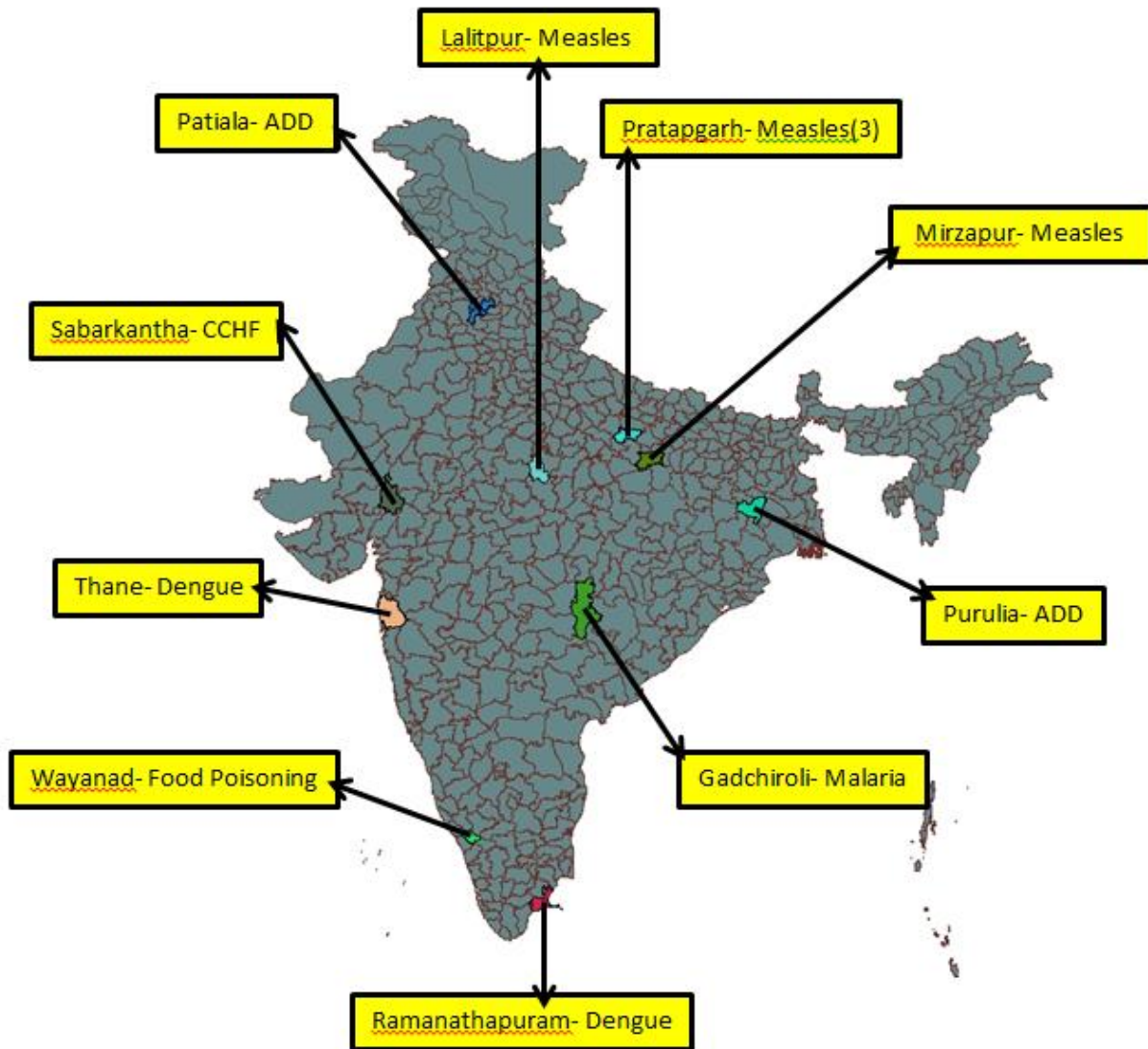

