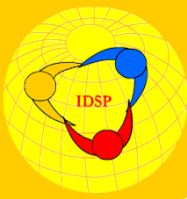

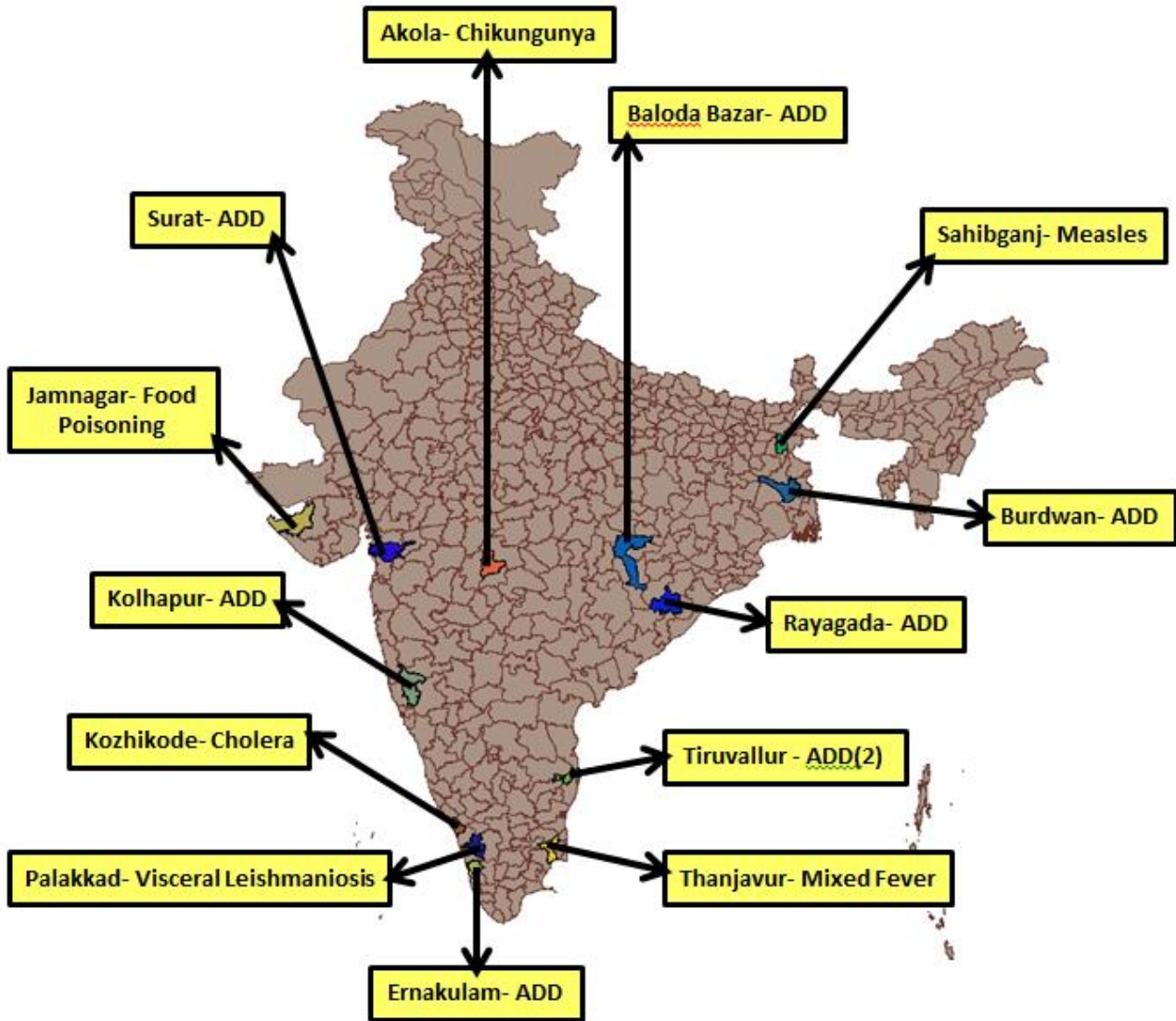

