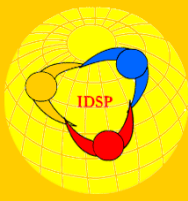

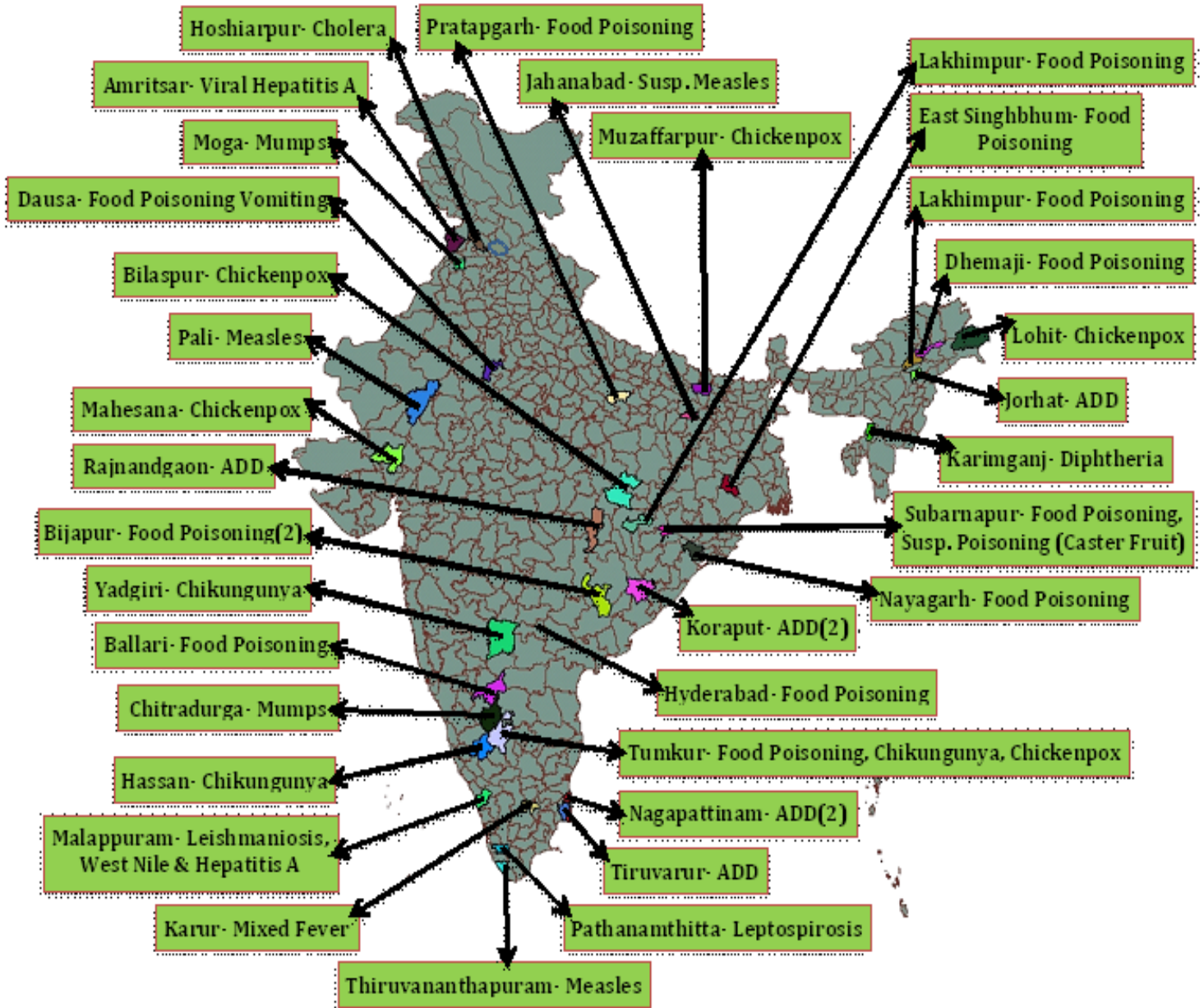

