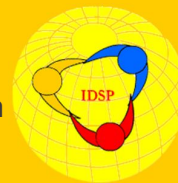

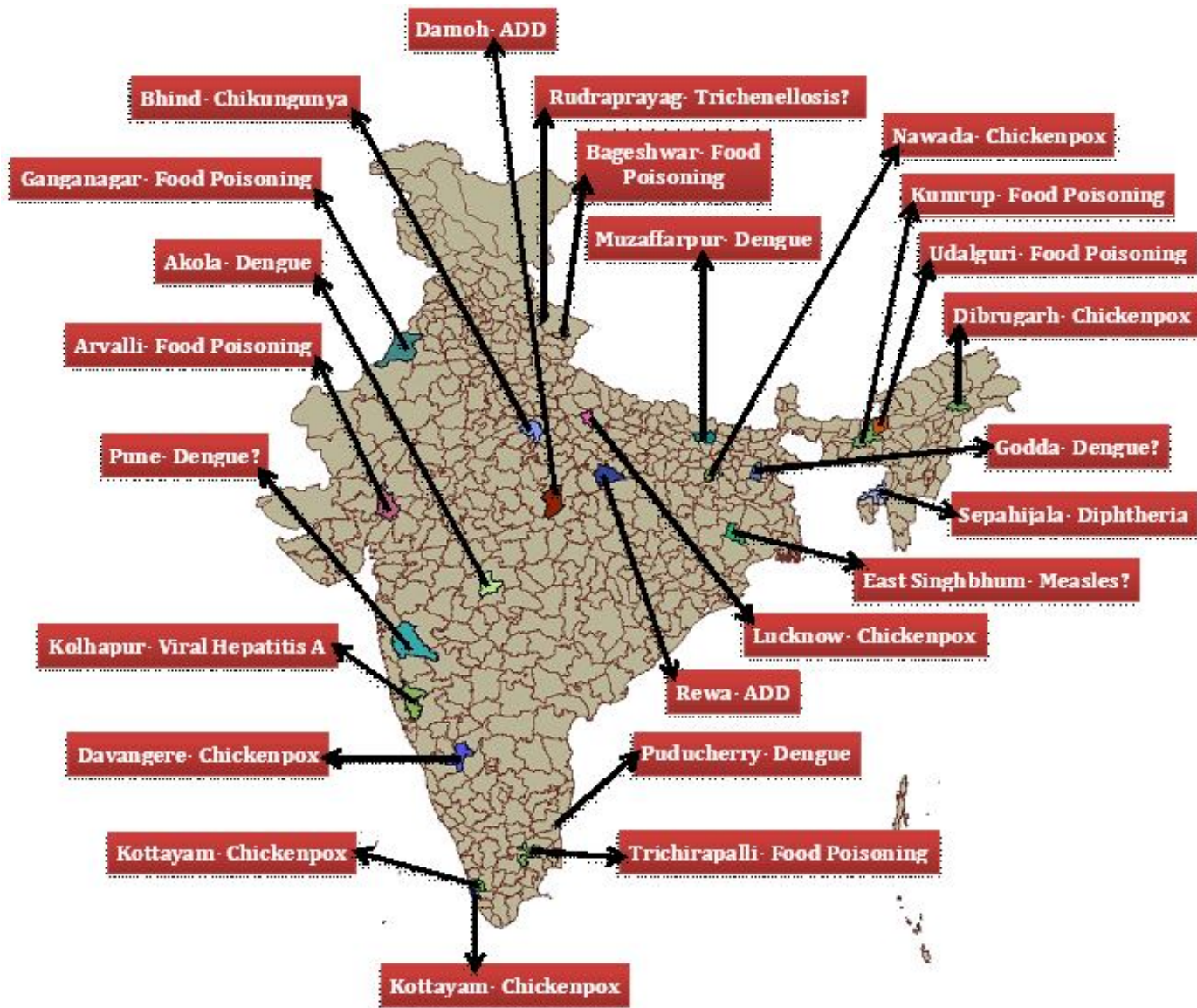

