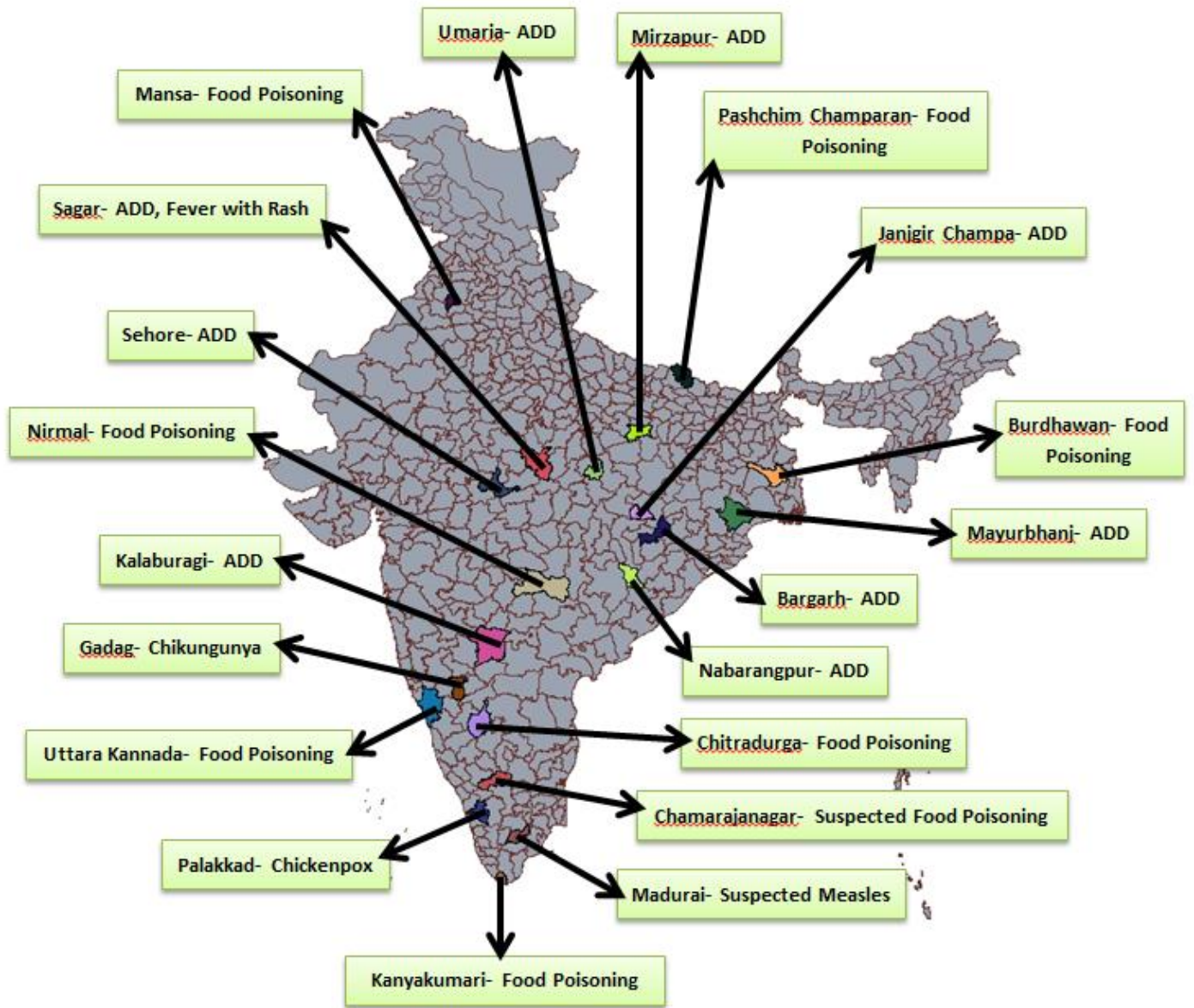

## 29<sup>th</sup> Week Map

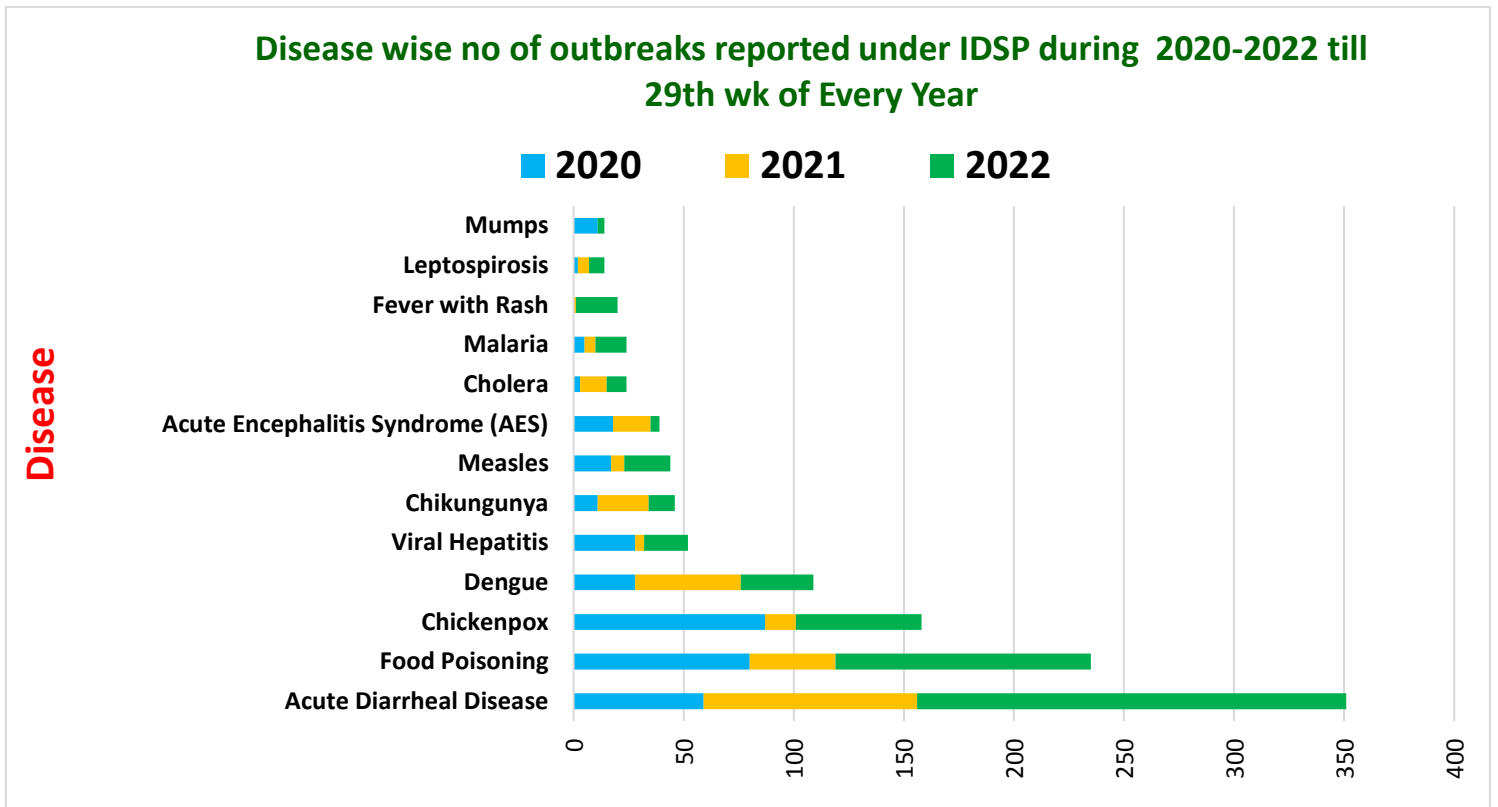
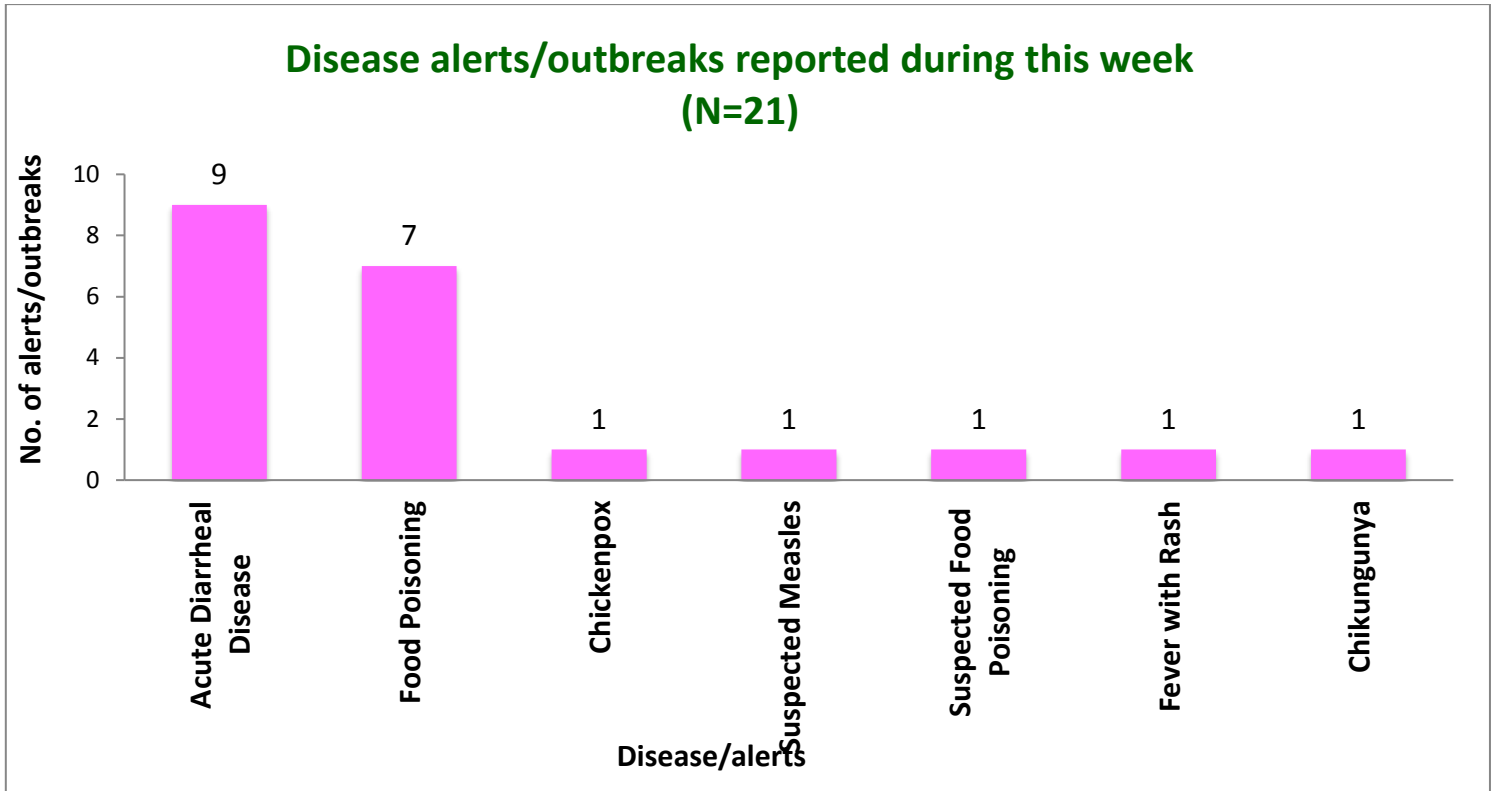

No growth was found after 24 hours of incubation and all four water samples were found suitable for potable purpose. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given on the importance of personal hygiene and intake of safe drinking water with special emphasis on hygiene of food handlers and food handling techniques.

Vitamin A Prophylaxis was given. Health education was imparted regarding importance of immunisation.
