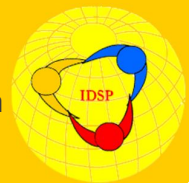

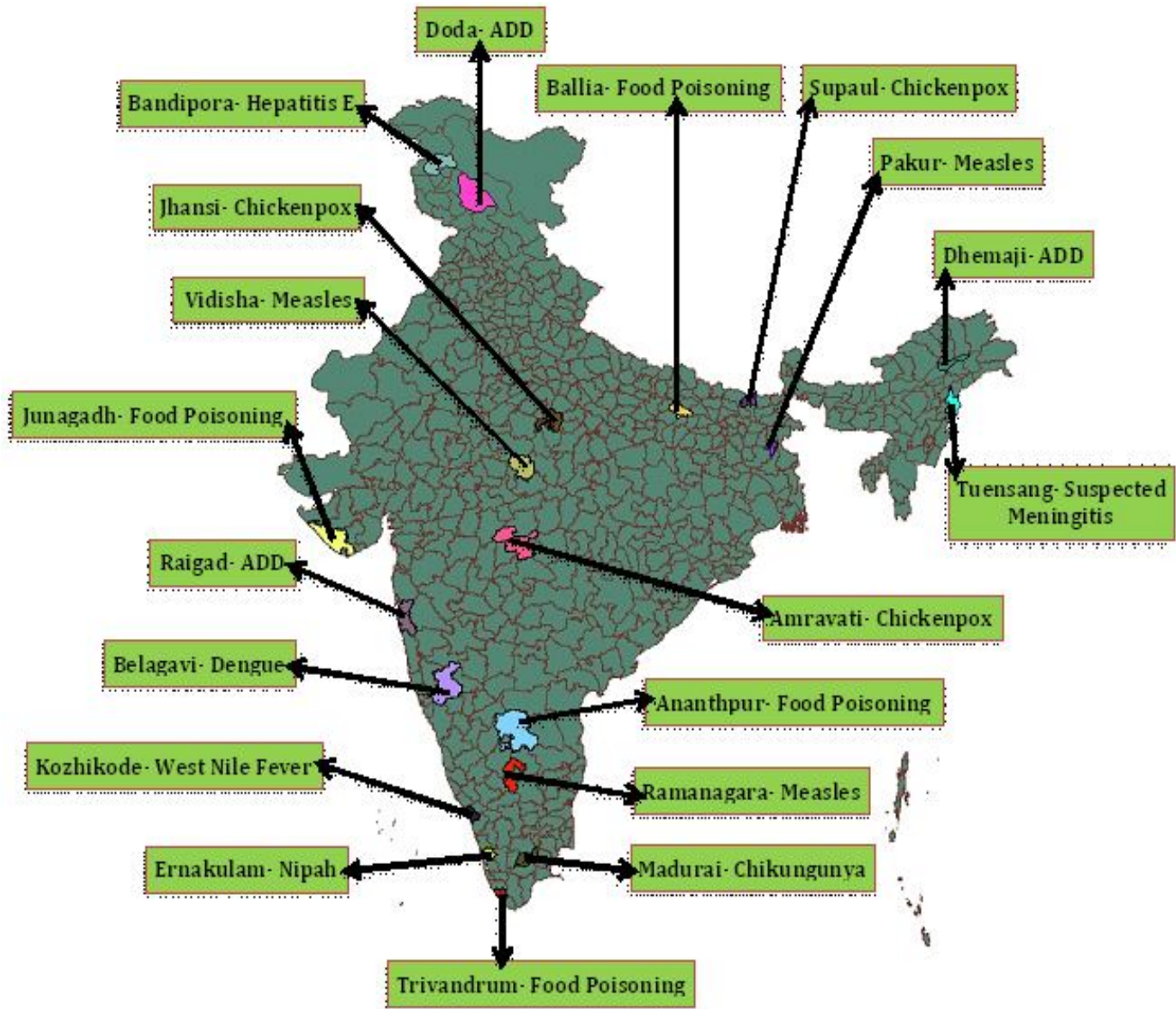

