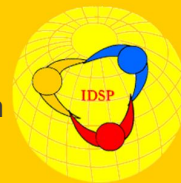
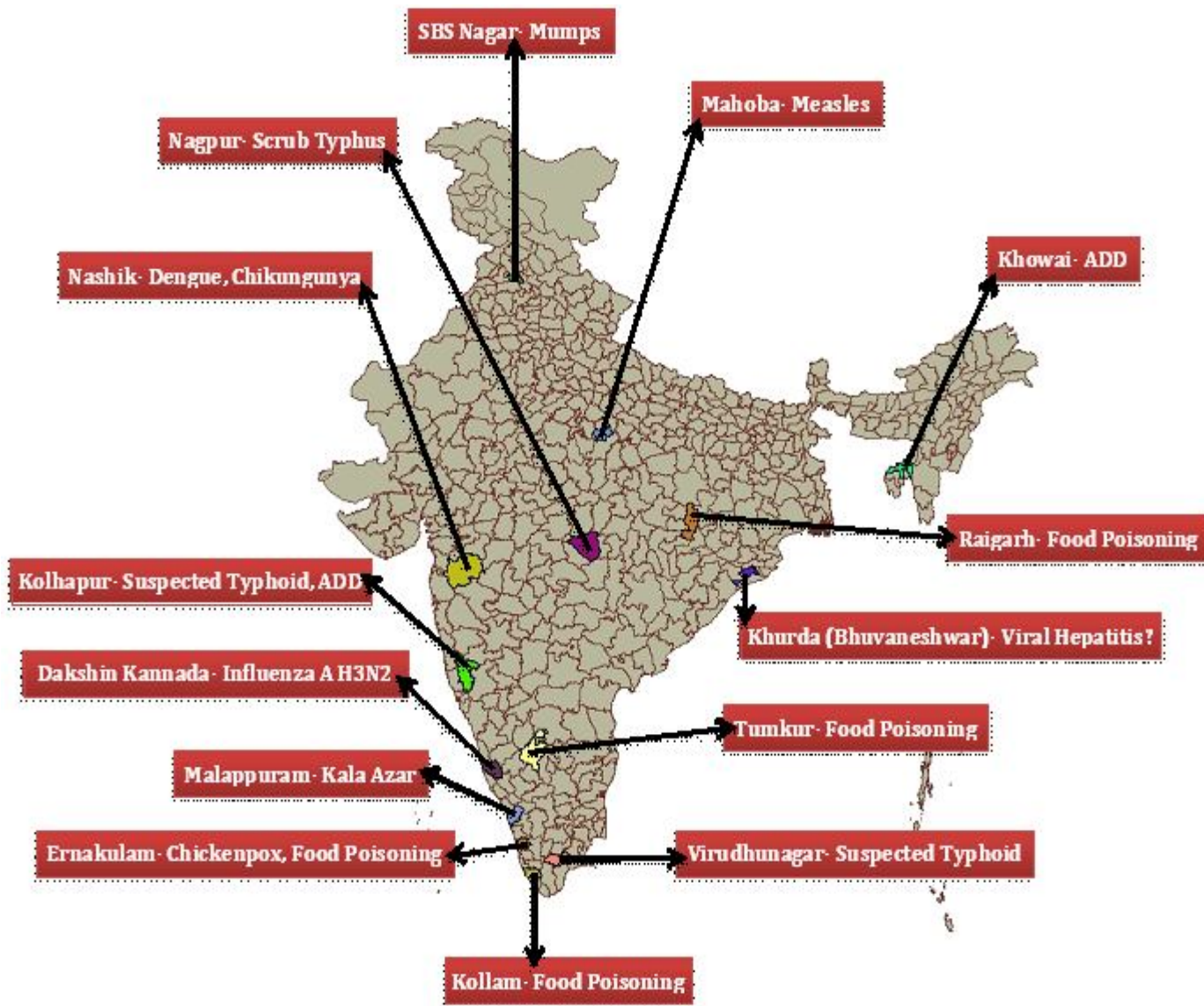

