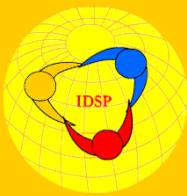

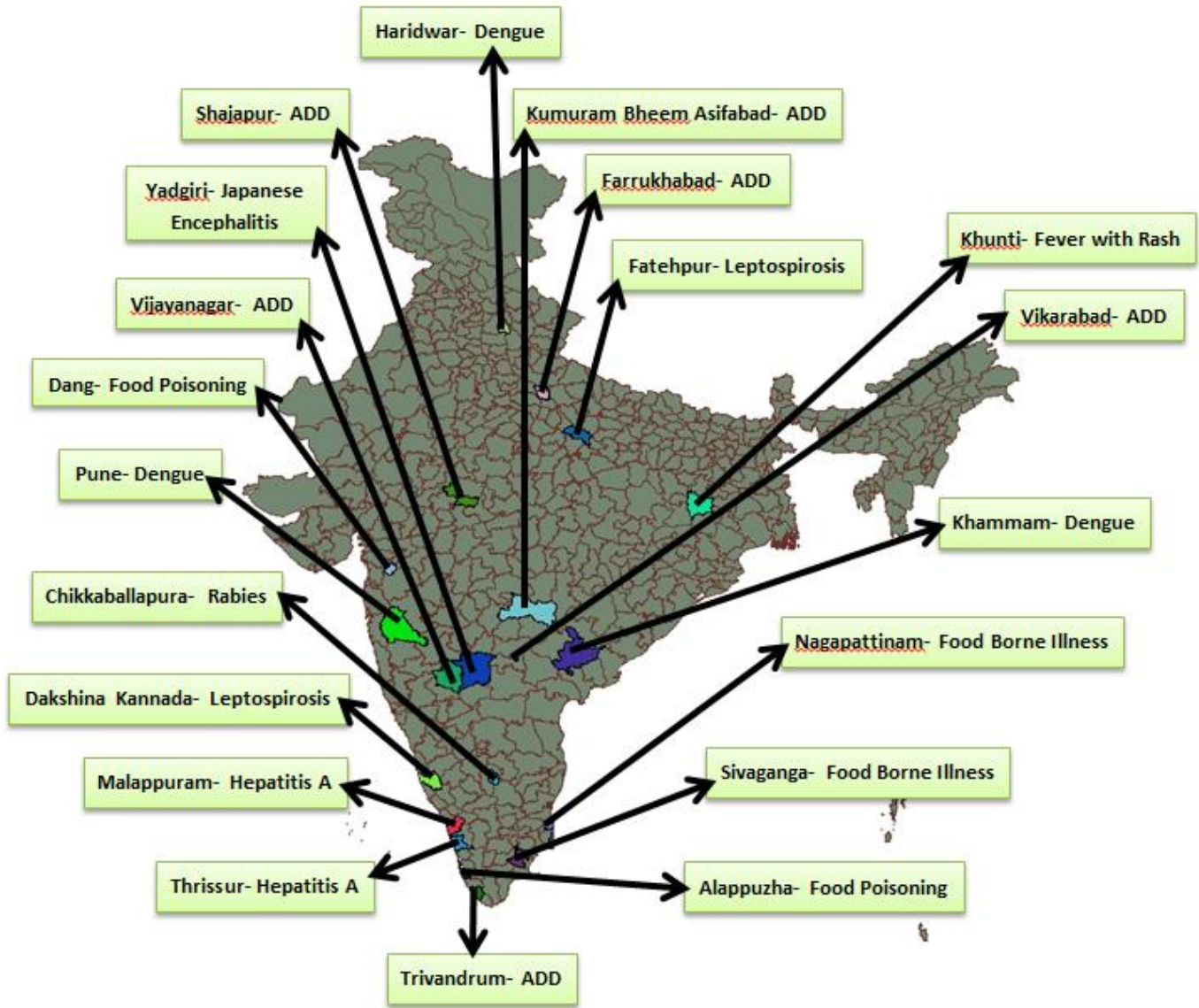

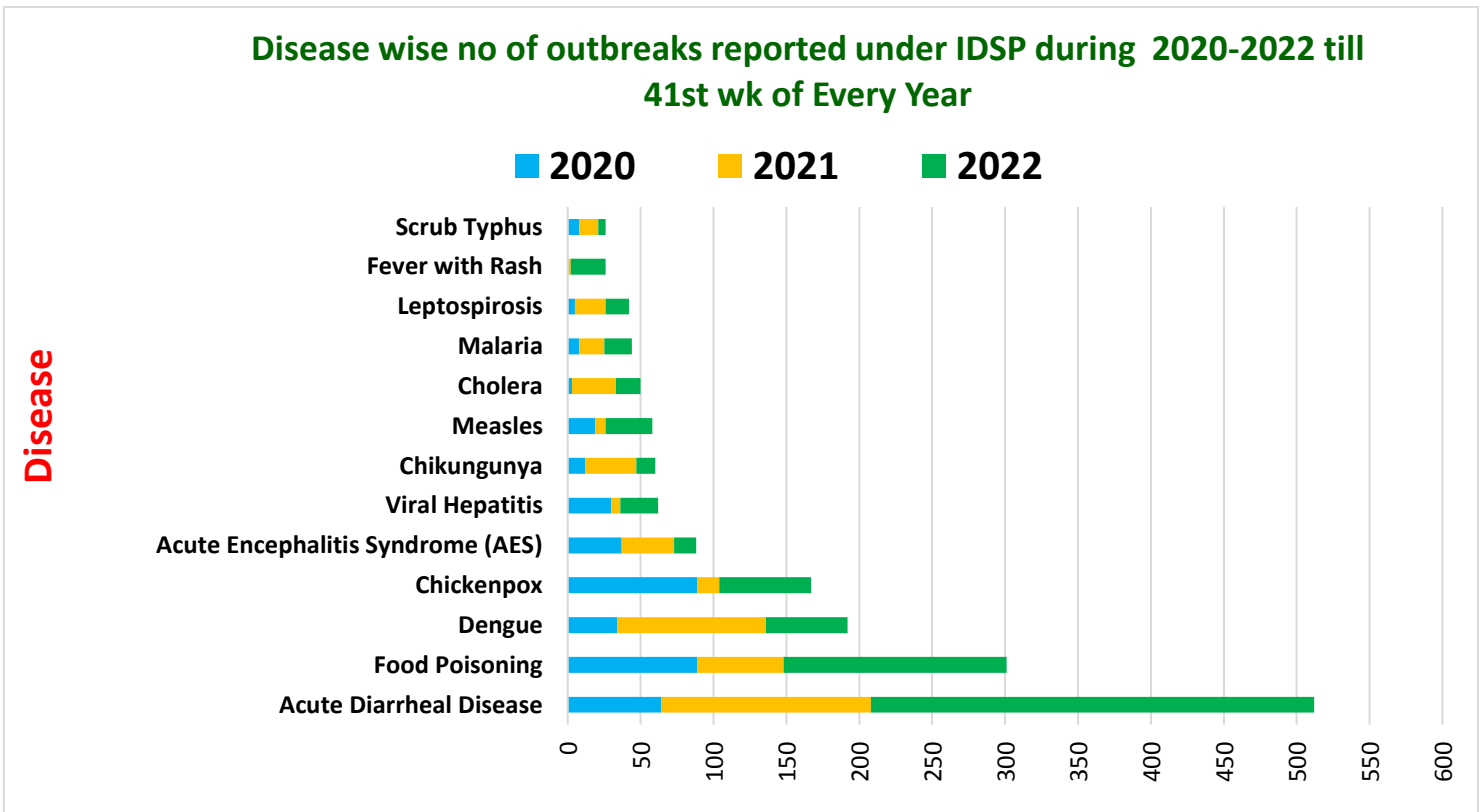

Health education was given.

KN/CKR/2022/41/809	Karnataka	Chikkaballapura	Rabies	02	02	07-06-22	13-10-22	Under Control	Case reported from Pesalaparathi and Dasaravaripalli Village, Taluk Bagepalli, District Chikkaballapura. The patient 48 year old female (Pesalaparathi village) and her family (3 members) were all bitten by dog. All were partially vaccinated, after 3 month of bite. The patient got symptoms of Hydrophobia and Airophobia, and was admitted at ED Hospital on 3rd June 2022 from where she was referred to NIMHANS Hospital and died on 7th June 2022. No samples collected, clinically confirmed Rabies. Another 58 year old male and died on 27th Feb 2022 at Home. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given. The deceased's family members and people in community were sensitized regarding the preventive measures. Instructed the patient's family members for complete vaccination.