22<sup>nd</sup> Week Map

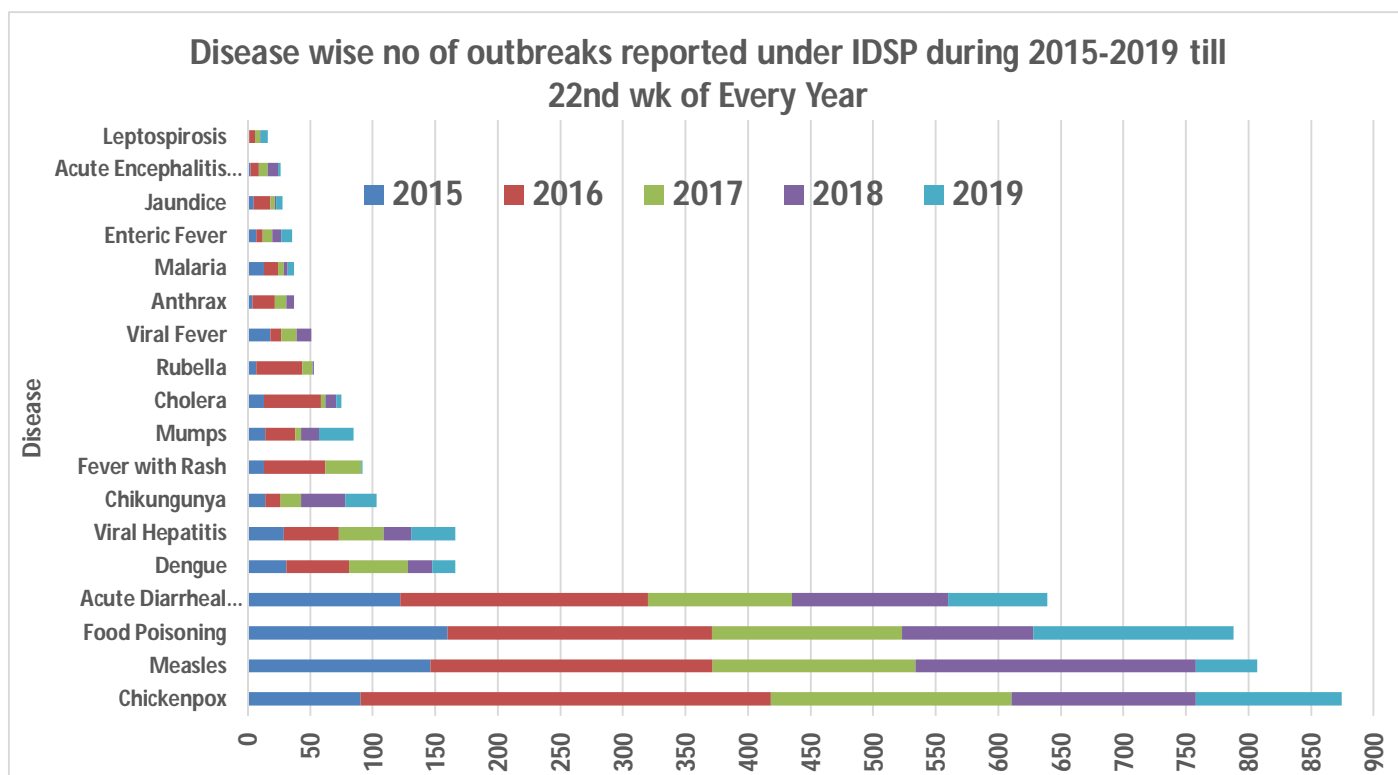
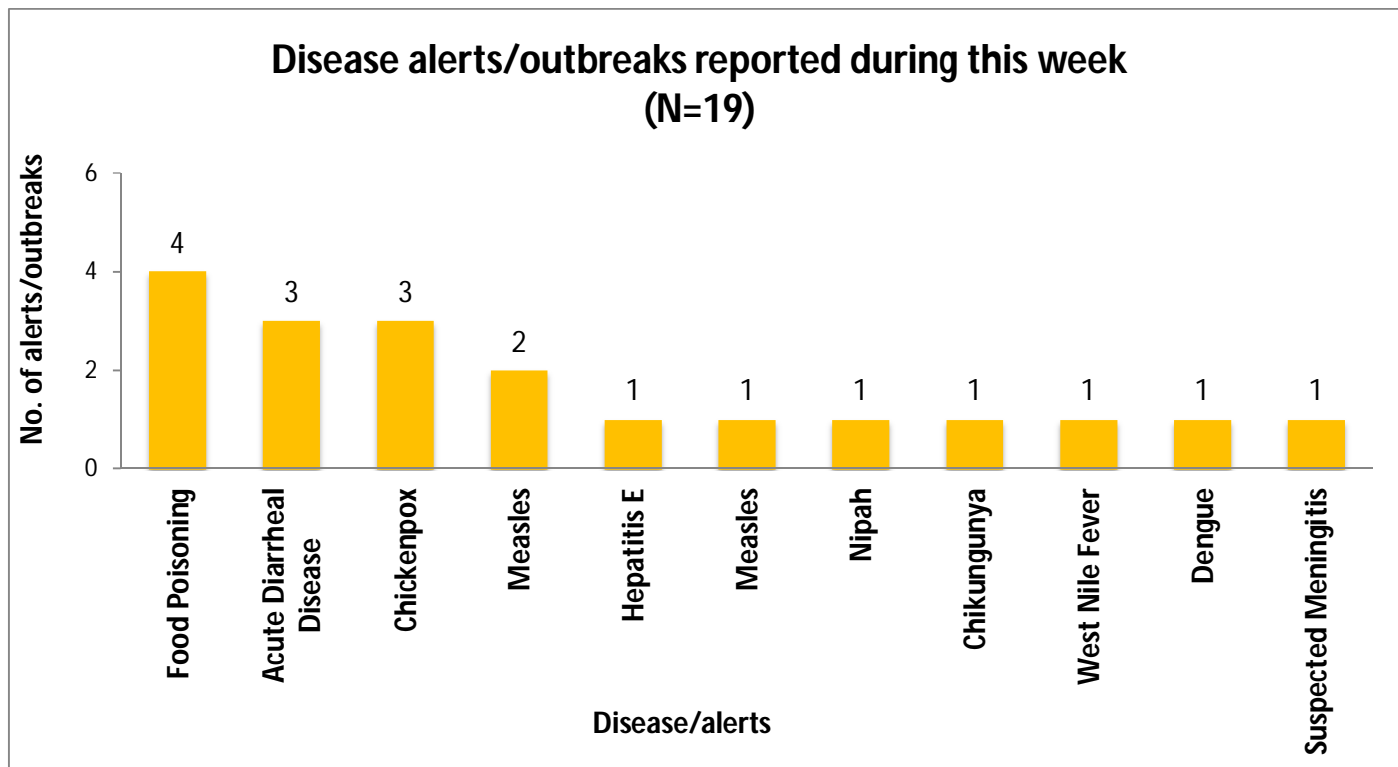

