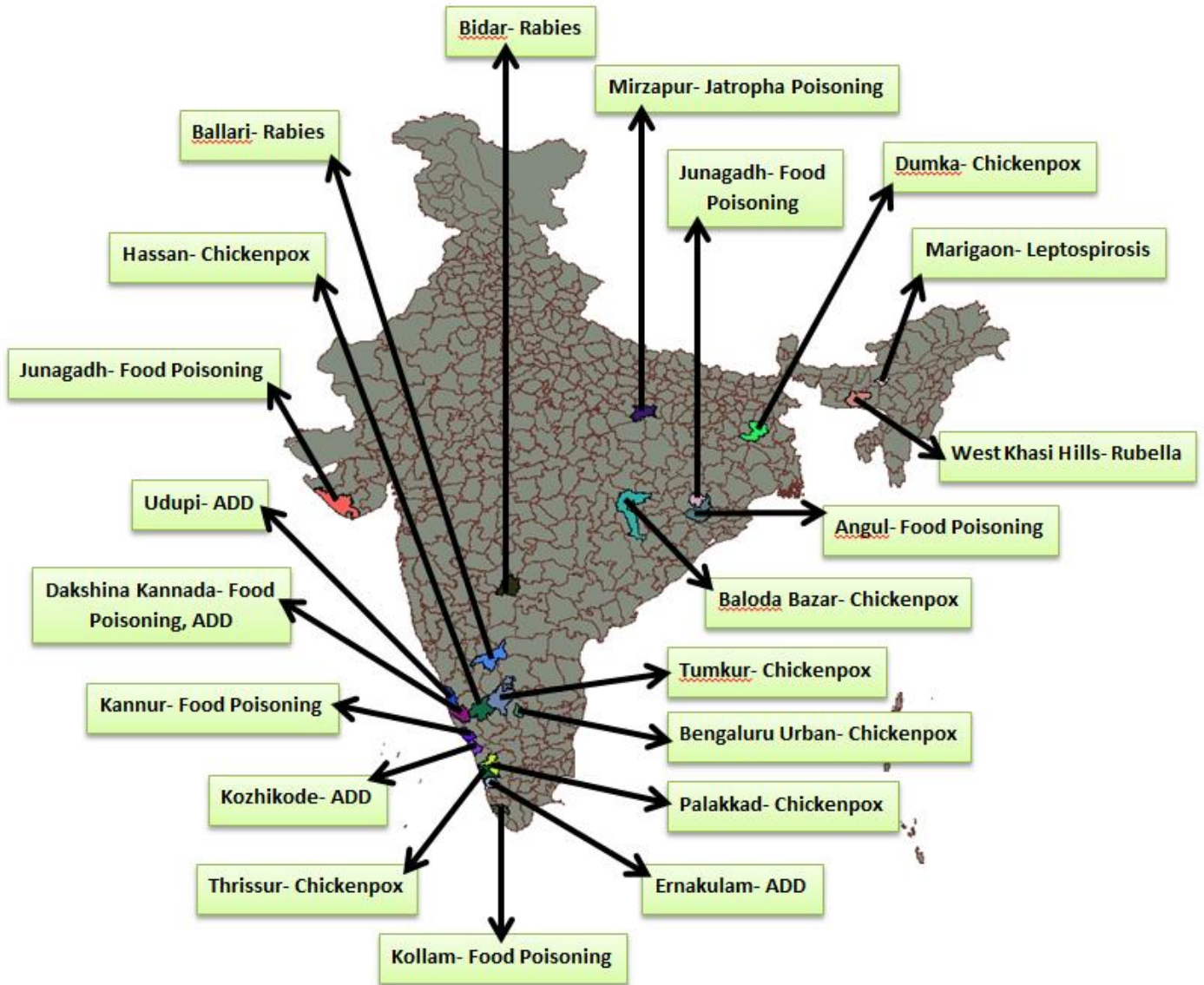

6th Week Map

