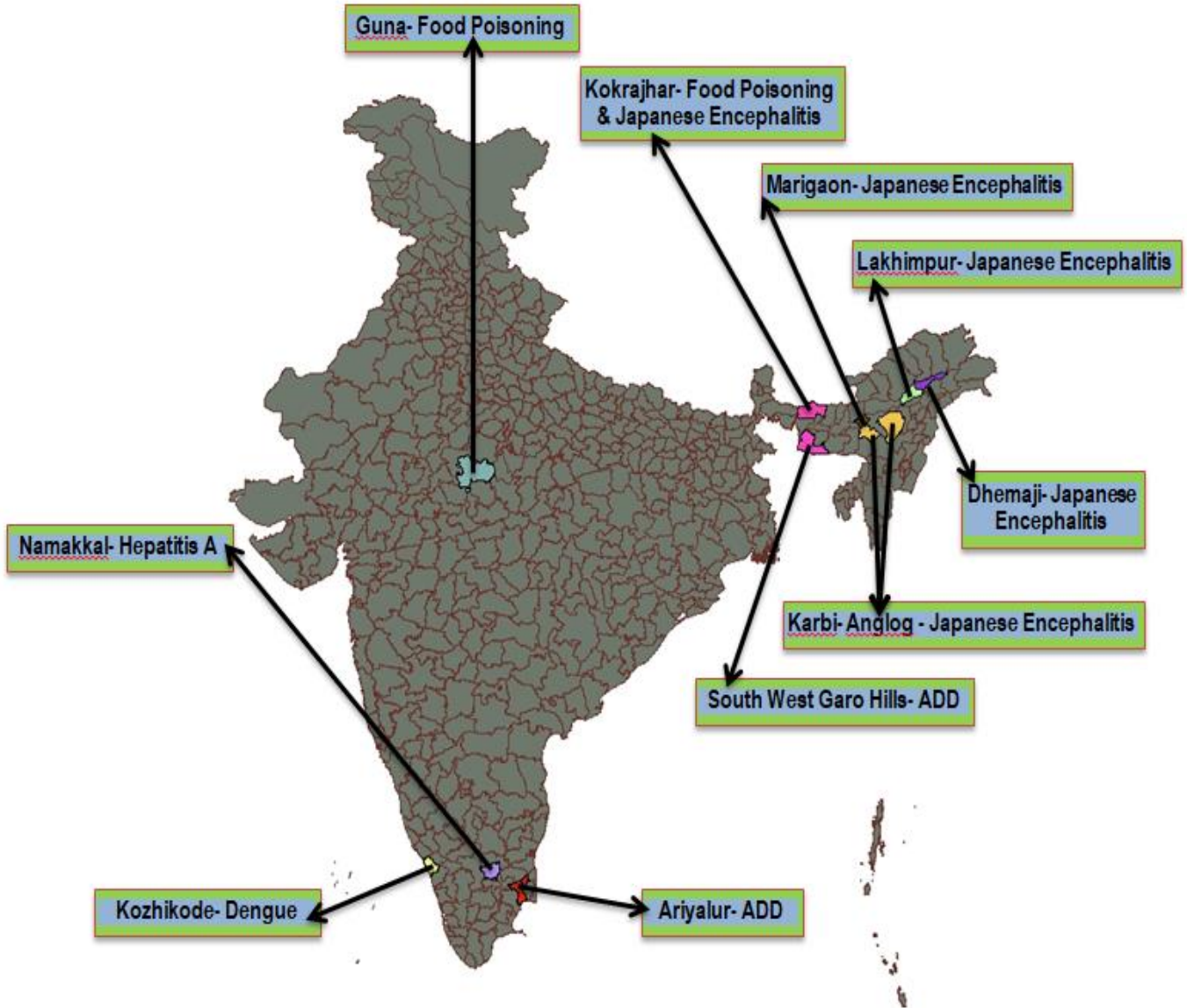

29<sup>th</sup> Week Map

