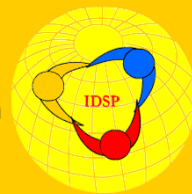

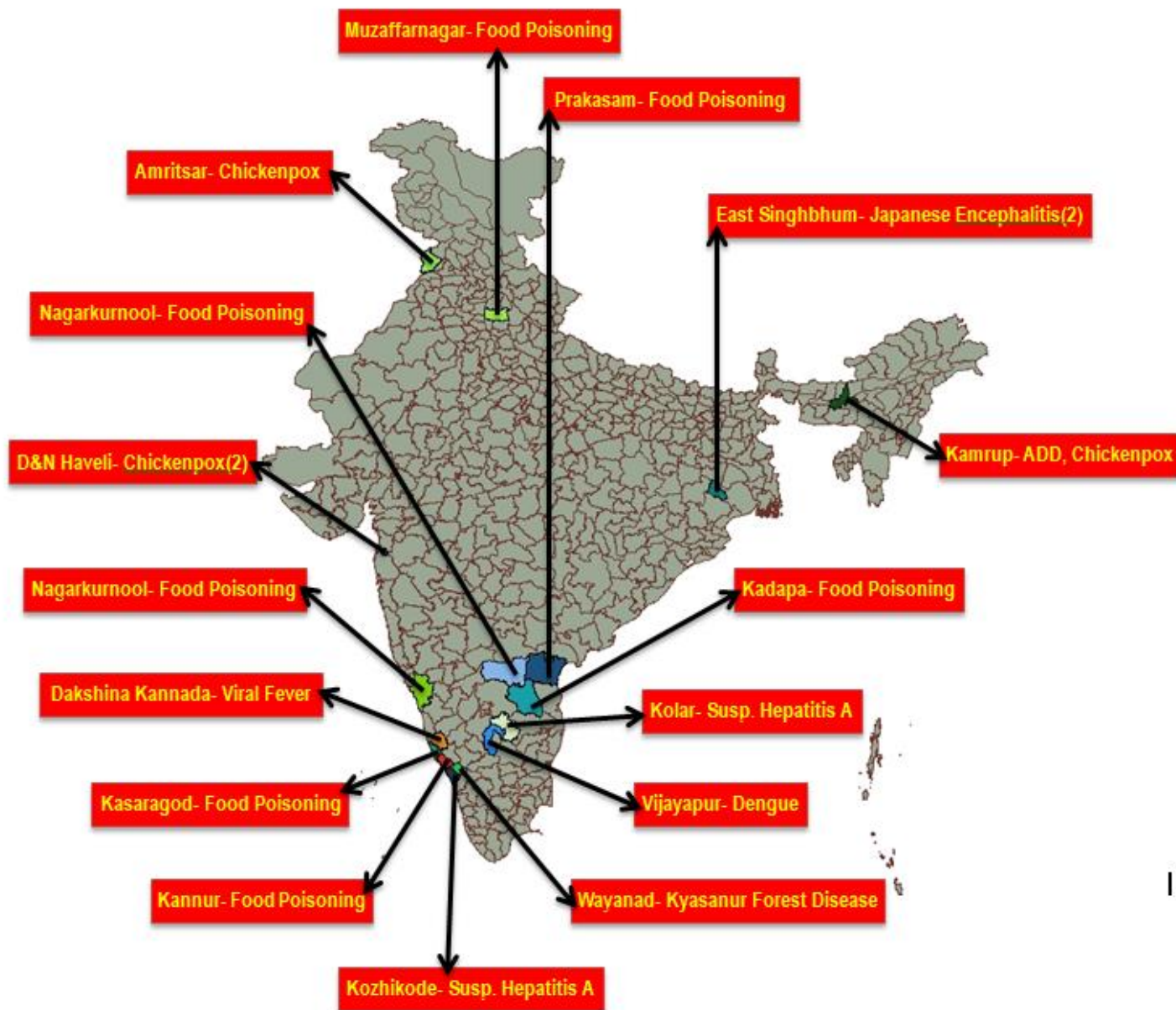