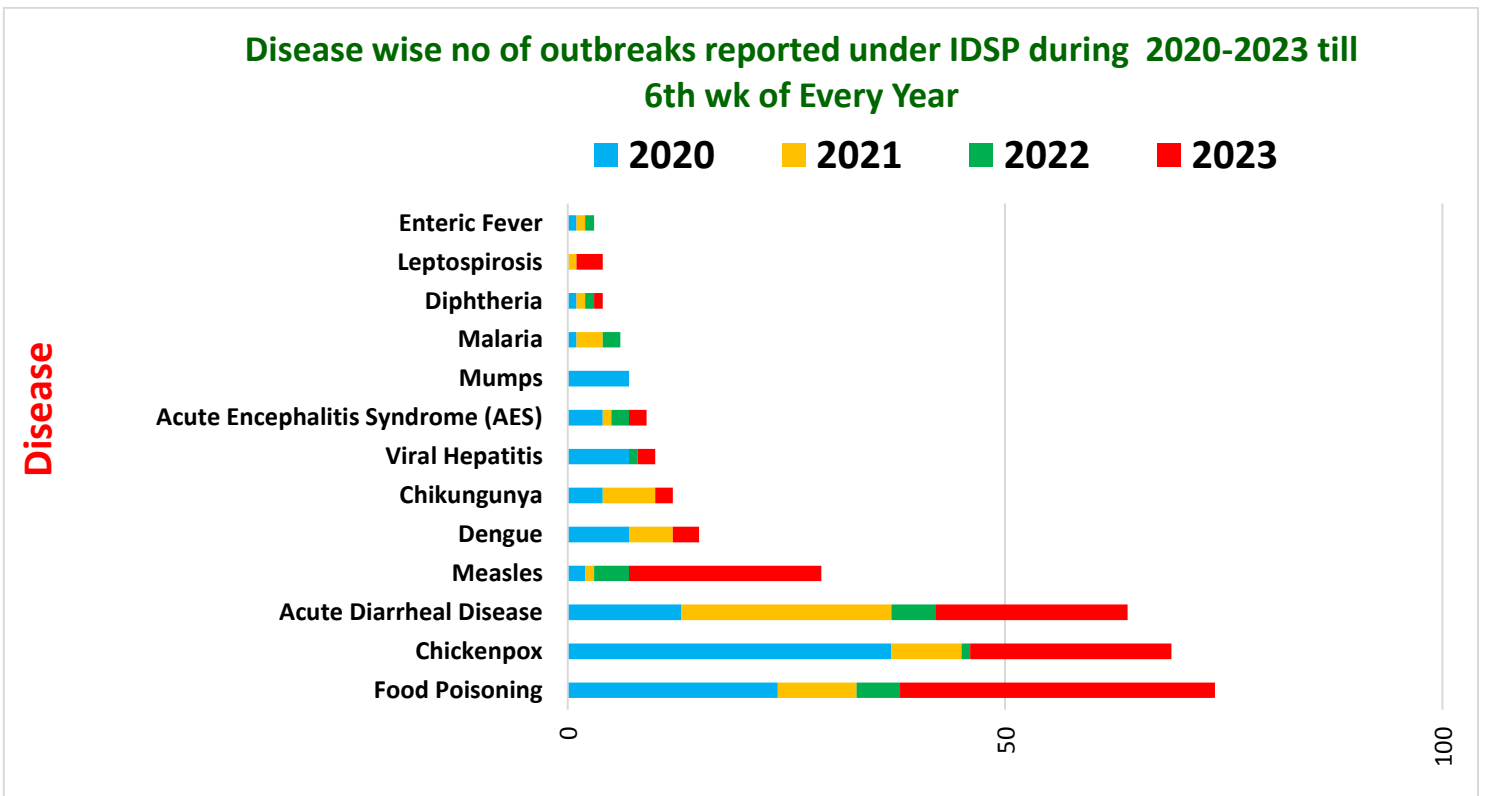
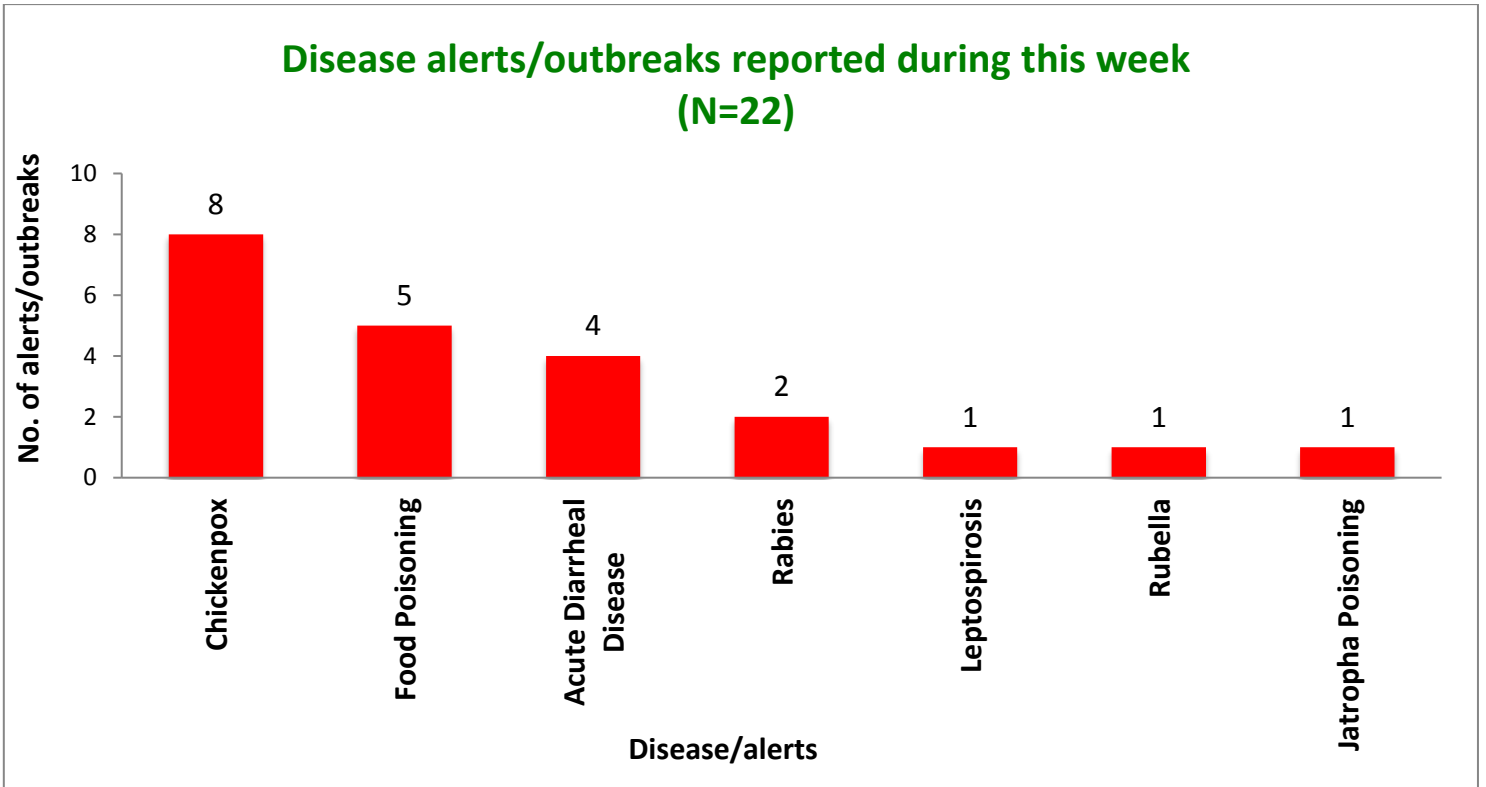

