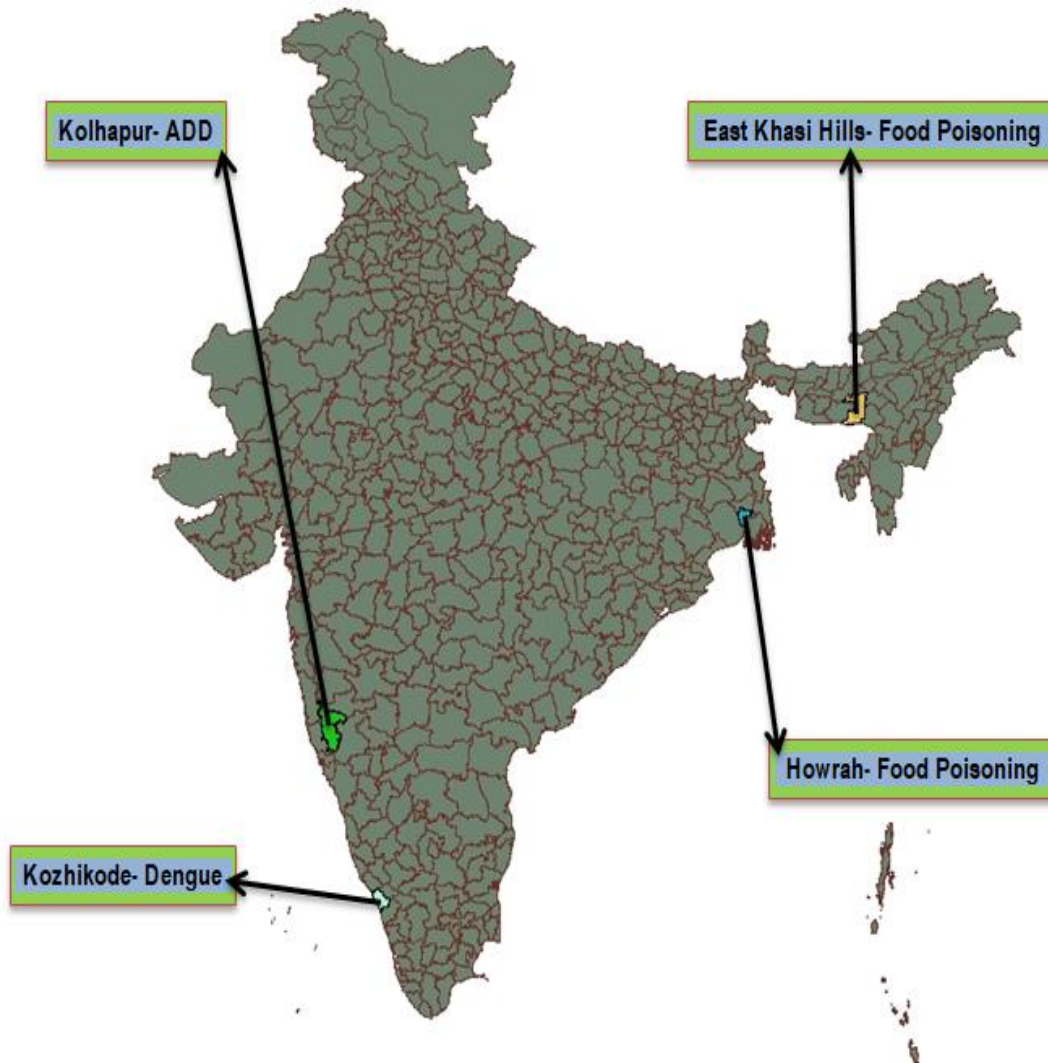

26<sup>th</sup> Week Map

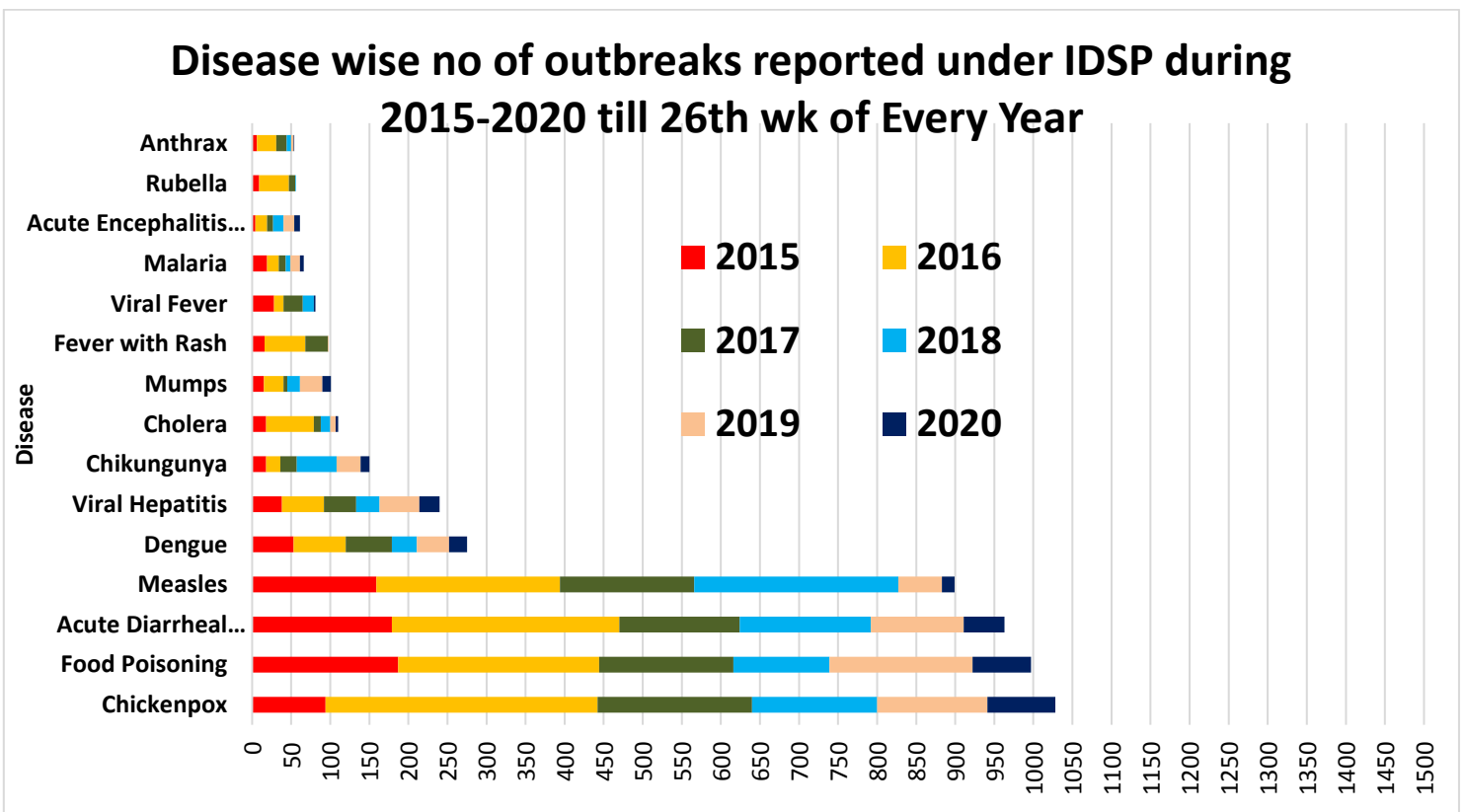
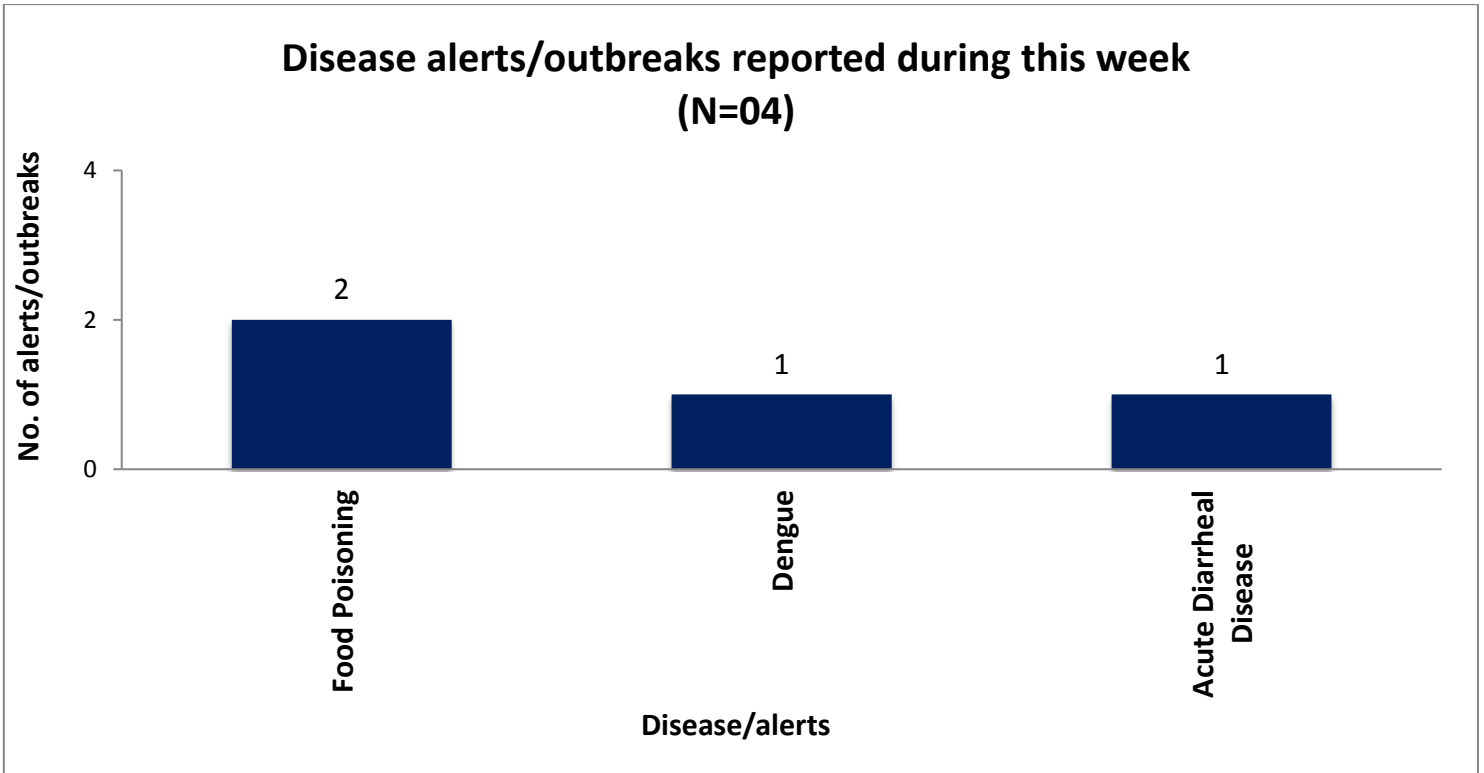

Health education given on hand washing, hygiene and safe drinking water.

Water sources were super chlorinated. Health education given on personal hygiene and sanitation.
