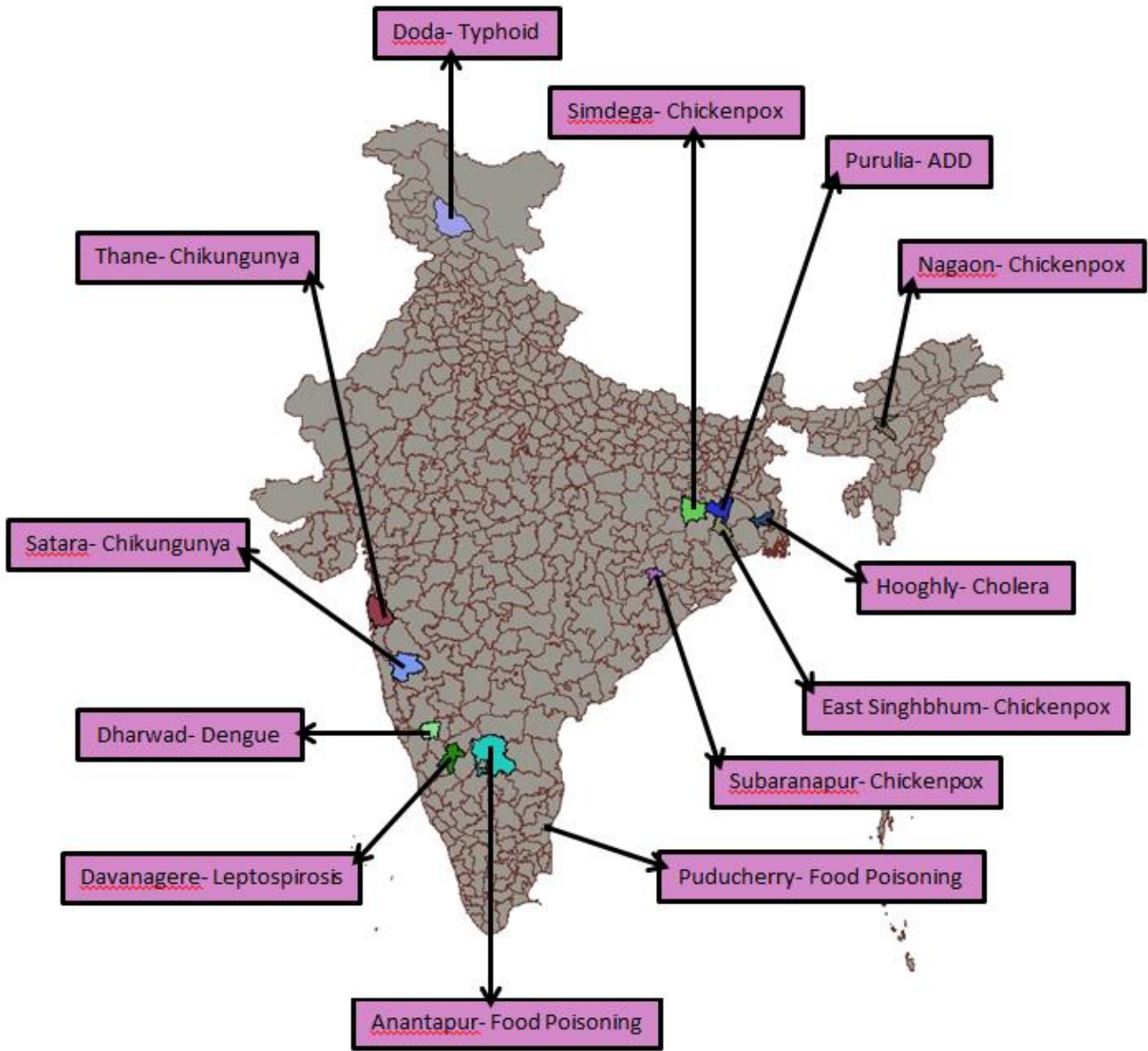

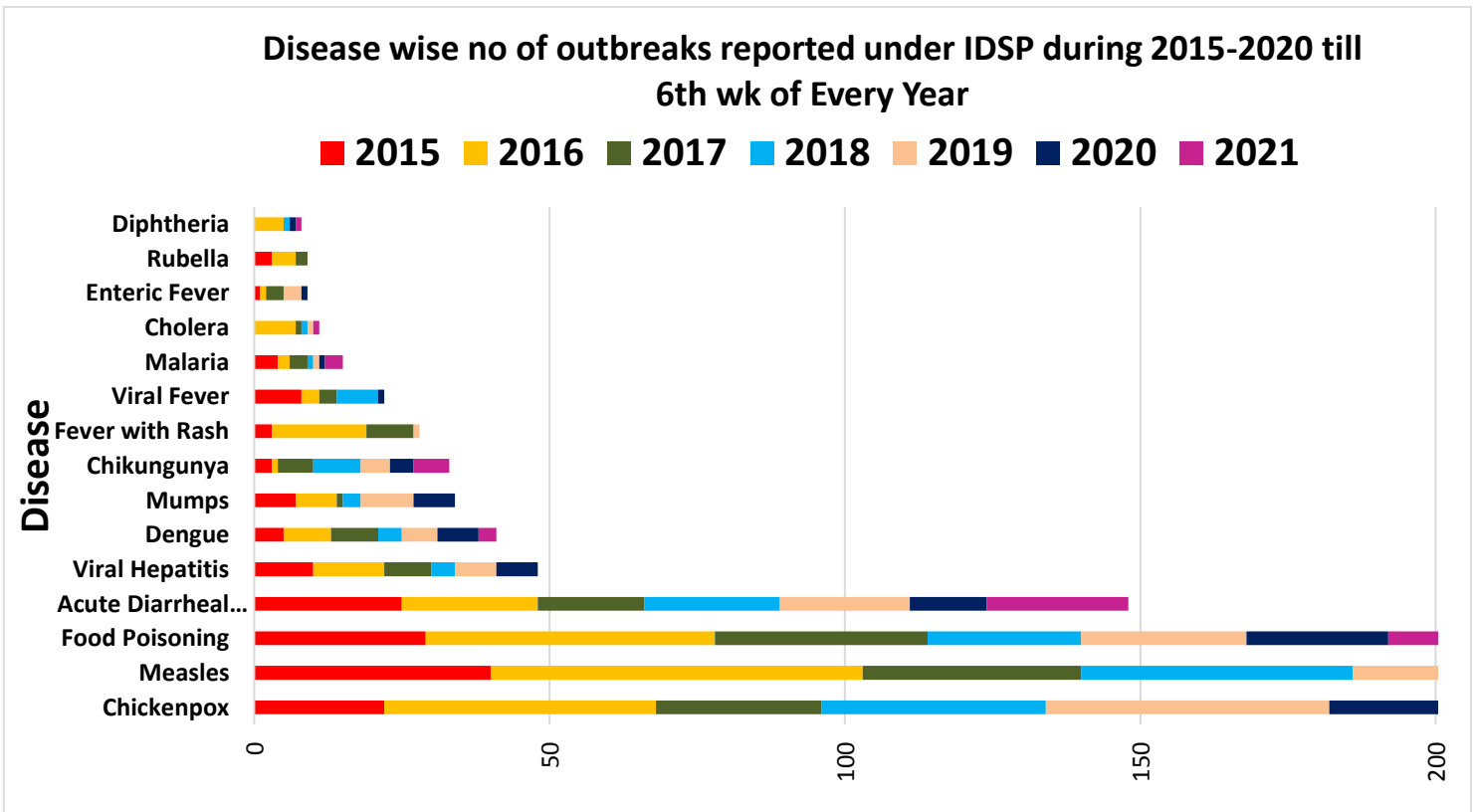