Symptomatic treatment given to all cases. Health education given regarding food hygiene and sanitation.

All cases consumed food (milk product) in marriage ceremony and presented symptoms with vomiting and loose motion. 1 food sample collected; result awaited. ORS packets distributed. All cases treated symptomatically. Health education given.

All cases treated symptomatically. Vitamin A supplementation provided. Health education given regarding isolation of cases.

District RRT investigated the outbreak. House to house survey done. Water samples sent to PHE Dept; result awaited. ORS and zinc tablets were distributed in the blocks. A meeting was organized by District Development Commissioner regarding provision of safe drinking water to the community followed by water testing once in a month. Chlorine tablets distributed in the community. Chlorination of water sources done in the community. All cases treated symptomatically. Health education given regarding drinking boiled and cooled water for daily consumption.

All cases treated symptomatically. Health education given regarding personal hygiene, Hand hygiene practices and consumption of safe drinking water.

Blood samples were collected and tested for Typhoid (Widal), JE (Rapid test), Scrub typhus and Malaria; were negative for all the above test. Symptomatically treated the case. He was discharged on 28 <sup>th</sup> May 2019. Health education given.

Out of 5 serum samples collected and sent to DPHL Madurai; 4 samples were positive for Chikungunya (IgM ELISA), 2 samples were positive for Typhoid, 1 sample was positive for Dengue (IgM ELISA). All cases treated symptomatically. Health education given.

District RRT investigated the outbreak. Active search of cases done. All the cases consumed stale food and presented symptoms with loose motion and vomiting. Cases treated symptomatically. Health education given regarding food hygiene and sanitation.

District RRT investigated the outbreak. House to house survey done. Migratory birds (crane) were observed in the affected area. Blood and CSF samples of the case was collected and sent to NIV, Allapuzha. The samples were found positive for West Nile virus (IgM ELISA). Entomological survey done. IRS and anti-larval measures were carried out in the affected area. Case cured and discharged. Health education given regarding personal protection measures.
KL/THI/2019/22/0583	Kerala	Trivandrum	Food Poisoning	43	00	21-05-19	Under Control	Cases reported from Mar Ivanios Bethany Girls Hostel, Nalanchira Village Mannanthala, SC/PHC/Block Pangappara. District RRT investigated the outbreak. All cases consumed food (pickle, potato curry, papad) in dinner and presented symptoms with loose motion, vomiting and abdominal pain. All cases treated symptomatically. Health education given.
KL/ERN/2019/22/0584	Kerala	Ernakulam	Nipah	01	00	20-05-19	Under Surveillance	A 23 year old male residing at Vadakkekara, Paravur a student of Al Akbar College Thodupuzha, presented symptoms of fever with altered sensorium was referred to a private hospital at Ernakulam on 30 <sup>th</sup> May 2019. Throat swab, CSF, blood and urine were collected and sent to NIV Pune; the samples were found positive for Nipah Virus (Real-time RT-PCR, nested RT-PCR and for anti-Nipah human IgM and IgG antibodies by ELISA assay). Presently the case is stable. Central team and State/District RRT investigated the outbreak. Control room was set up at State Headquarter (Trivandrum) and District Headquarter (Ernakulam). 330 contacts were traced and 13 suspected cases samples were found negative for Nipah. 141 bats were captured and samples were collected (rectal and throat swabs) were tested. Out of these one bat sample was found positive for Nipah viral RNA. Standard NIPAH outbreak guidelines were implemented in the hospital and community settings. Health education given.
