



51st Week Map




Cases presented with fever, headache and vesicular eruption. House to house survey was done. IEC regarding maintenance of proper health and hygiene along with proper isolation of affected household members was done. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Follow up of the affected individuals was done for 21 days from the onset of symptoms.
AS/DHE/2020/51/510	Assam	Dhemaji	Leptospirosis and Scrub Typhus	01	00	15-11-20	22-12-20	Under Surveillance	Cases reported from Village Kodomtola, SC Jalkiasuti, PHC Silapathar, BPHC Sissiborgaon. The case, a 66 years male started developing symptom such as Fever and Cough. Leptospira, sample was positive for Scrub Typhus by IgM Elisa.
KN/RCR/2020/51/511	Karnataka	Raichur	Dengue	29	00	16-12-20	17-12-20	Under Control	Cases reported from Village Gonwatla Tanda, PHC/CHC Echnal, Taluk Lingsugur. High mosquito density was found and huge number of breeding sites was observed in the area. House to house survey done. 29 blood serum samples collected and sent to DSU, Raichur, result 01 sample positive for Dengue by IgM ELISA. All cases treated. Health education given.
KL/KAS/2020/51/512	Kerala	Kozhikode	Shigella sonnei	50	01	06-12-20	15-12-20	Under Surveillance	Cases reported from Village Corp/Chelavoor, HSC UHC Chelavoor, PHC Division 18-Kottaparamb, Block Corporation. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Cases presented with fever, vomiting, abdominal pain and loose stools. The deceased was a 11 year child with similar symptoms, cause of death was found to be sepsis. Water samples collected and sent to Regional Analytical Lab. Shigella and coliform bacteria were found and the sample was found to be unfit for drinking purpose.

PO Nonakuri Bazar, Saira, Demarihat, Ballukhat, Alinan. Block Sahid Matangini. Cases presented with Fever, Body aches, muscles pain and dark scab. House to house survey done. 15 samples were collected and 5 were reactive. All the rest were negative for scrub typhus and malaria.

Cases presented with high-fever, diarrhea and vomiting. Blood samples collected and sent to AMCH, and result positive for Leptospira.
JH/PAK/2020/51/515	Jharkhand	Pakaur	Fever with Rash	12	00	01-12-20	Under Surveillance	Cases reported from Village Randanga, HSC Sangrampur, CHC Pakur. District RRT investigated the outbreak. House to house survey done. Two blood samples collected and sent to Institute of Serology Kolkata with the help of WHO Pakur, and both tested negative for Rubella and Measles.
KL/THI/2020/51/516	Kerala	Trivandrum	Chikungunya	11	00	06-12-20	Under Surveillance	Cases reported from Village/HSC Pangode, PHC Thrikkannapuram, Block Trivandrum Corporation. Vector breeding sites were found in money plant holding containers, flower vases, plastic containers and tyres. 13 Blood samples collected and sent to PH Lab and all samples were found positive.