47th Week Map

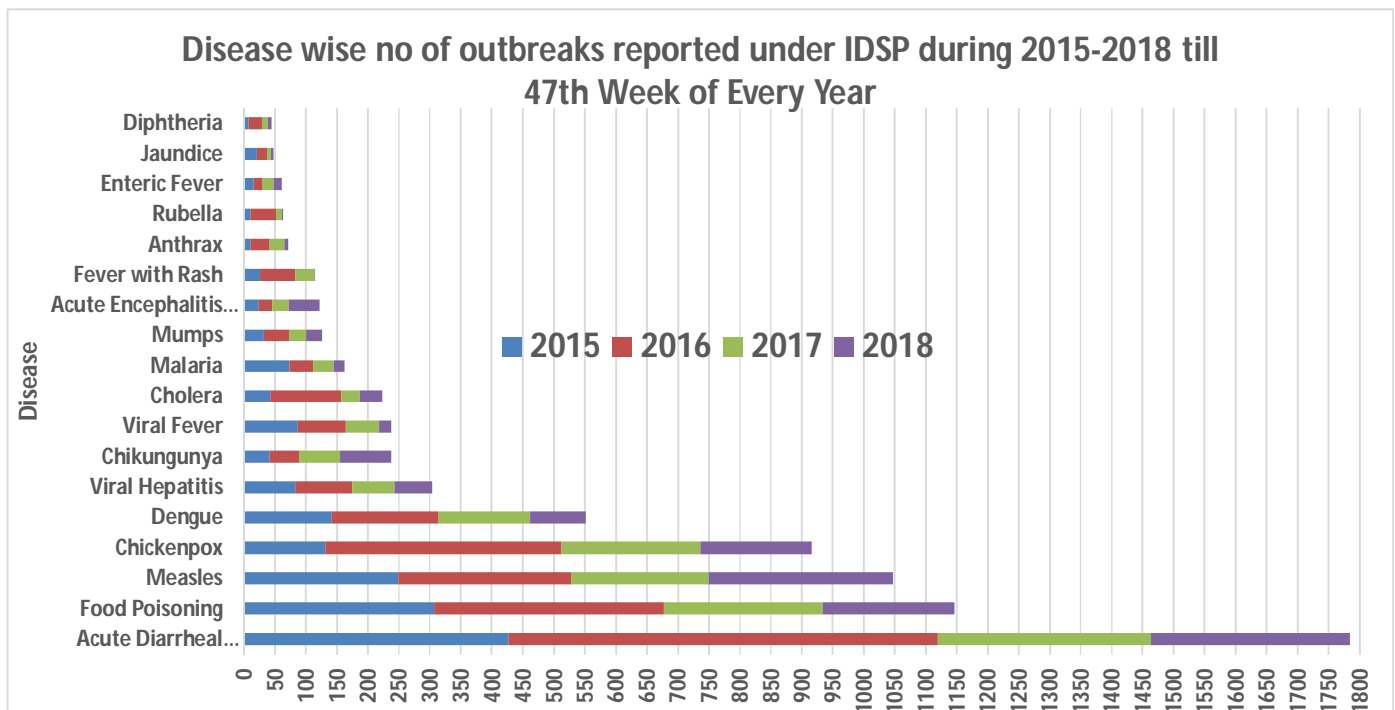
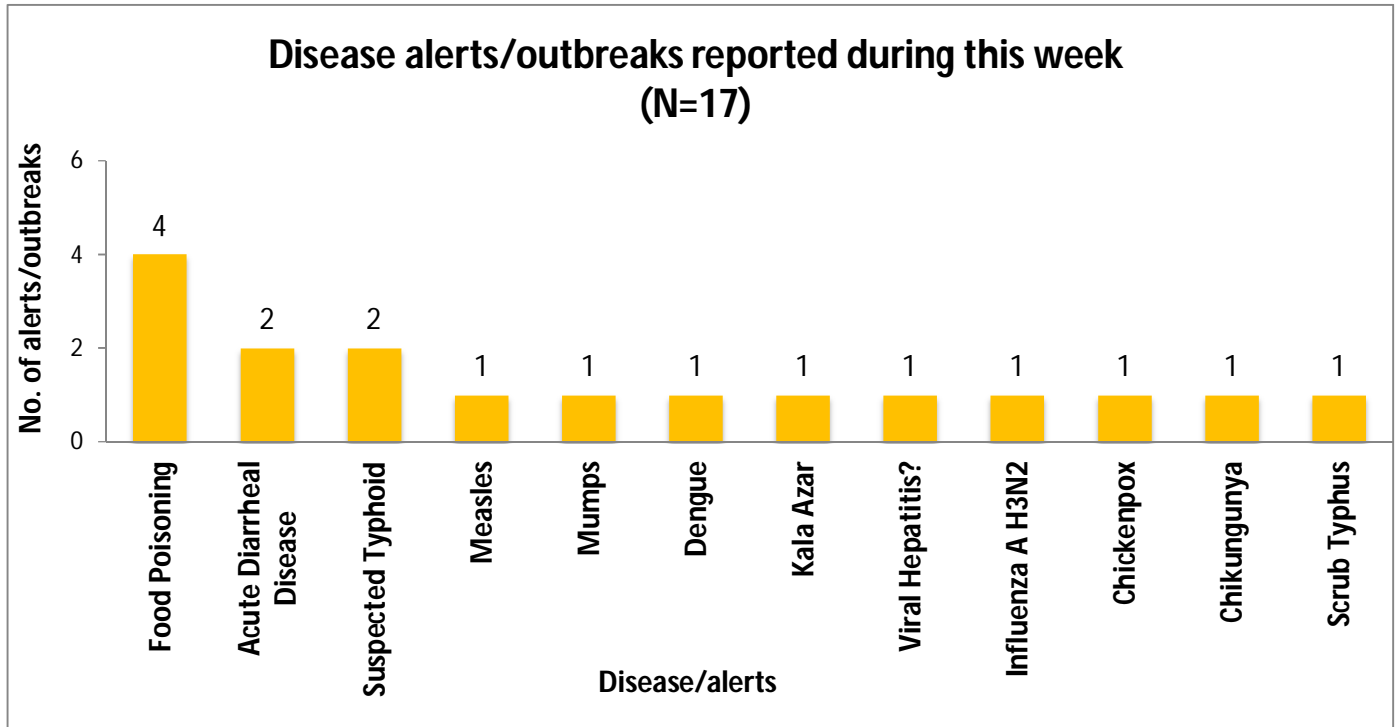

