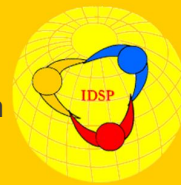

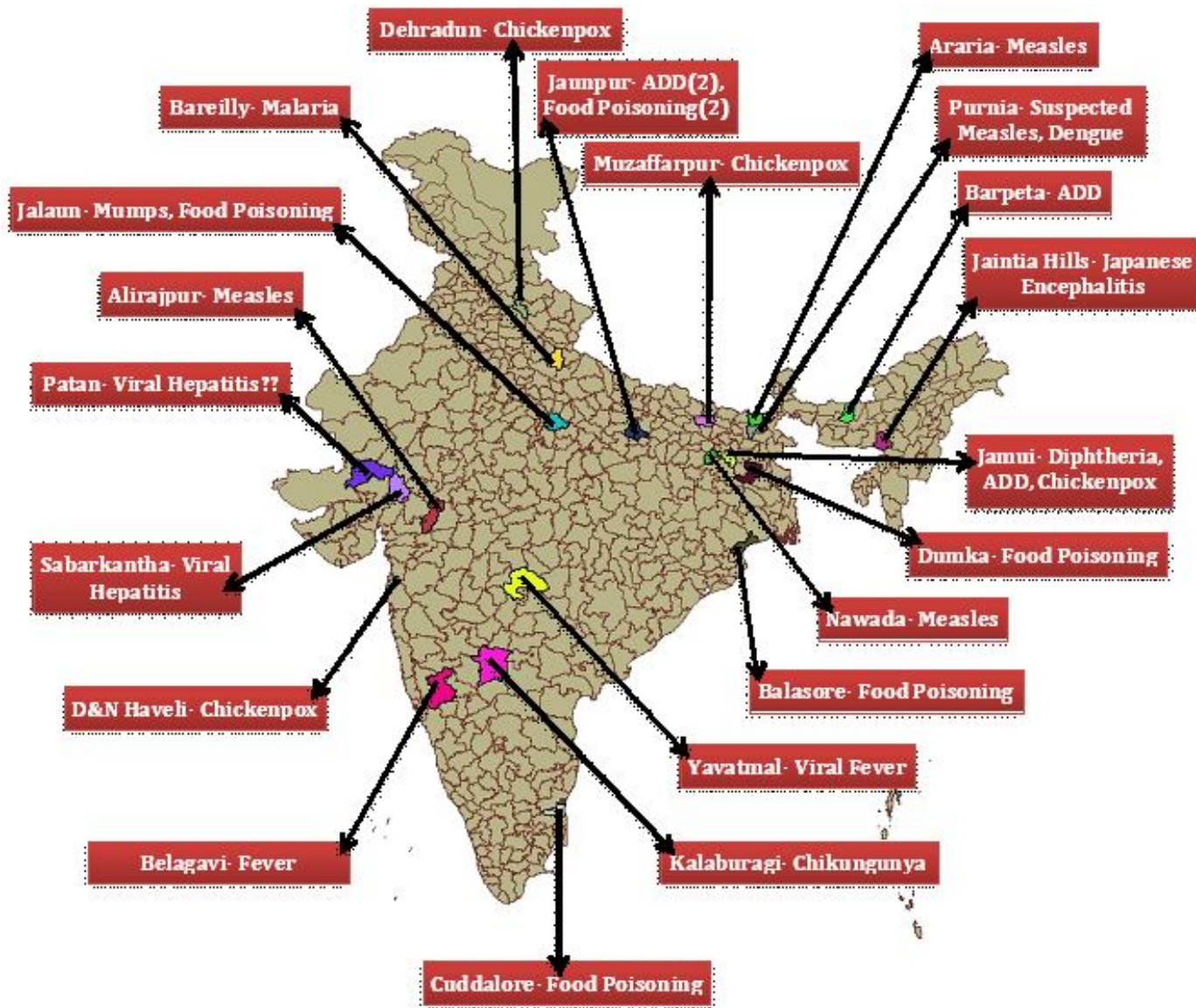