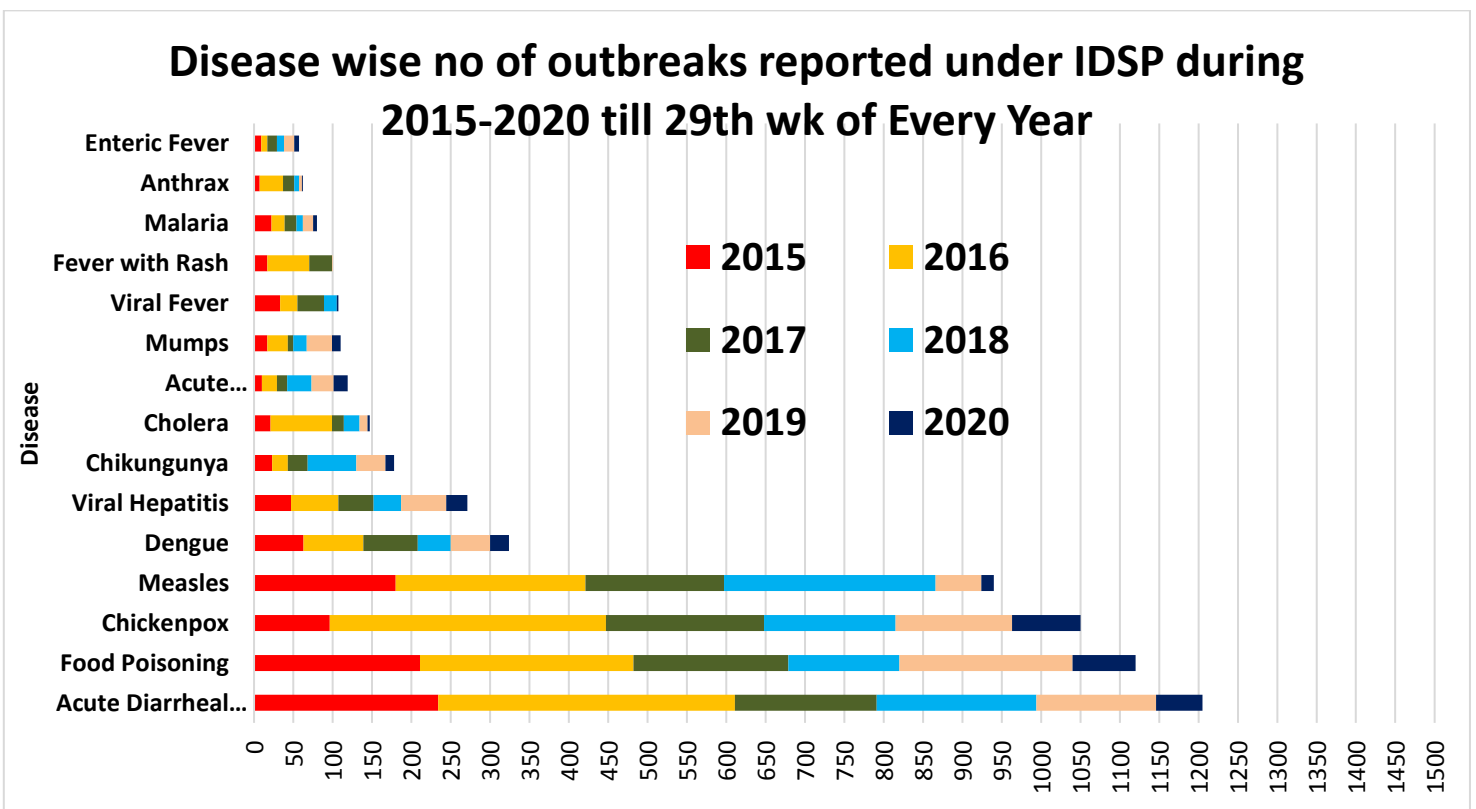
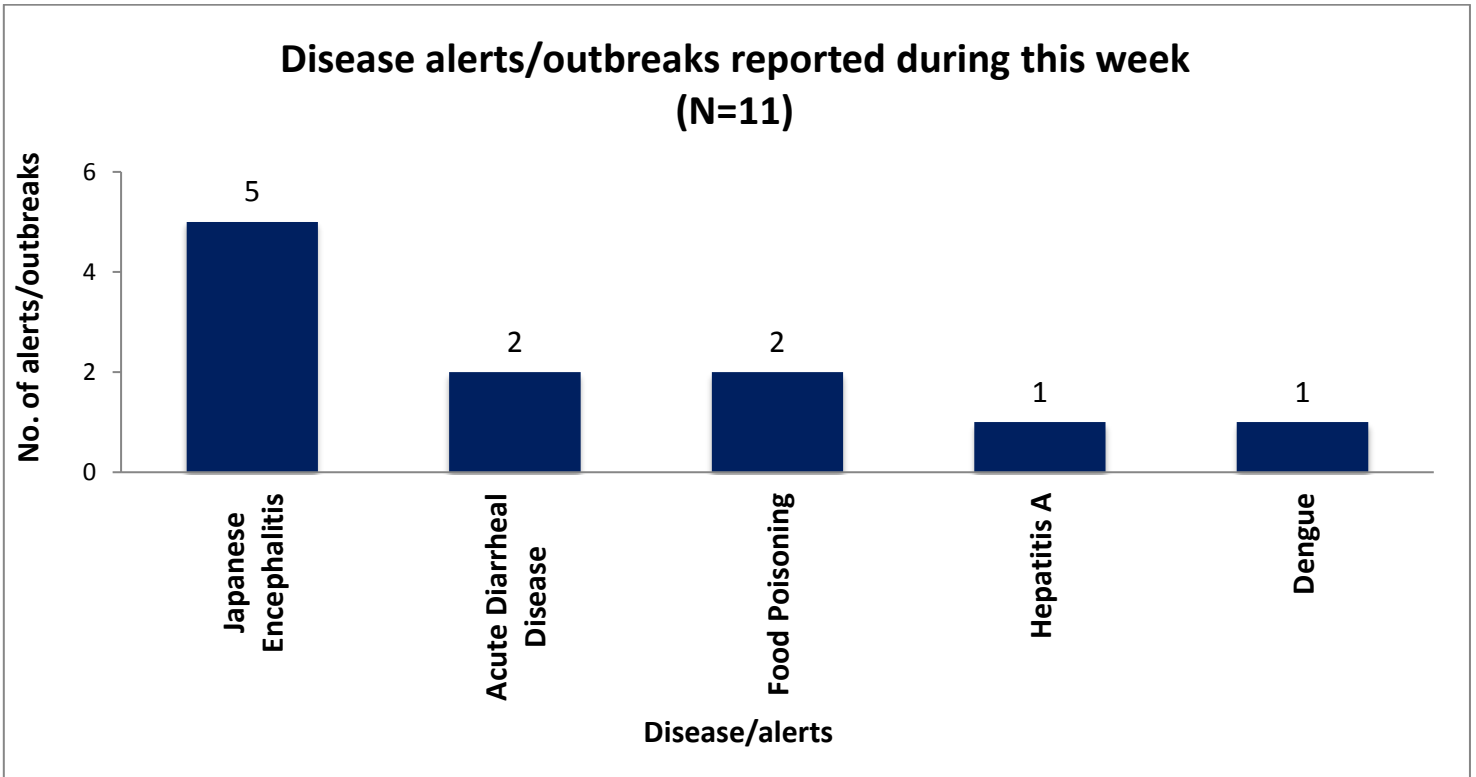