1<sup>st</sup> Week Map

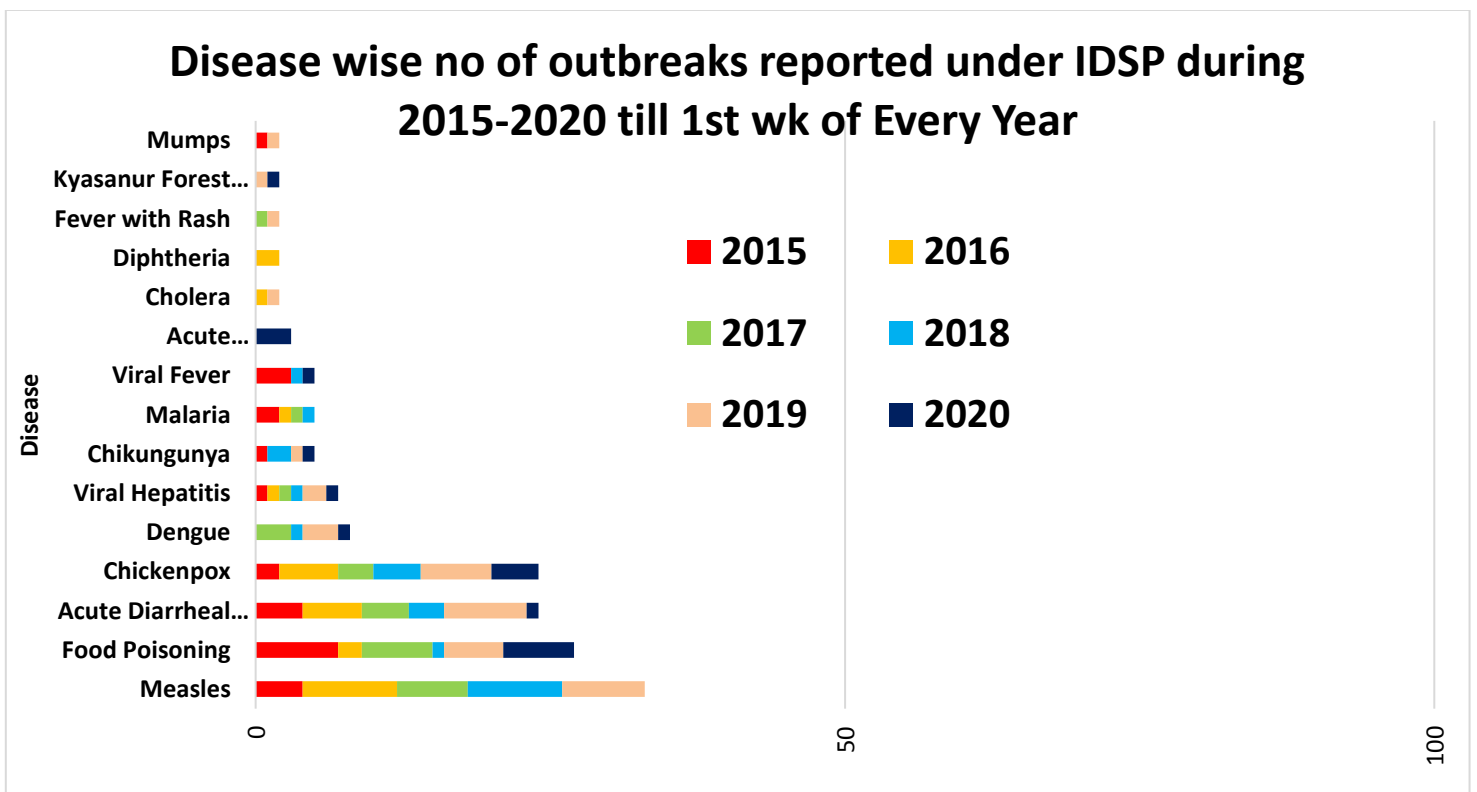
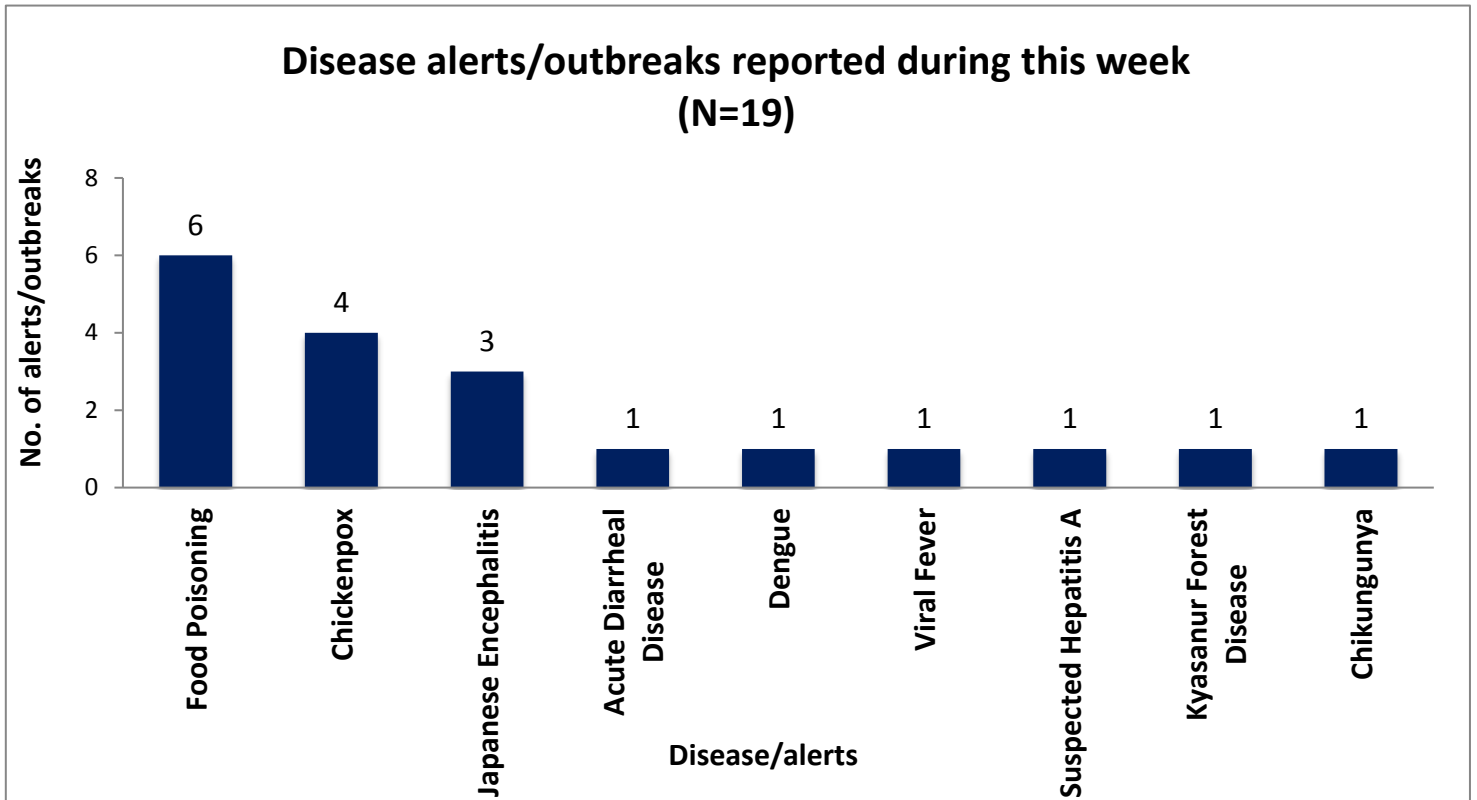