49th Week Map

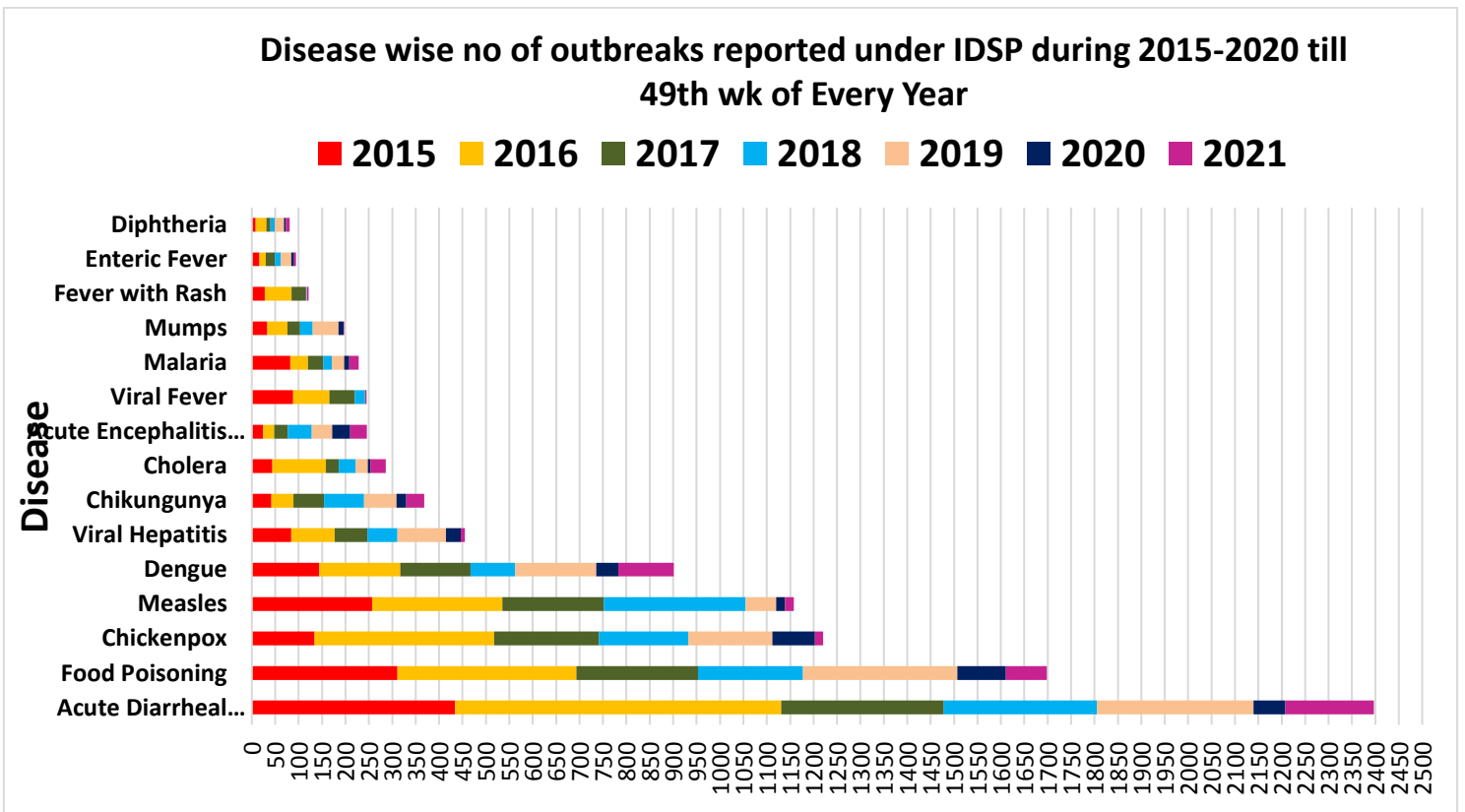
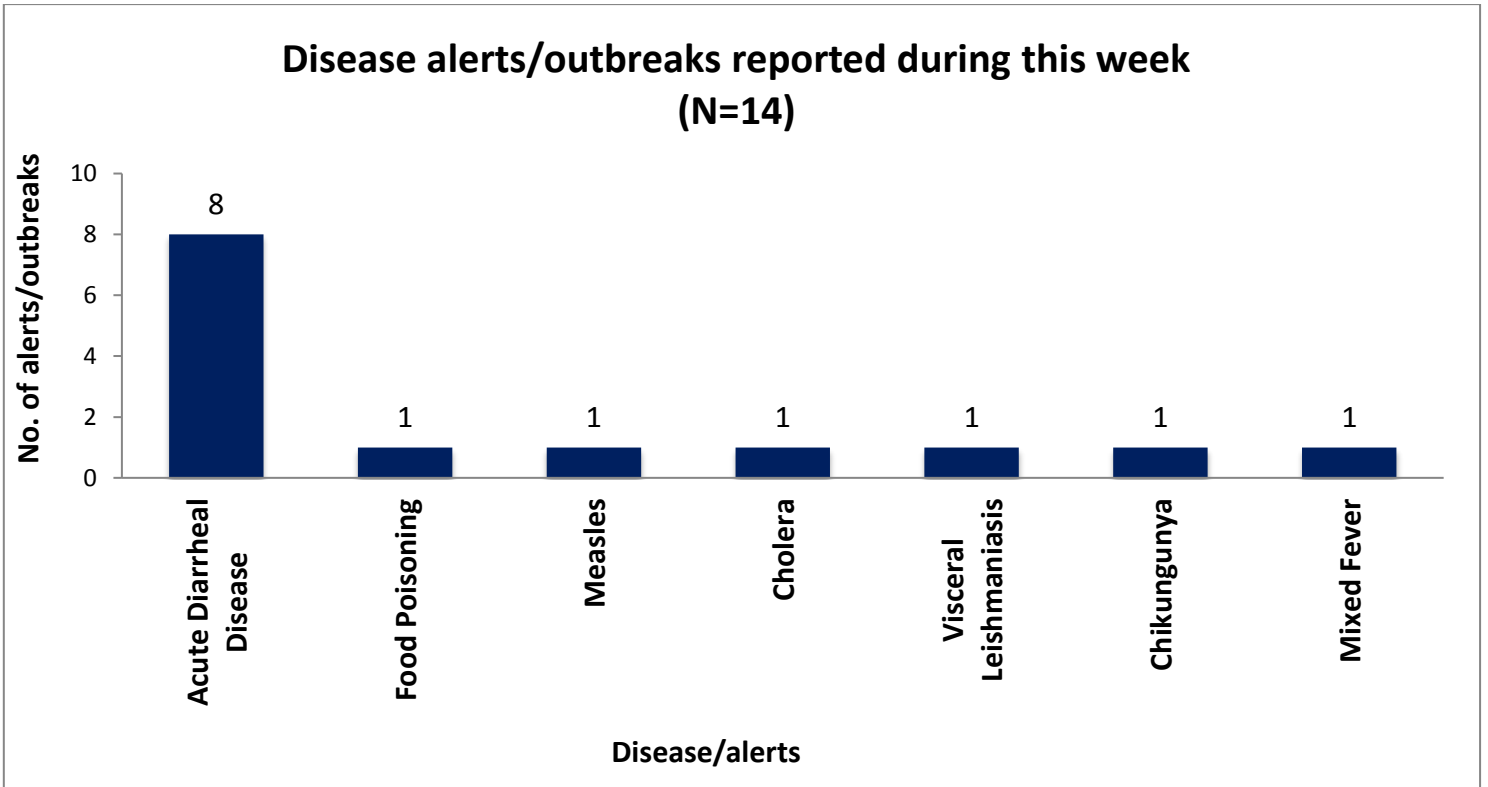