48th Week Map

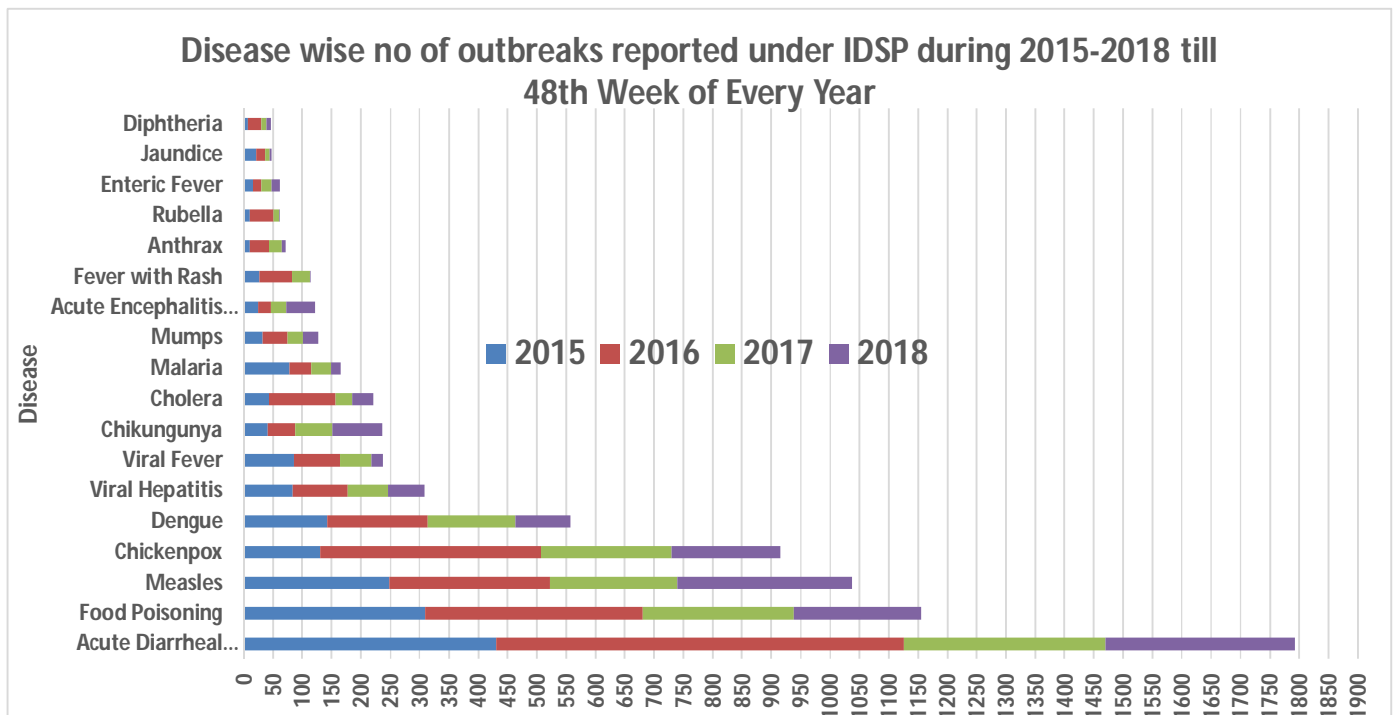
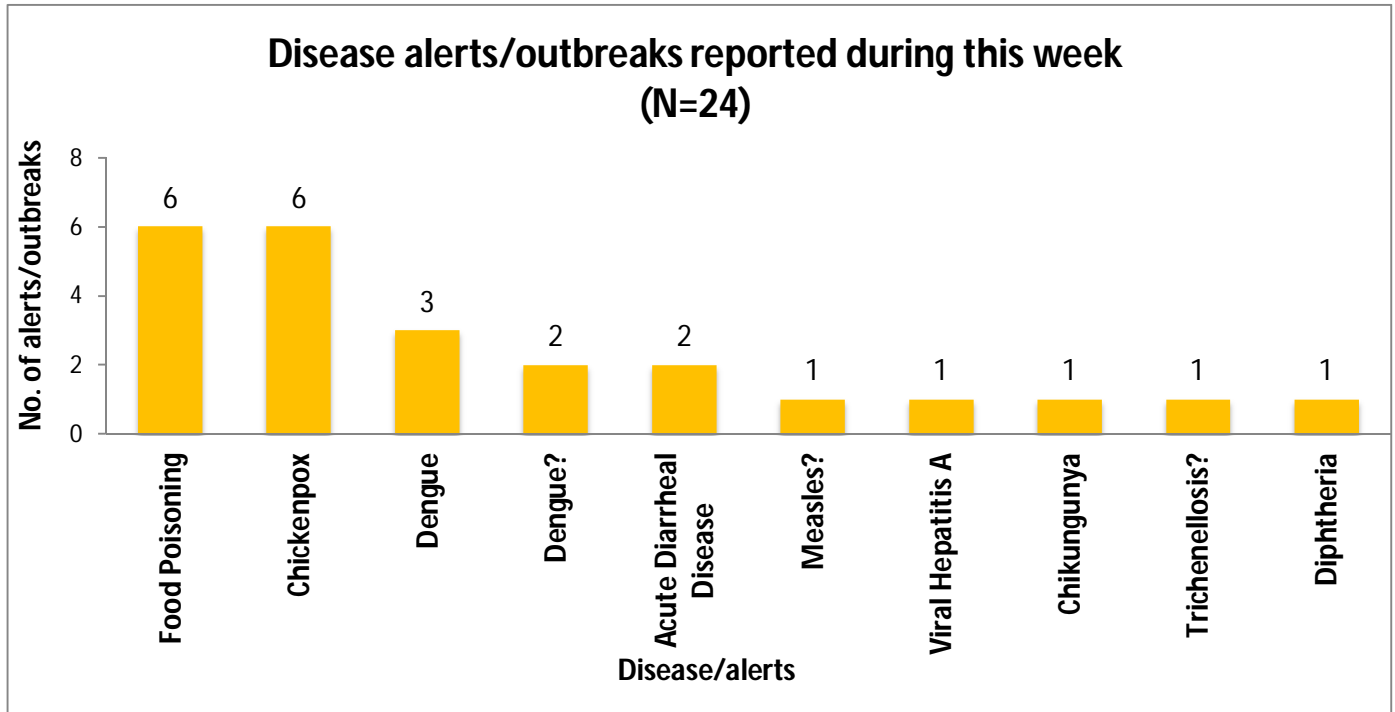
