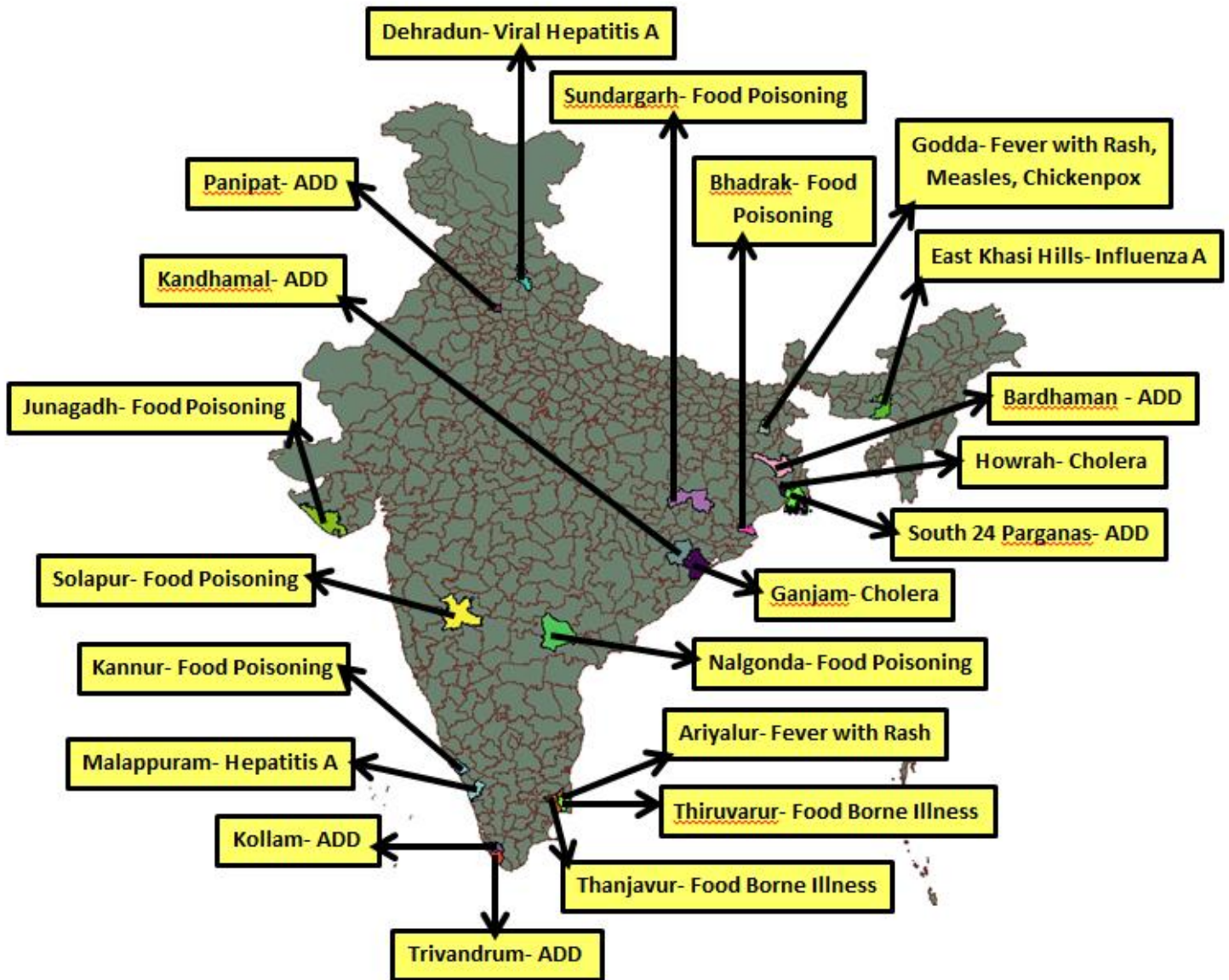

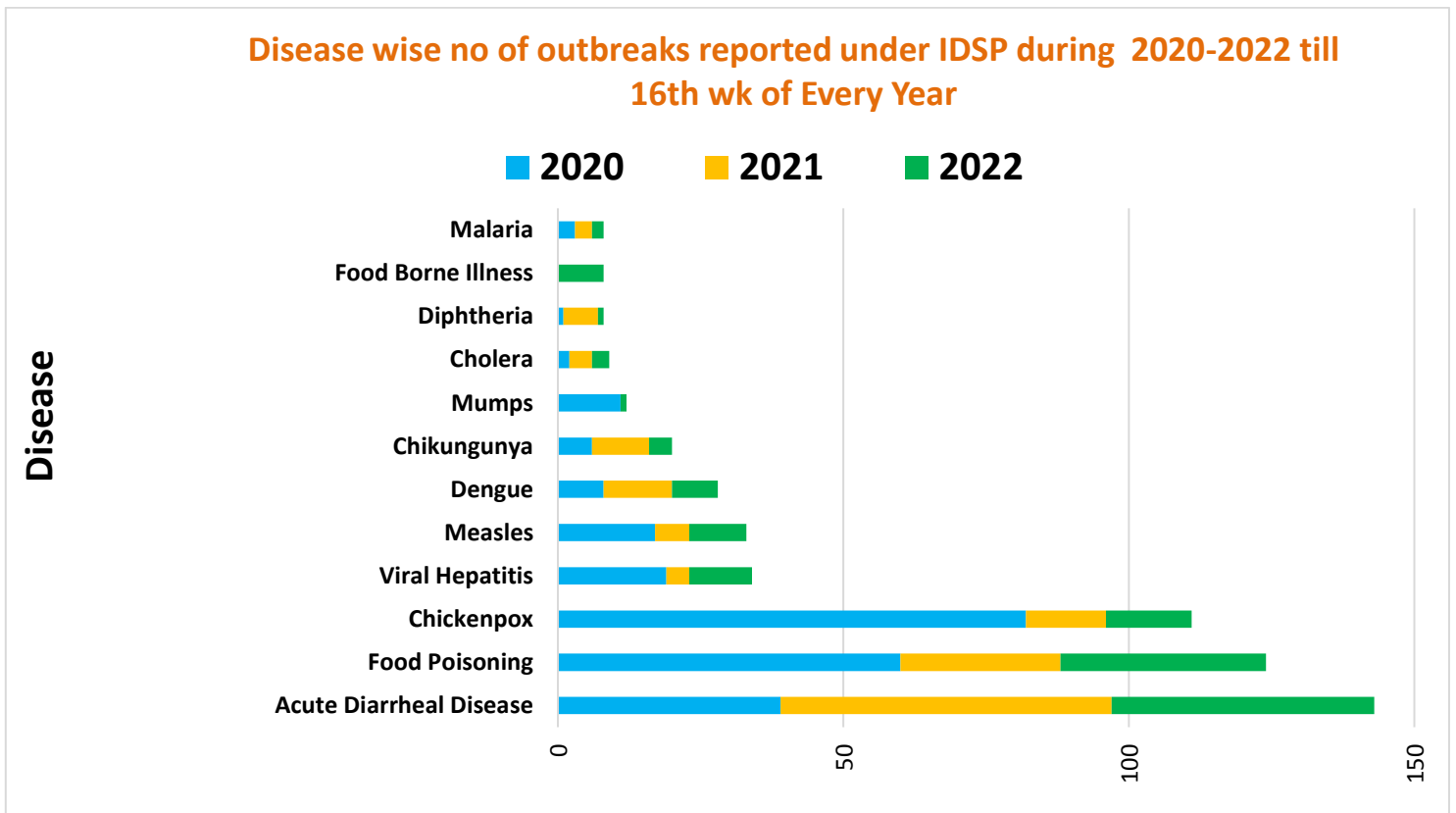

Cases presented with vomiting and abdominal pain. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Symptomatic treatment was given to all the cases. Chlorine tablets were distributed. Health education was given regarding importance of safe drinking water.
HR/PNP/2022/16/148	Haryana	Panipat	Acute Diarrheal Disease	06	00	23-04-22	25-04-22	Under Control	Cases reported from Village Deshraj Colony, UPHC Hari Singh Colony, District Panipat. Cases presented with loose stools, vomiting and abdominal pain. Seven water samples were sent to Civil Hospital, Panipat. All the samples were found to be unfit for drinking. Two samples showed presence of Klebsiella and remaining five samples showed presence of E.coli. District RRT investigated the outbreak. It was observed that drinking water pipes were broken and leaked due to road construction work. Symptomatic treatment was given to all the cases. Chlorine tablets were distributed. Health education was given regarding importance of safe drinking water.

Cases presented with fever, maculopapular rashes and body pain. Four blood samples were sent to RIMS, Ranchi and all of them were found negative for Measles by IgM ELISA. Vitamin A solutions and symptomatic treatment were given to the cases. Health education was given regarding importance of immunization.

Vitamin A solutions and symptomatic treatment were given to the cases. Immunization status of the cases is unknown. Health education was given regarding importance of immunization.

Of these, one sample was found positive for Salmonella species by culture and sensitivity. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Symptomatic treatment was given to all the cases. Chlorine tablets were distributed. Health education was given regarding importance of safe drinking water.

District RRT investigated the outbreak. Symptomatic treatment was given to all the cases. Chlorine tablets were distributed. Health education was given regarding importance of safe drinking water.

Symptomatic treatment was given to all the cases. Chlorine tablets were distributed. Health education was given regarding importance of safe drinking water.

Health education was given regarding importance of hygiene practices, safe drinking water and sanitation.

Of these, three samples were found positive for Influenza A by RTPCR. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given regarding importance of personal hygiene and prevention of Influenza like illness. Health workers were sensitized on active surveillance and referral of severe cases to higher centers for treatment. Tab Oseltamavir and Syrup Oseltamivir were distributed.