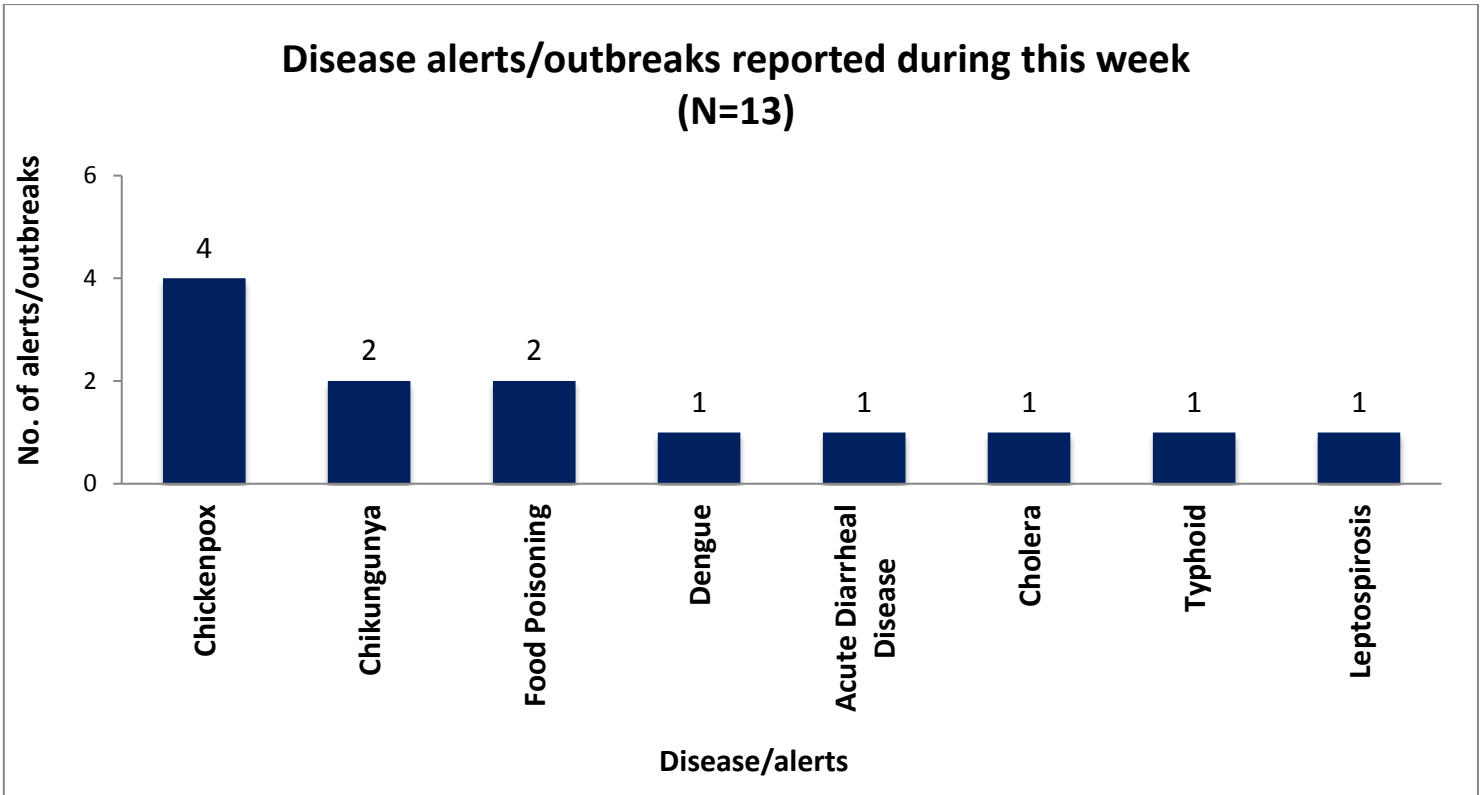

District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.
