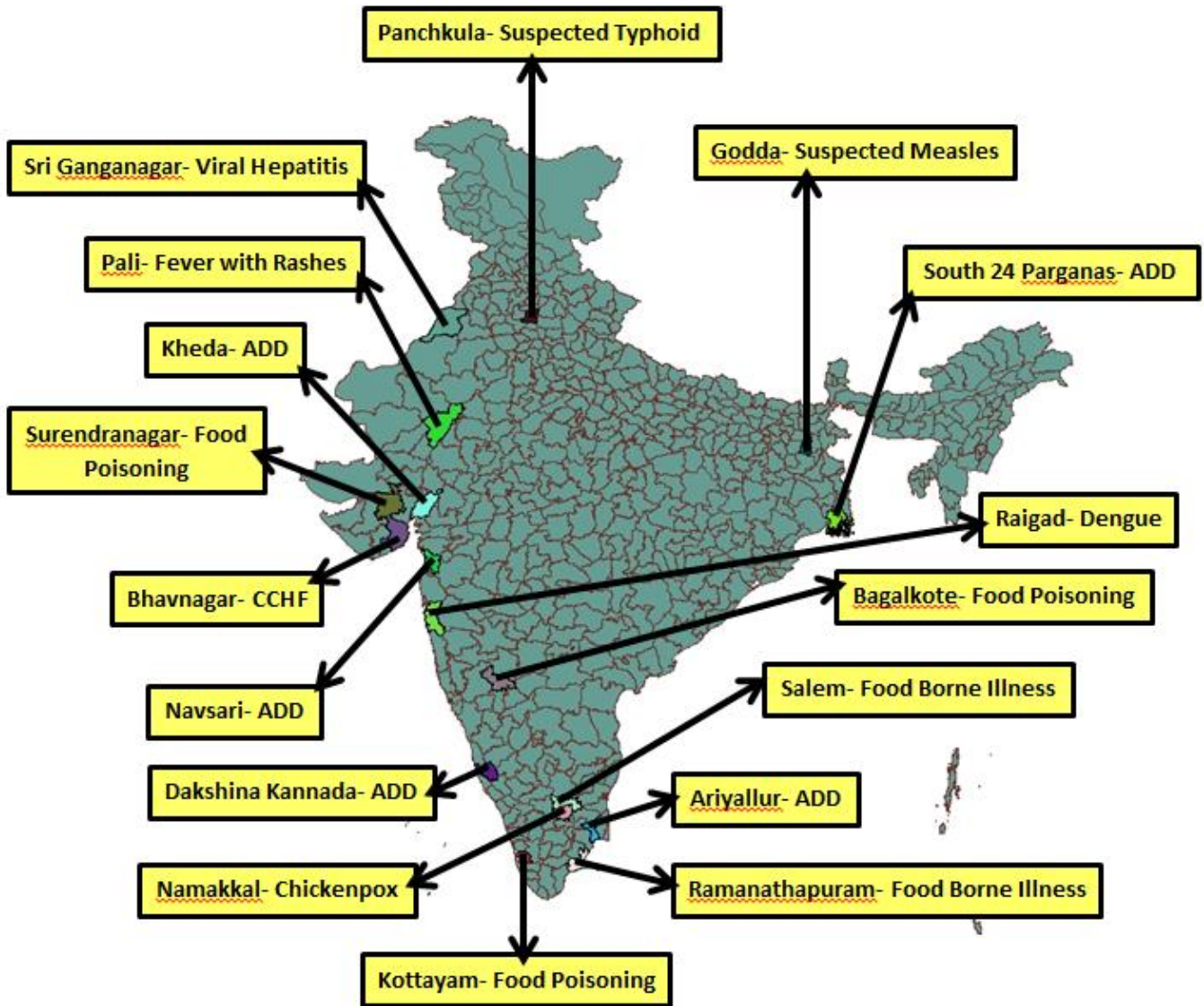

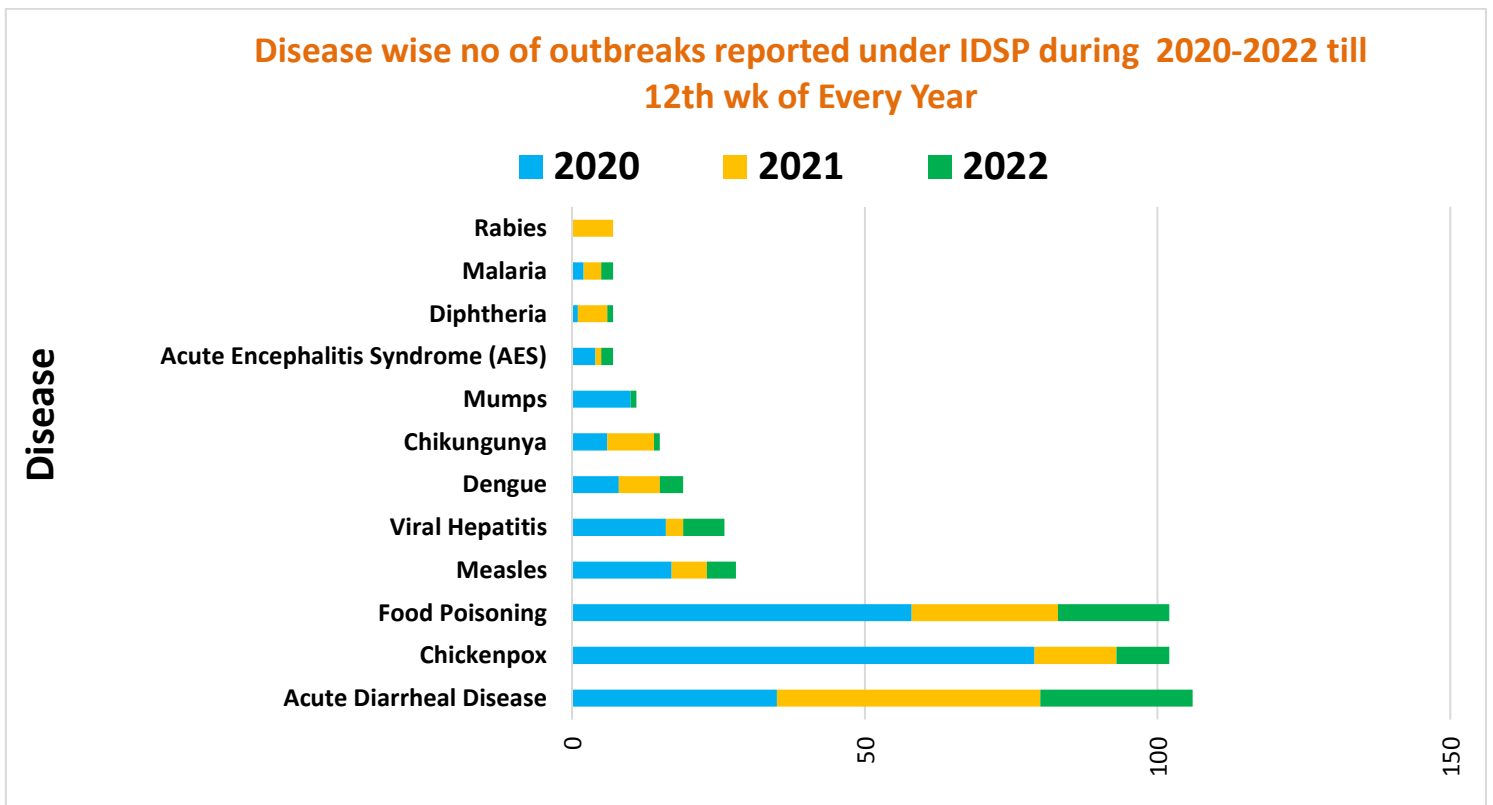
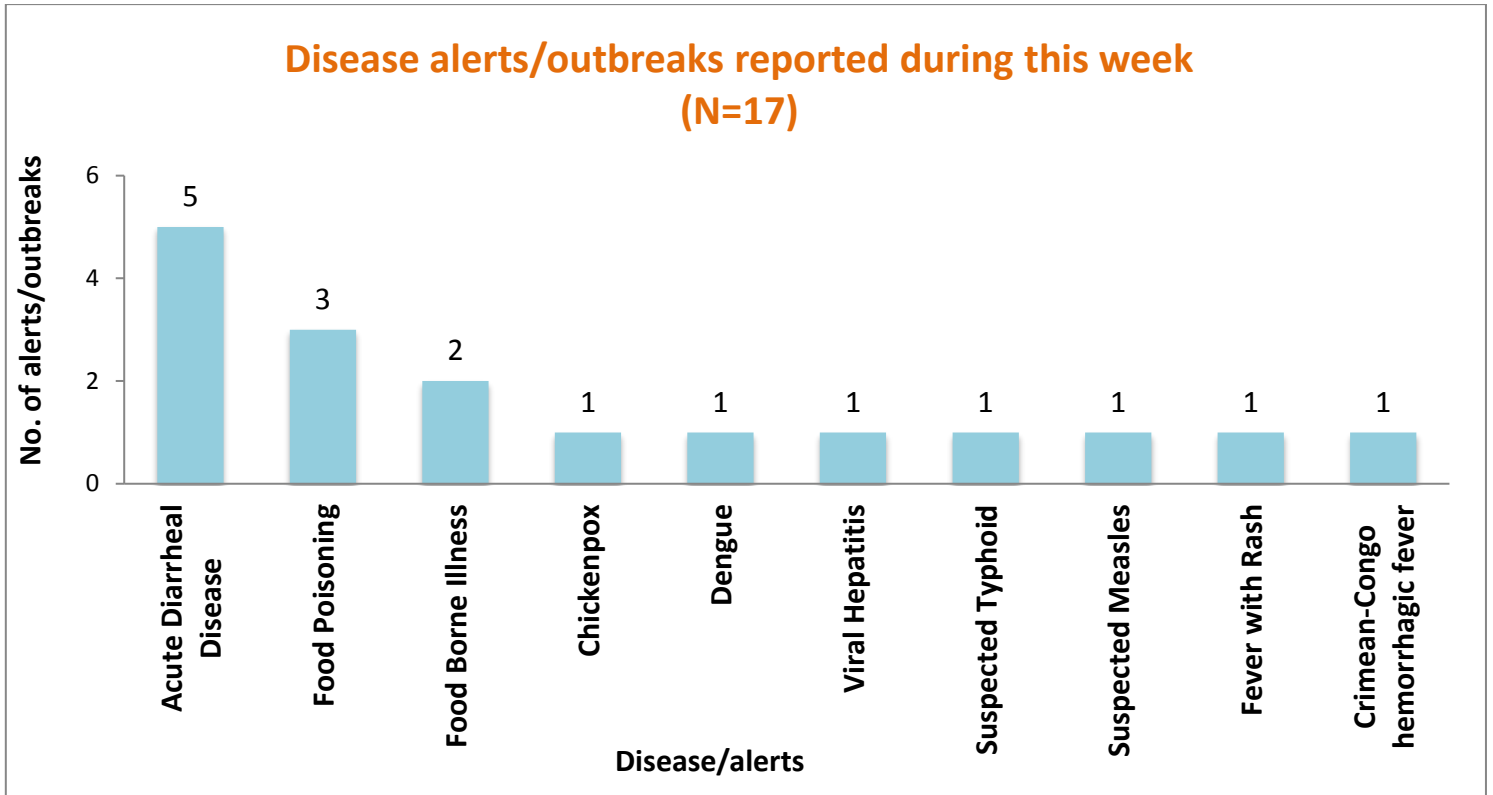

Chlorine tablets were distributed. Health education was given regarding importance of safe drinking water.

Of these, one was found positive for Crimean Congo haemorrhagic fever by District RRT investigated the case. Health education was given.

Symptomatic treatment was given to all the cases. Chlorine tablets were distributed. Health education was given regarding importance of safe drinking water and properly cooked food.

It was found that drinking water supply was contaminated with sandy water. Symptomatic treatment was given to all the cases. Chlorine tablets were distributed. Health education was given regarding importance of safe drinking water.

Four out of 10 cases were vaccinated for Measles. District RRT investigated the case. Health education was given.

Symptomatic treatment was given to all the cases. Chlorine tablets were distributed. Health education was given regarding importance of safe drinking water and properly cooked food.

Health education was given regarding importance of safe drinking water and properly cooked food.