Health education was imparted.

Health education was imparted regarding the importance of personal hygiene. IEC-like muniyadi activity performed. All the symptomatic cases were treated symptomatically. Calamine lotion, antiviral drugs were distributed. Affected children were isolated. School staff, students, and their parents were sensitized about the symptoms of chickenpox its transmission, prevention and control. Letter issued to all blocks regarding Chickenpox Cases identification, treatment and their reporting in IHIP/IDSP section.

Health education was imparted.

Three blood samples collected and all found IgM Chickenpox positive. District rapid response team visited the site and investigated the outbreak. Health education was imparted. Cases were isolated and symptomatic treatment given.

Total seven Samples collected, five serum samples sent to NIV for Measles and Rubella testing, found negative for both and two serum samples sent to BMCRI for Chickenpox, found positive for chickenpox by IgM ELISA. District RRT team investigated the outbreak, the age group affected was found to be of 7 to 8 years. Cases have been isolated. 2nd standard classroom where most of the cases reported was sanitized. IEC and Health Education regarding communicable diseases were given. House to house survey of fever with rashes done.

Patient had symptoms of giddiness, hydrophobia and localized weakness. It was clinically suspected rabies case. The deceased was a 60 years old male. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Prophylactic dose given to all family members, informed gram panchayat to vaccinate all the stray dogs regularly. Health education given to public and school children and anganwadi teachers regarding the dog bite and prophylactic treatment. Health education was given. .

Among these 21 cases, one case had symptoms of rabies on 18-02-2023 and was referred to NIMHANS, Bangalore on 19-02-2023. CSF and Saliva samples were collected which tested negative. The deceased was a 3 years old female child. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education given. Sufficient availability of ARV & ARS in the institution was ensured. House to house survey to generate the line list of Suspected Rabid dog bite cases was carried out. IEC activities regarding wound washing and management, importance of ARV in Animal bite condition and completing the vaccine schedule was imparted. PEP and clinical history of all the suspected Dog bite cases was reviewed. Interdepartmental meeting with city corporation commissioner, supervisor & counselor and staff was conducted at UPHC Ashraya colony, 30th ward, C B Ballari, co- ordination with veterinary department and NGO in dog restraining activities (Mass Vaccination and sterilization) was suggested.

Also one stool samples collected and sent to DPHL, Dakshina Kannada, in which no entero pathogens were isolated. Out of 10 water samples collected, 9 found not suitable for potable purpose. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given. Special team was deputed at the hostel for examining remaining students at the hostel.

First batch of 89 student's studying in class 3 & 4 and second batch of 78 students, studying in class 5 & 6 visited this park on 08.02.2023 & 09.02.2023 respectively. They had vegetable biriyani brought from outside and also Pickled mango, Pineapple and Gooseberry brought from shop inside the park after which they started having vomiting and diarrhea. Two water and stool samples collected and Sent to RPH Lab, Presence of Coliforms detected in water samples, No pathogens isolated in stool samples.