49th Week Map

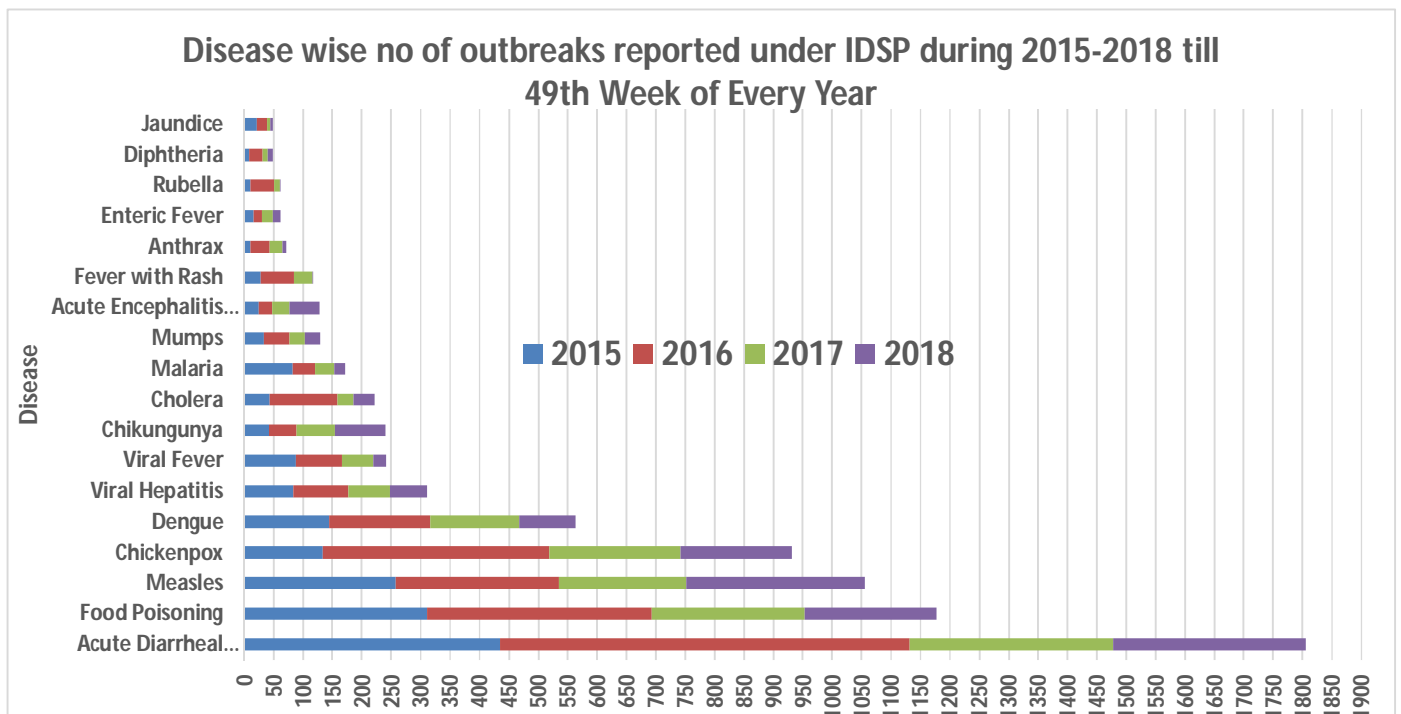
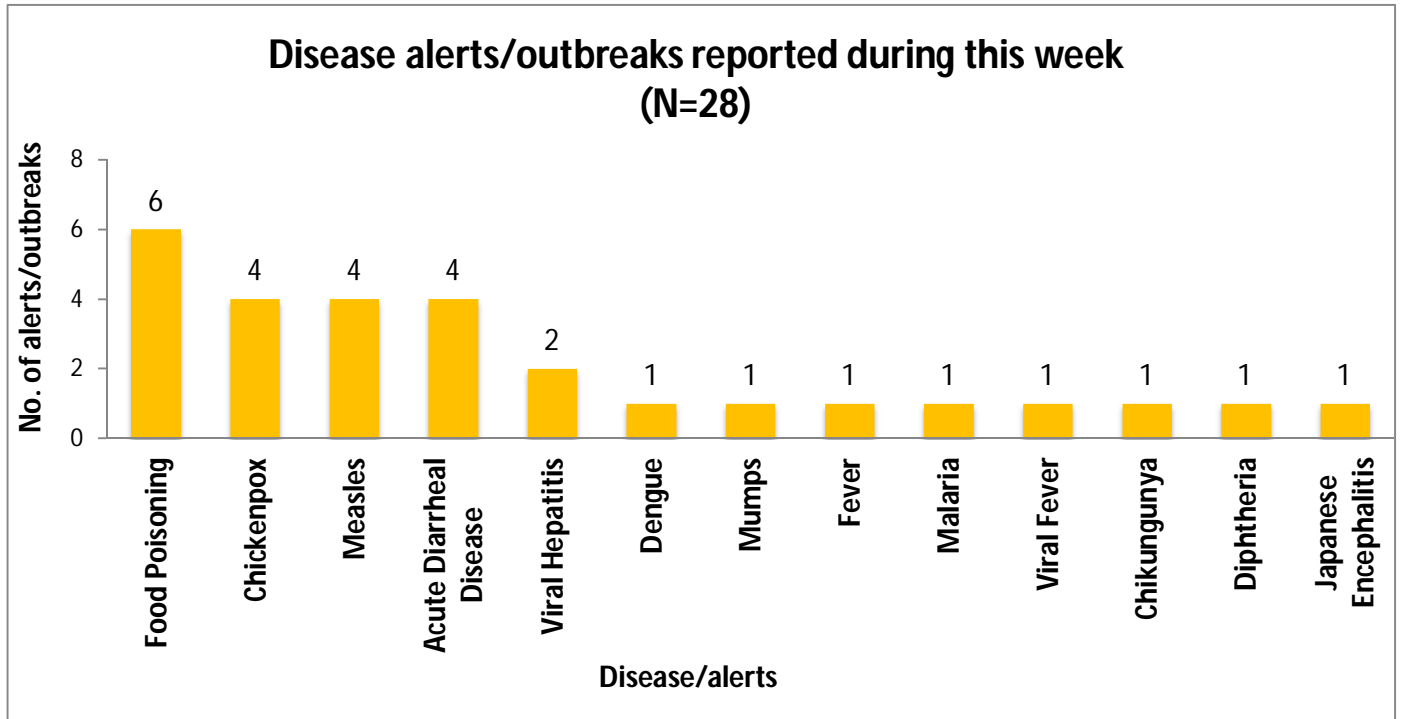