GJ/JNR/2021/49/0687	Gujarat	Jamnagar	Food Poisoning	48	01	03-12-21	03-12-21	Under Surveillance	Cases reported from Village Dhoriyo nes, SC Vadavala, PHC Paradva, Block Jamjodhpur, District Jamanagar. The deceased was a 12-year-old male. The cases presented with diarrhea and vomiting. The outbreak happened during a religious gathering where everyone present in the event consumed food from a common place. One water sample was sent to GGH Hospital Jamnagar for further lab analysis, the water was found not fit for drinking purpose. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.
GJ/SRT/2021/49/0688	Gujarat	Surat	Acute Diarrheal Disease	22	00	11-12-21	11-12-21	Under Surveillance	Cases reported from Village Pathradiya, SC Goji, PHC Sarbhon, Block Bardoli, District Surat. The outbreak occurred in a tribal area where there was a pipe line leakage reported. Eight stool samples and six water samples were sent for further lab analysis, out of which the stool samples did not show the presence of pathogenic growth and the water samples were found to be not fit for drinking purpose. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given. Chlorine tablets were distributed among the households.
JH/SBG/2021/49/0689	Jharkhand	Sahibganj	Measles	04	00	08-11-21	08-12-21	Under Surveillance	Cases reported from Village Manihari Tola Bhatta, Mirzapur, SDH – Rajmahal, District Sahebganj. Three Blood samples were sent to Institute of Serology, Kolkata for further lab analysis, out of which all tested positive for Measles by IgM ELISA. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given. Vitamin A was given to all the cases.