11th Week Map



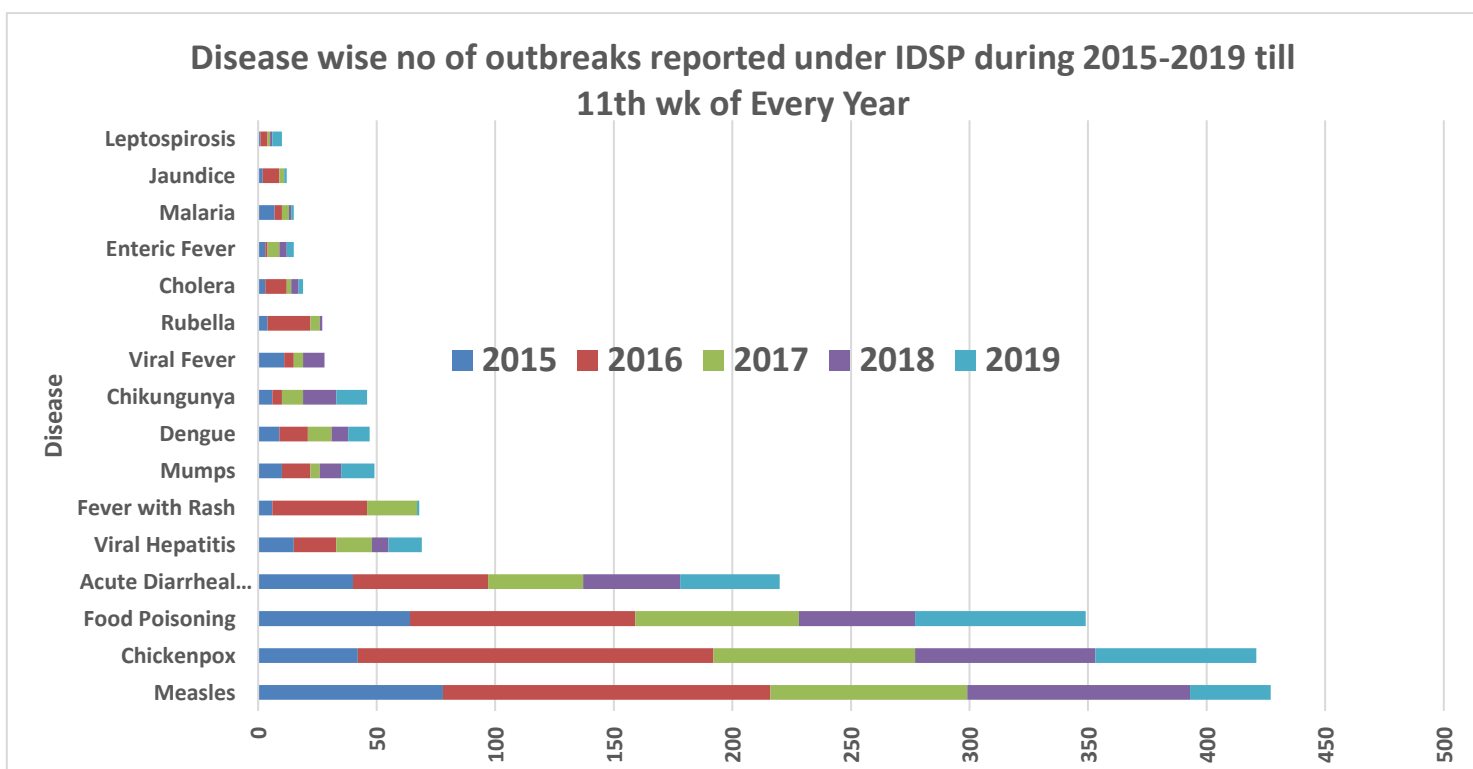
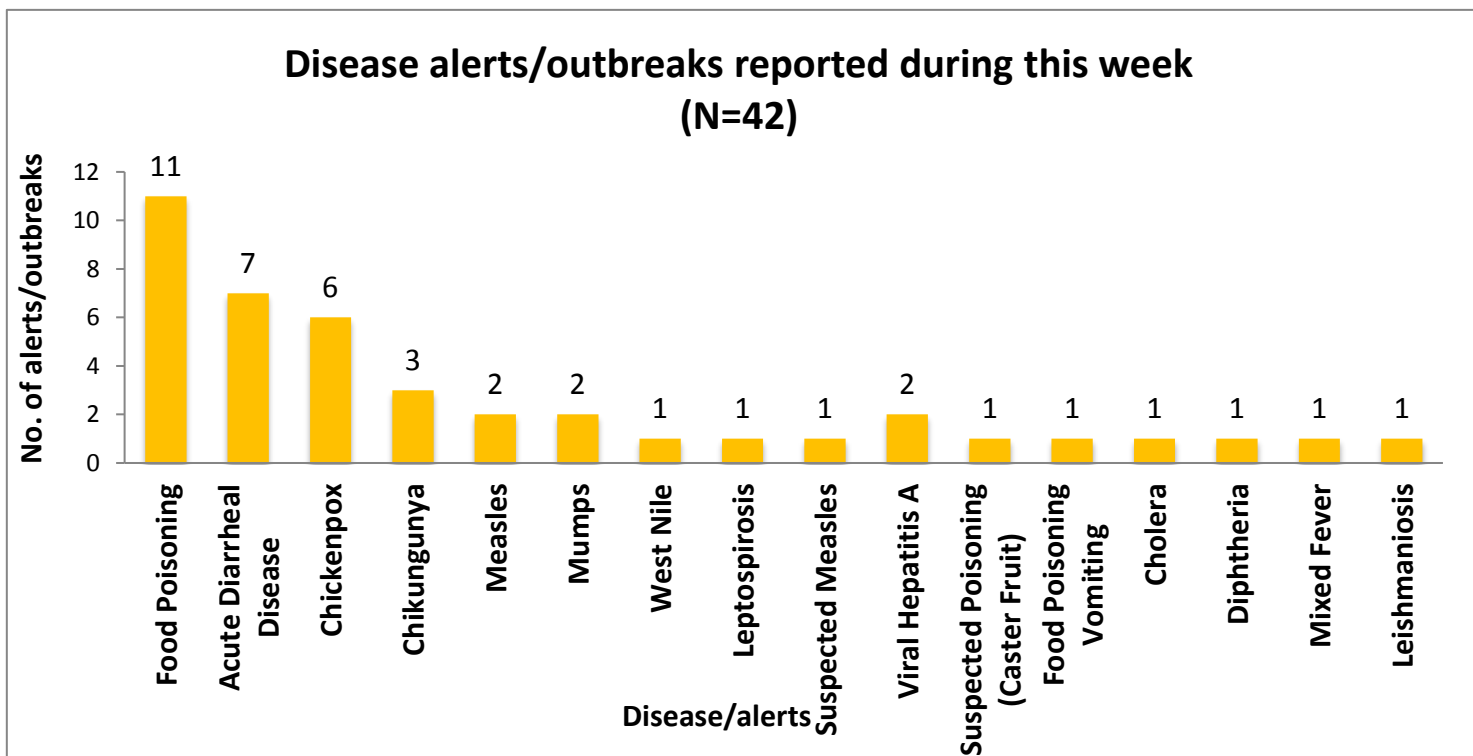