44th Week Map

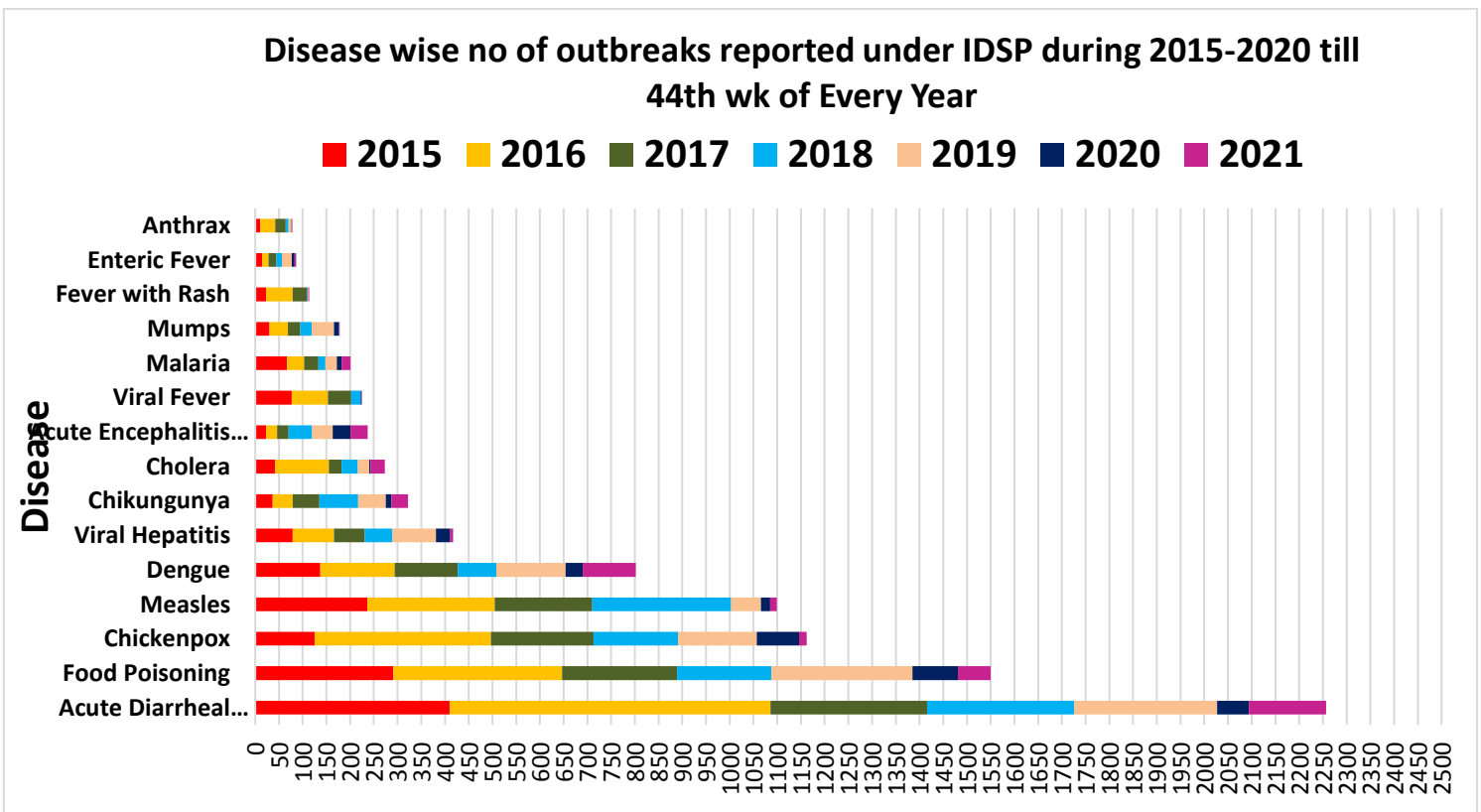