KL/ERN/2021/49/0690	Kerala	Ernakulam	Acute Diarrheal Disease	15	00	09-12-21	06-12-21	Under Surveillance	Cases reported from UPHC Thammanam, Palarivattom, District Ernakulam. The cases presented with fever, nausea, vomiting, loose stools and headache and were residents of a common hostel. The most affected age group was 19-20 years of age. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given. Super chlorination of water source was done.
KL/KOZ/2021/49/0691	Kerala	Kozhikode	Cholera	01	00	08-12-21	09-12-21	Under Surveillance	Case reported from Kozhikode Corporation (Ward 61), District Kozhikode. The case was a Police constable who was a resident of a common camp. The cases presented with loose watery stool and vomiting. Stool culture sent to MCH Microbiology Lab and was found to be positive for Vibrio Cholera. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.

The cases presented with fever. 44 Blood serum samples were sent to GMC Akola Lab, out of which 18 samples tested positive for Chikungunya by IgM ELISA. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given and public awareness was imparted.
MH/KOP/2021/49/0693	Maharashtra	Kolhapur	Acute Diarrheal Disease	29	00	08-12-21	11-12-21	Under Surveillance	Cases reported from AP Lotewadi, SC/PHC Minache Khu, Taluk Bhudargad, District Akola. The reason of the outbreak was improper sanitation of the water source (tank) for the affected population. Four stool and seven water samples were sent to RH Solankur, six water samples sent to DPHL Lab and CPRH Microbiology dept, the result is awaited. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.
OR/RAY/2021/49/0694	Odisha	Rayagada	Acute Diarrheal Disease	11	00	05-12-21	08-12-21	Under Surveillance	Cases reported from Village Bada Matakabadi, SC Patraguda, CHC/Block B. Cuttack, District Rayagada. The cases presented with abdominal pain, cramps, nausea and fever. One water sample was sent for further lab analysis, the sample was found to be not fit for drinking purpose. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.

TN/TVL/2021/49/0695	Tamil Nadu	Tiruvallur	Acute Diarrheal Disease	147	00	03-12-21	08-12-21	Under Surveillance	Cases reported from Village/HSC Perandur, PHC Latchivakkam, Block Ellapuram, District Thiruvallur. The cases presented with vomiting and loose motion. The reason of the outbreak was a contaminated water source. Two stool and six water samples were sent to DPHL Tiruvallur for further lab analysis, the result is awaited. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given. ORS was provided to all the affected cases.

The cases presented with vomiting and loose motion. The reason of the outbreak was a contaminated water source. Two stool and six water samples were sent to DPHL Tiruvallur for further lab analysis, out of which the water samples were found to be not fit for drinking purpose. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.
TN/TNJ/2021/49/0697	Tamil Nadu	Thanjavur	Mixed Fever	45	00	11-12-21	11-12-21	Under Surveillance	Cases reported from Village Usulampatti – RSV agriculture College, PHC Palayapatti, HSC Sengipatty, Block Budalur, District Thanjavur. The cases presented with fever. Five water samples and 17 Serum samples were sent to DPHL, Thanjavur, out of which one sample tested positive for Dengue by IgM ELISA and two samples tested positive for Scrub Typhus by IgM ELISA. The water samples were found to be unfit for drinking purpose. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.
WB/BWN/2021/49/0698	West Bengal	Burdwan	Acute Diarrheal Disease	89	00	09-12-21	10-12-21	Under Control	Cases reported from Village Pilkhuri, Block Bagar-1, Purba Bardhaman, District Burdwan. The cases presented with vomiting and loose motion and all had consumed food from a common local festival. Four rectal swabs were sent to BMCH, out of which the growth of E. Coli was found in all three samples. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.

KL/PLK/2021/49/0700	Kerala	Palakkad	Visceral Leishmaniosis	01	01	01-11-21	Under Surveillance	Case reported from Village Payyanadam 2, SC Karapadam, PHC Kumaramputhur, Block Alanallur, District Palakkad. District Ernakulam. The deceased was a 14-year-old female. The cases presented with fever, bilateral swelling in the legs and increased fatiguability. The child was referred to Taluk hospital for further management where she was treated for pancytopenia and severe anemia. The child developed cardiogenic shock and died on the same day following admission. Bone marrow aspiration showed the presence of Leishmaniosis donovani bodies (LD bodies). District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.