Five water samples sent to GH Kudligi of which three were Not Suitable for Potable Purposes. District RRT visited the affected area. Temporary clinic started in the village, Grama panchayat repaired pipeline leakages and cleaned overhead tank, IEC to drink boiled and cooled water and to eat fresh and hot food given. ORS distribution done.

Two serum sample sent to Micro lab (VDRL) which tested positive for JE by IgM Elisa. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given. House to House fever survey done. Instructed to maintain hygiene around the houses. Fogging done.

Food, Water and Three Stool samples collected and sent to PH lab Trivandrum where no pathogens were isolated in stool culture (No parasites & bacteria seen), food samples were satisfactory but water sample showed presence of Coliforms. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.

No sample collected. District RRT investigated the outbreak. IEC activity done in village regarding personal Hygiene (Hand washing) and prevention of food from being contaminated.

TN/NGP/2022/41/814	Tamil Nadu	Nagapattinam	Food Borne Illness	30	00	11-10-22	12-10-22	Under Surveillance	Cases reported from Village Government Nurse Training Centre Nagapattinam, HSC/PHC/Block Nagapattinam. District Nagapattinam. One food and one water samples collected and sent to DPHL Nagapattinam. Food sample was contaminated with dead centipede but showed no growth of Salmonella, Shigella, and Vibrio Cholera whereas water sample was found Non-potable. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given. Disinfection of premises and cooking area done. Chlorination of water sources done.

Five food and Two water samples collected and sent to DPHL Karaikudi, Sivagnaga. All food samples and water samples were found fit for consumption. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given. Hygiene of hotel premises and cooking area are inspected. Disinfection of premises and cooking area done. Chlorination of water sources done.

TL/AFD/2022/41/816	Telangana	Kumuram Bheem Asifabad	Acute Diarrheal Disease	15	02	08-10-2022	13-10-2022	Under Control	Cases reported from Murkilanka, Village Dhanora Gram Panchayat of Kerameri Mandal, District Komarumbheem Asifabad with vomiting and abdominal pain. 08 families among 19 families from the village consumed pork meat after one day of cutting. It has confirmed by the laboratory tests, that the two drinking water samples were potable and the probable cause for the outbreak may be due to food poisoning as they have consumed pork meat after one day at RWS lab. The deceased were Sidiam Kannivai 25 years/Female and Sidiam Jaithu-7years/Male. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given. Medical Camps were conducted and treated patients with for diarrheal symptoms. House to House syndromic survey was conducted. Health Education was given to local public which included hand wash techniques, cleanliness of premises, consumption of the freshly cooked food and to drink chlorinated or boiled water. All Drinking water sources were chlorinated.

Eighteen samples collected and sent to DPHL Lab Found ELISA (Dengue) Positive. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given. Dewatering done. Anti-Larval and Anti Adult measures were done. Health camp conducted. Chlorination of water Done.

Five water samples collected and result awaited. Borewell water samples of 5 bore wells in village of Juntupally sent to RWS (Rural water supply testing lab), where one borewell water sample was found to be nonpotable. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Immediately after getting the information water supply through bore wells stopped alternative arrangements for water were made. Special Sanitation drive was undertaken in all the wards in the village, health education on consuming clean water & food were given by health teams.

No sample collected. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given. Disinfection of premises and cooking area done. Symptomatic treatment given to all, all recovered.

District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given. Symptomatic treatment provided to all the cases. RRT conducted fever survey, epidemiological & entomological surveillance in the area. Source reduction, Fogging and IEC conducted.

Eight students in the hostel complained of abdominal pain and diarrhea. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given. Symptomatic treatment given.

Two blood samples sent to PH Lab Malappuram which tested positive for Hepatitis A Ig M ELISA. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.

Five serum samples collected out of which three serum samples tested positive for Hepatitis A by Ig M ELISA. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.
MH/PNE/2022/41/825	Maharashtra	Pune	Dengue	16	00	19-09-2022	Under Control	Cases reported from Village-Narhe, PHC- Khadakwasala, Taluka- Haweli, District- Pune with fever, general weakness, bodyache etc. Total 16 Blood Samples were sent to NIV Pune, out of which 04 samples were positive for dengue by IgM. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Container survey, fogging, IEC done, dry day, gambusia fish etc. measures were taken.

District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given. The community was sensitized regarding the preventive measures. Fever Survey was done
