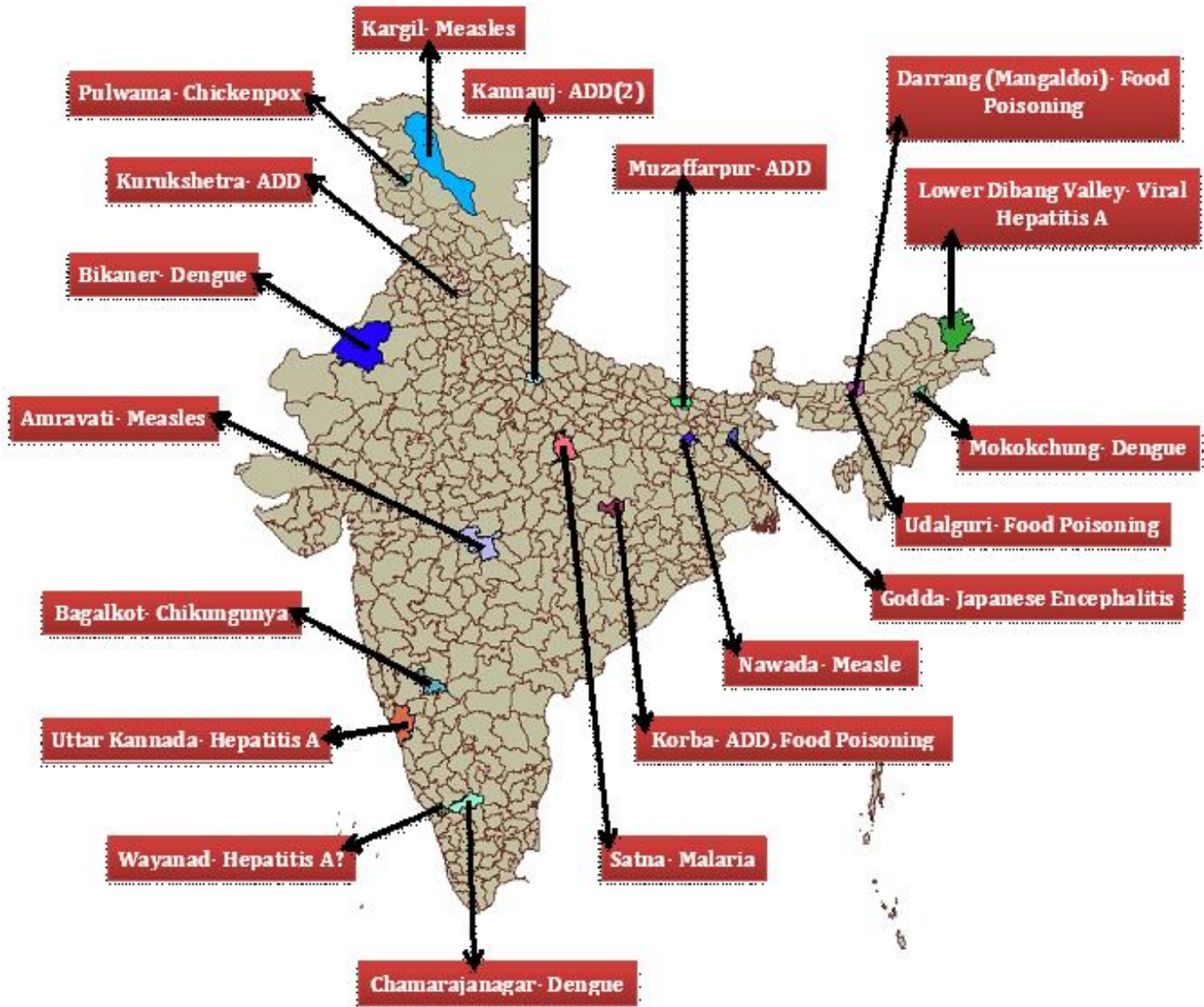

41<sup>st</sup> Week Map