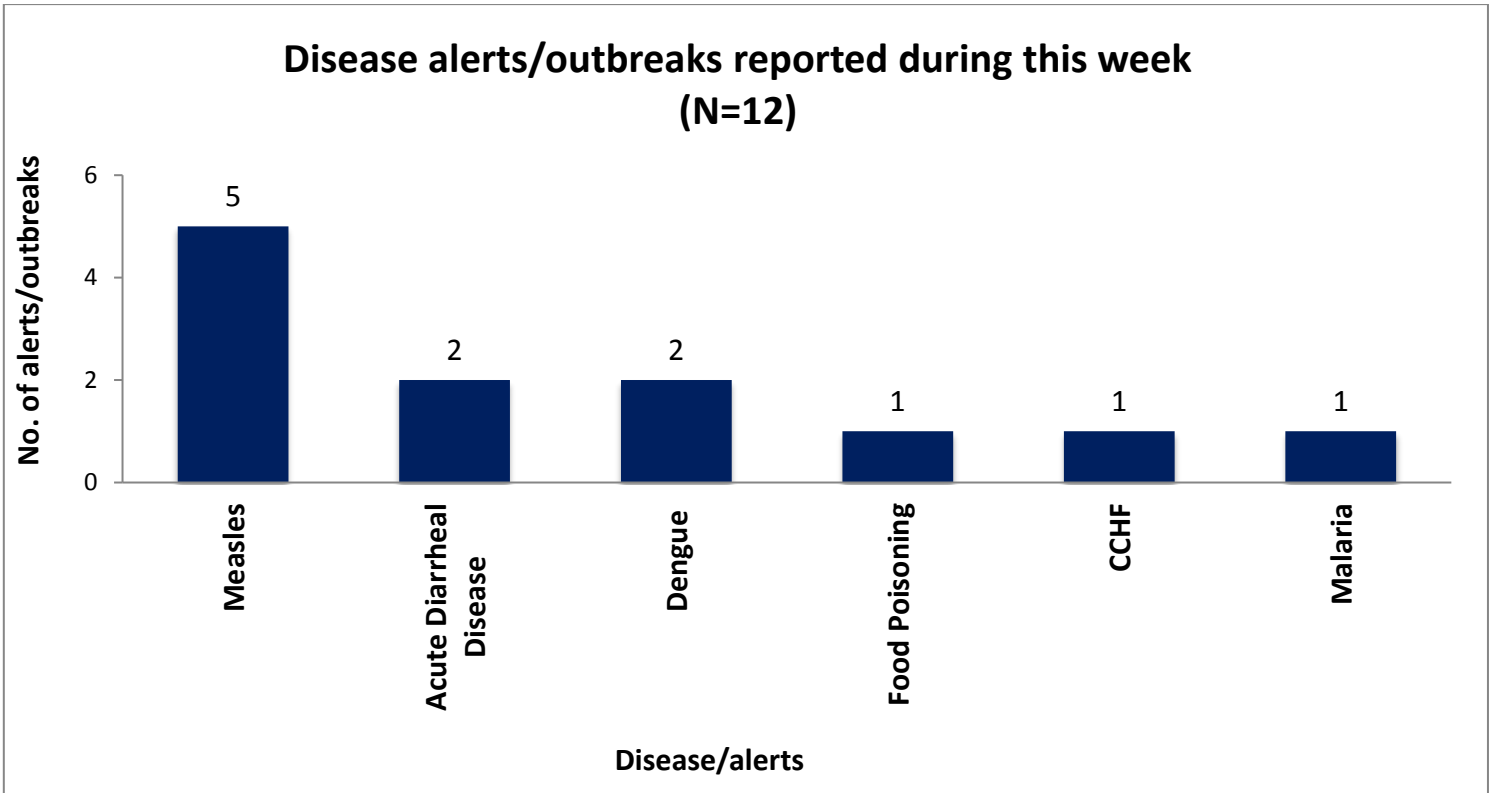