A total of 02 water samples sent to District Public Health Laboratory Kadapa and found fit for drinking. All cases treated symptomatically. Medical camp organized in the hostel. Health education given.

Health education given.

Food samples collected and sent to Microbiology Department GMCH showed growth of non typhoidal salmonella. All cases treated. Health education given.

Health education given on safe water and hand washing and food hygiene.

A total of 03 blood samples collected and result of 02 samples were found positive for Dengue and 01 sample positive for Rickettsial disease. All cases treated. Health education given.

Cases presented with vomiting and pain abdomen. A total of 02 water samples collected and tested at Water Authority Lab, Kasaragod was found to be contaminated with Coliform bacteria and E coli. A single stool sample collected and tested at NIV, Alappuzha and result awaited. All cases treated. Health education given.

Food samples collected and sent to Regional Analytical lab Kozhikode result awaited. Blood and stool samples collected, blood culture showed no growth. All cases treated. Health education given.

Her house is surrounded by coffee estate and monkey deaths were reported from the same area. A single sample collected and sent to MCVR, Manipal was found positive for Kyasanur Forest Disease by PCR. Case treated. KFD vaccination campaign conducted in the affected area. Tick surveillance conducted in all monkey death reported areas. Health education given.

All cases treated. Source reduction activities undertaken. Health education given on prevention and control of vector borne diseases.

A total of 07 blood samples taken and sent to RPH Lab Kozhikode, all found positive for Hepatitis A by IgM ELISA. All cases treated. Health education given on personal hygiene and safe drinking water.