ORS packets distributed in the affected area. Health education given regarding food hygiene and sanitation.

District RRT investigated the outbreak. Active search of cases done.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A female child aged 1.5yr resident of Karuli forest area of Mallapuram was admitted at MCH Khozikhode with severe malnutrition and anaemia. The child was found positive for Leishmania and later died on treatment. The forest area is inaccessible to health workers and has restrictions to entry due to Maoist activity. A 63yr old male resident of Kuttampuruzha region (inaccessible area), Ernakulum was treated in MCH Trivandrum in October 18 and later confirmed for Leishmania. Screening campaign with rapid test rK39 kits and IRS activities undertaken. All cases treated symptomatically. Health education given.

Apart from Nagpur District cases were reported from Amravati District and many bordering Districts of Madhya Pradesh like Balaghat, Chindwara, Umariya, Seoni, Betul and Satna. A total of 78 cases and 14 deaths were reported from 1 st August to 7 th September 2018. District RRT investigated the outbreak. House to house survey done. All the cases were treated at GMC, Nagapur. Entomological survey done and vector control measures like malathion dusting was undertaken in the affected areas. Health education given regarding personal protection measures.

Out of 3 blood samples collected and tested at DPHL Nashik; 2 samples were positive for Dengue (IgM ELISA). 3 deaths occurred in 2 females (4yrs & 17yrs) and one male (9 month old) child. Entomological survey done. All cases treated symptomatically. Fogging and anti- larval measures undertaken. Health education given.

Super chlorination of water sources done and chlorine tablets distributed in the community. Health education given.