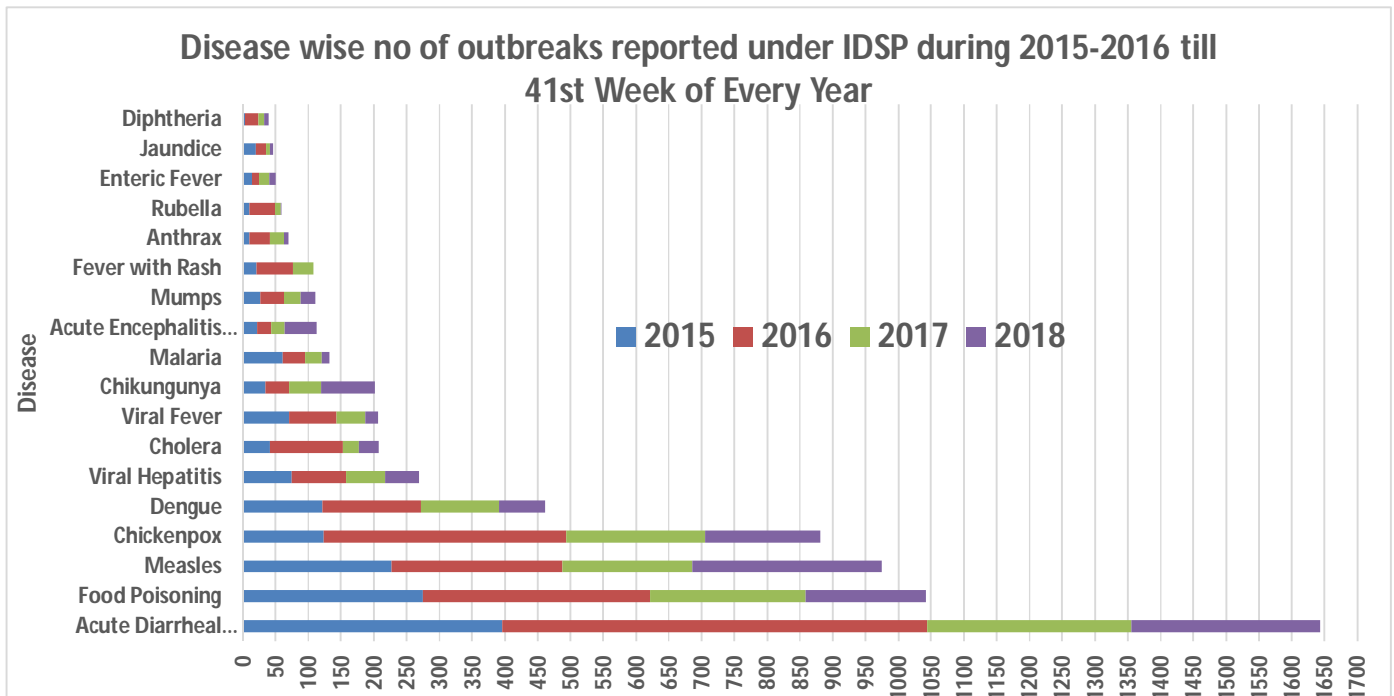
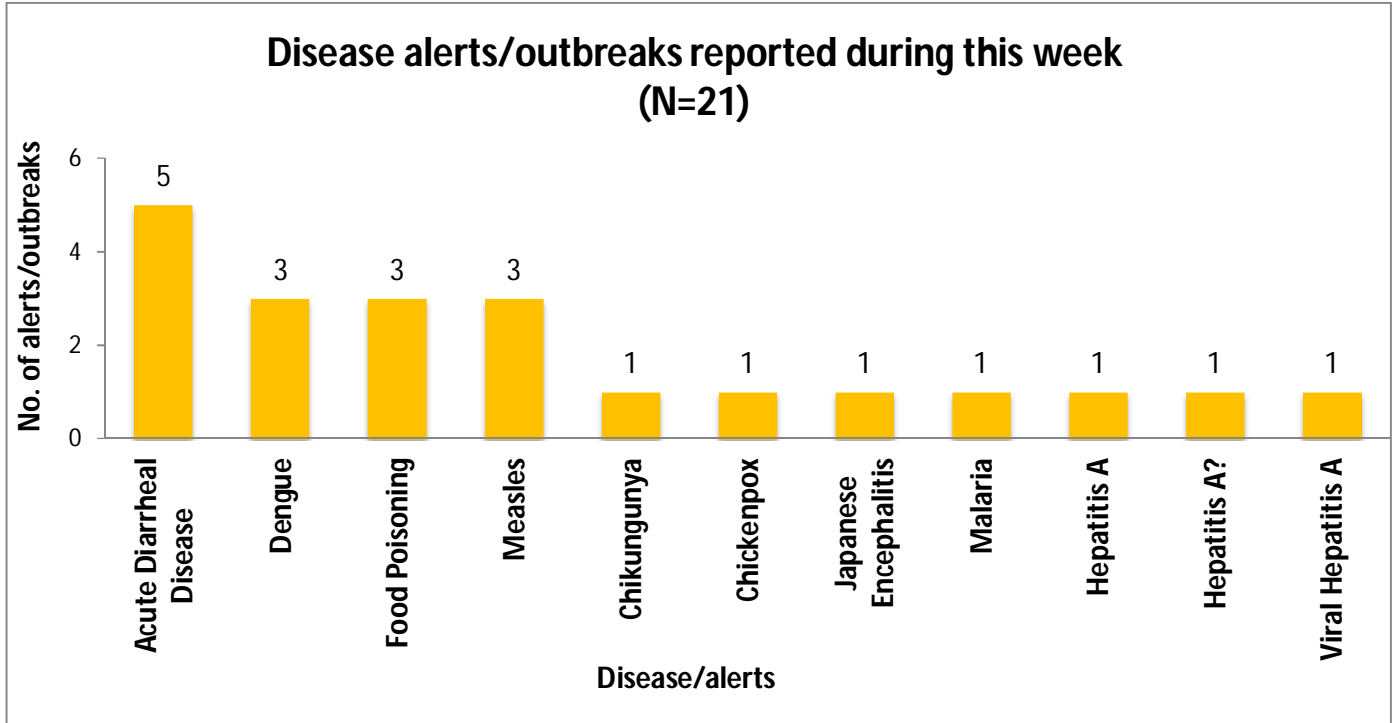
